## Scandinavian Christmas Wallhanger

47" X 55" (119 x 139 cm)

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENT:**

Fabrics from series "Scandinavian Christmas" and "Melange", both 44" wide.





#### OTHER SUPPLIES:

Batting: Matilda's Own 99M500, 100% polyester 94" (240 cm) wide 51" (130 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

CUTTING: 1/4" seam allowance is included. Take care of orientation on some motifs.

Fabric C: 5 Trees as template, page 4
Fabric A,G,J: each 3 Trees as template, page 4
Fabric E: 2 Trees as template, page 4
Fabric I: 5 Triangles of each as template for left

Fabric I: 5 Triangles of each as templates for left & right side, page 3
Fabric B,D,F: each 3 Triangles of each as templates for left & right side, page 3
Fabric K: 2 Triangles of each as templates for left & right side, page 3

Fabric I: 10 Rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (W x H) Fabric B,D,F: each 6 Rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (W x H) Fabric K: 4 Rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (W x H)

Fabric K: 4 Rectangles 3½" x 2½" (W x H)
Fabric M: 6 Squares 2½" x 2½"

Fabric L,N: each 5 Squares 2½" x 2½"

Fabric O: 2 Strips 3½" x 42" Inner border (must trim) Fabric O: 2 Strips 3½" x 40" Inner border (must trim)

Fabric D: 2 Strips 5" x 40½" Outer border (check lenght) \*

Fabric D: 4 Rectangles 5" x 5" for side border (must trim)

Fabric D: 2 Strips 5" x 38½" Outer border (check lenght) \*


Fabric D: 4 Squares 5" x 5" Corner outer border

Fabric P: 5 Strips 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44" Binding

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<sup>\*</sup> before cutting the outer border check the length of your quilt so far and cut so it fits.



SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4".

The quilt has 16 Christmas trees at the quilt center and the center is surrounded with 2 borders.

Start making the Christmas trees. Take one tree center and two back grounds. Join the trinagles on both side of the tree. Fold back seam towards the tree.

Now take the brown square and back ground rectangles for the bottom of the tree. Join them together.

Join the tree top & tree bottom. One tree block is created.

Follow the letters on the lay out page 5 for how to join the trees. Make 16 trees.

Position the blocks as layout on page 5 or as you prefer. Join the trees into rows and afterwards join the rows. The guilt center is now created.

Measure the height & width of the quilt top. Should be  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ ". Join strips in fabric O to left & right sides (O1) and afterwards join at the top & the bottom (O2).

Measure height & width again. Should be  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ ". Take the strips and the rectangles for the sides of the outer border and join at the short ends. Join to the left & right sides (D1). At last take the strips and squares and join at the short end. Join to the top & the bottom (D2).


#### **QUILTING AND BINDING:**

Layer top, batting and backing fabric and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine.

Sew hanging sleeve in backing fabric and place under top binding in fabric P.




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### Template for tree

# Assemble the template at the turquoise line



Outer border: Rectangle at the side & square at the top. NOTE:
First letter is tree.
Second letter is back ground.
Third letter is tree trunk.



Outer border: Rectangle at the side & square at the bottom.

Binding is fabric P
