Fabrics from series „Snow Crystals”, 44" wide .

### OTHER SUPPLIES:

Batting: Matilda's Own 99M300, 100% wool, 94" (240 cm) wide 61" (155 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

### CUTTING:

1/4" seam allowance is included.

Fabric A,E,Q:	9 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric C:	6 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric F,M,O,R:	each 5 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric B,N,P:	each 4 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric D,H:	3 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric G,K,L:	each 2 Squares	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric I,J:	1 Square	8 1/8" x 8 1/8"
Fabric S:	6 Strips	2 3/4" x 44" Binding
Fabric S:	1 Strip	2 3/4" x 10" Binding

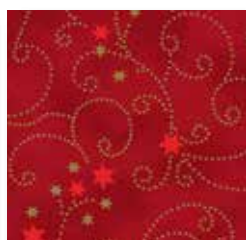

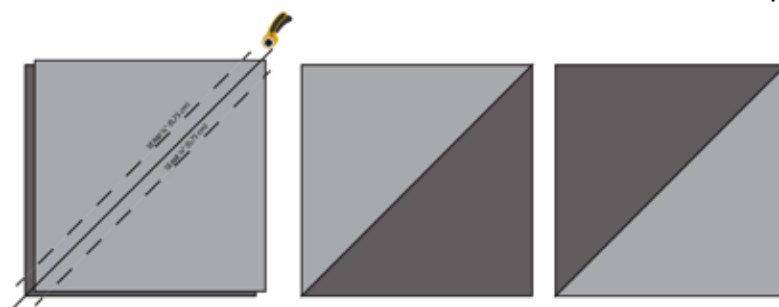
SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4".

The quilt is made with blocks joined as half square triangles.

Take the beige squares in fabric A-G and draw a diagonal line from one corner to another.  
Note: there is no orientation in the designs so you can draw the line what ever you like.

Now take one square in green fabric M-R and one square in beige fabric A-G. With right sides together, sew on both sides of the drawn line. Cut at the drawn line and two squares come forward, see sketch.

Afterwards take squares in beige fabric A-G and red fabric H-L and make these blocks.



## Overview of half square triangles:

### Green blocks:

Fabric A+M: 3 squares (= 6 half square triangles)

Fabric A+Q: 2 squares

Fabric B+R: 1 square

Fabric C+N: 1 square

Fabric C+P: 2 squares

Fabric D+O: 1 square

Fabric E+N: 2 squares

Fabric E+P: 2 squares

Fabric F+Q: 2 squares

Fabric G+R: 1 square

Fabric A+N: 1 square

Fabric B+O: 2 squares

Fabric C+M: 2 squares

Fabric C+O: 1 square

Fabric C+Q: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+Q: 2 squares

Fabric E+O: 1 square

Fabric E+Q: 1 square

Fabric F+R: 3 squares

### Red blocks:

Fabric A+H: 1 square

Fabric A+L: 1 squares

Fabric C+H: 1 square

Fabric E+I: 1 square

Fabric G+L: 1 square

Fabric A+K: 1 square

Fabric B+J: 1 square

Fabric E+H: 1 square

Fabric E+K: 1 square

Trim each block to size  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Position the squares as layout on page 4.

Join the squares into rows and afterwards join the rows.

The quilt top is now created.

## QUILTING AND BINDING:

Layer top, batting and backing fabric and baste the pieces.

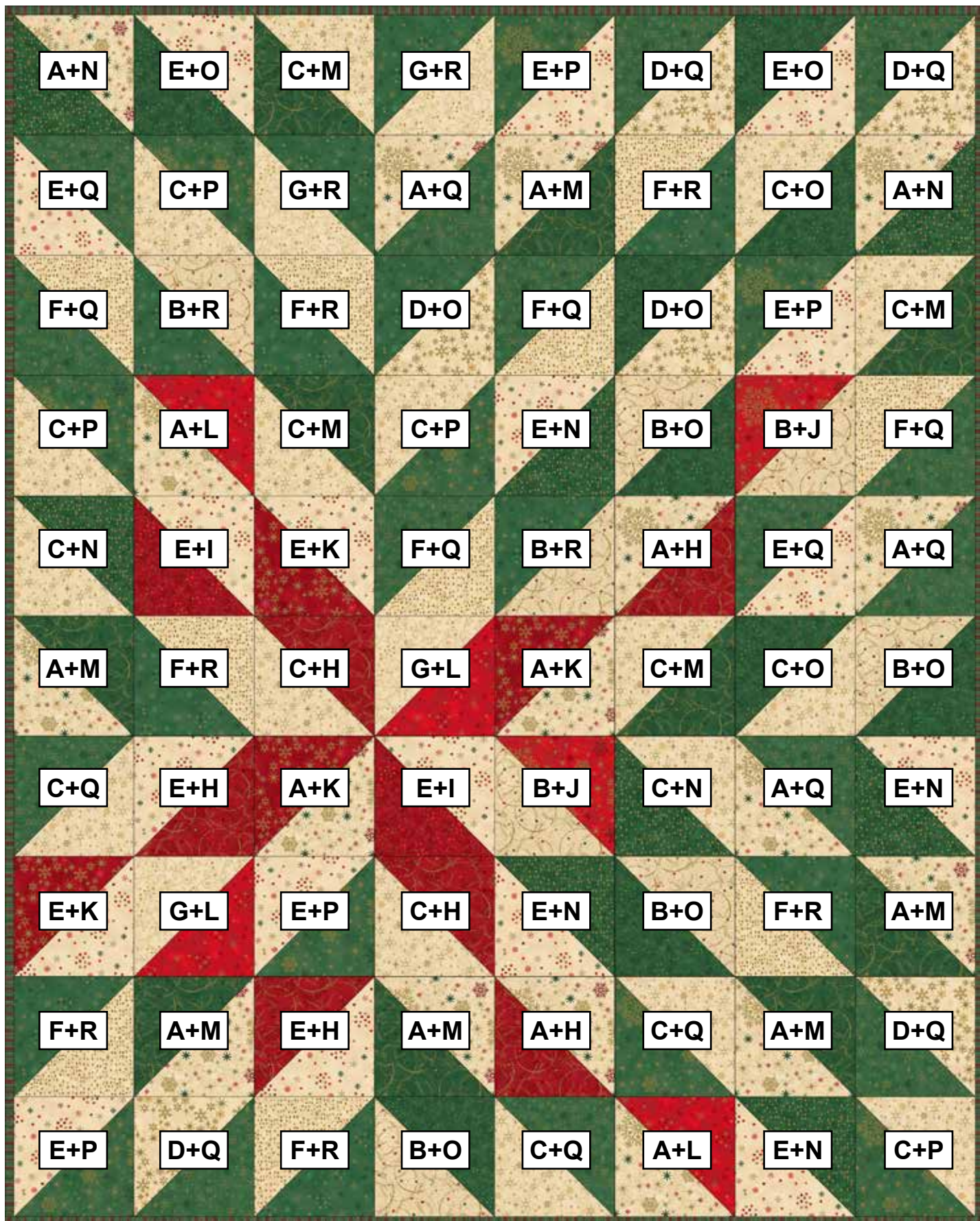
Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine.

Sew hanging sleeve in backing fabric and place under top binding in fabric S.
