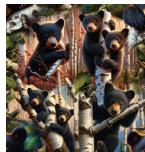

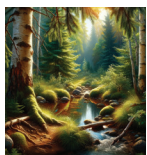

- 100% Cotton thread and sewing supplies

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Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please check *blankquilting.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 5½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

- (7) 2" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams; subcut
- (2) 2" x 61½"
- (2) 2" x 58½"
- (7) 2½" x WOF for the binding

Fabric C, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 5½" squares

Fabric D, cut:

- (3) 4" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 44½"
- (3) 3" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 43½"
- (6) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams; subcut
- (2) 1½" x 59½"
- (2) 1½" x 55½"
- (5) 1½" x WOF; subcut
- (34) 1½" x 5½"

Fabric E, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 5½" squares

Fabric F, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 5½" squares

Fabric G, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 5½" squares

Fabric H, cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 42½"
- (2) 3" x 39½"

Fabric I, cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
- (4) 5½" squares

Fabric J, fussy cut:

- (1) 34½" x 42½" rectangle centered on the design

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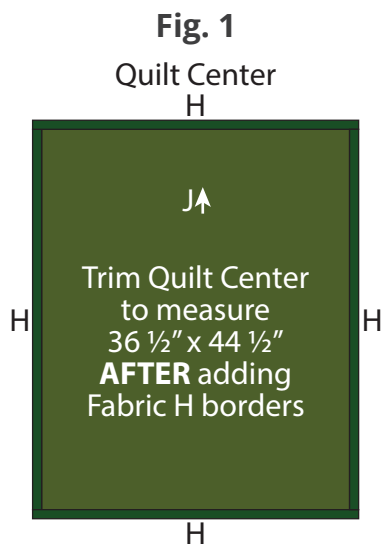
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Little Cuties Quilt

Sewing

- Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm) seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
 - The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.
- Sew (1) $3" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric H** strip to each side of the $34\frac{1}{2}" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric J** rectangle. Sew (1) $3" \times 39\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric H** strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric J** rectangle to make the Quilt Center (**Fig. 1**). **Trim the Quilt Center to measure $36\frac{1}{2}" \times 44\frac{1}{2}"$.**



- Sew together (9) $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric D** strips and (8) assorted $5\frac{1}{2}"$ squares as shown to make $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 49\frac{1}{2}"$ Left Side Border (**Fig. 2**).
- Repeat Step 2 to make the $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 49\frac{1}{2}"$ Right Side Border (**Fig. 3**).

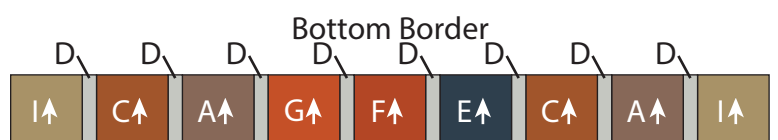
- Sew together (9) assorted $5\frac{1}{2}"$ squares and (8) $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric D** strips as shown to make the $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 53\frac{1}{2}"$ Top Border (**Fig. 4**).

- Repeat Step 4 to make the $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 53\frac{1}{2}"$ Bottom Border (**Fig. 5**).

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Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

6. Sew (1) 4" x 44½" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 3" x 43½" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
7. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center.
8. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
9. Sew (1) 1½" x 59½" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 1½" x 55½" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
10. Sew (1) 2" x 61½" **Fabric B** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2" x 58½" **Fabric B** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to complete the quilt top which should measure 58½" x 64½".
14. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
15. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

11. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.

Binding

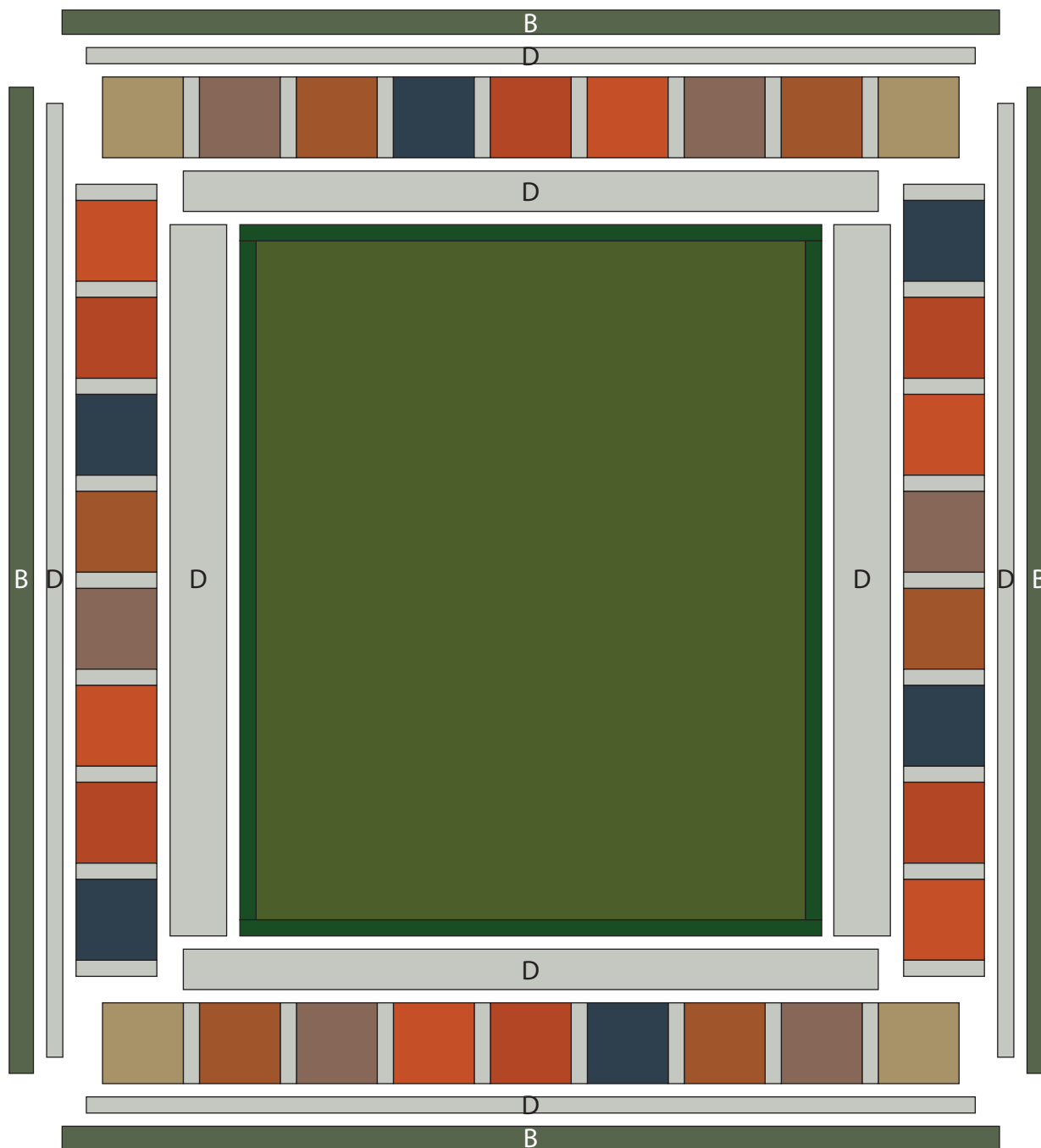
12. Sew together (7) 2½" x WOF **Fabric B** binding strips end to end with diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
13. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning
