

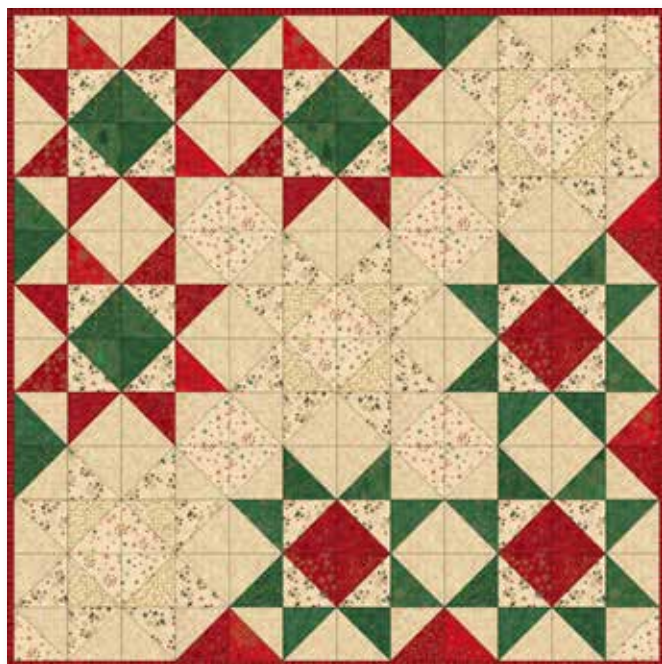

Batting: Matilda's Own 99M500 100% Polyester, 94" (240 cm) wide 53" (135 cm)

* The project is also suitable as a table cloth. In this case pls. use

Batting: Matilda's Own 99M400 100% Cotton, 94" (240 cm) wide 53" (135 cm)

In addition: Matching sewing and quilting thread.

CUTTING:

1/4" seam allowance is included.

Fabric B:	16 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric C:	6 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric D:	48 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric F,M,O,R:	each 5 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric E,I,K,Q:	each 4 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric G,L,P,S:	each 3 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric H,J,N:	each 2 Squares	5 1/8" x 5 1/8"
Fabric T:	5 Strips	2 3/4" x 44" Binding

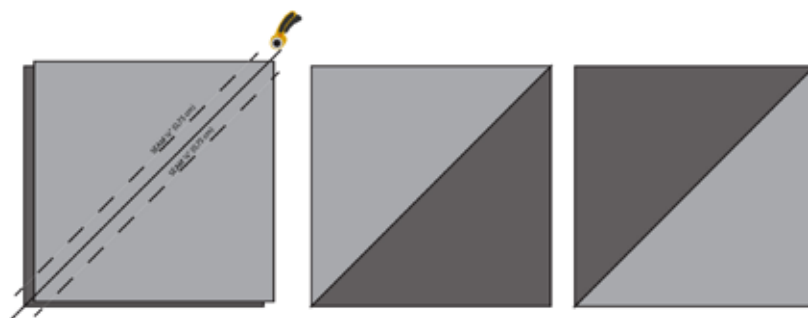

SEWING OF QUILT TOP: Seam allowance is 1/4".

This quilt is made from half square triangles (HST).

Take the beige squares in fabric A, B, C and D and draw a diagonal line from one corner to another.

Now take one square in beige fabric A and one in red fabric E. With right sides together sew on both sides of the drawn line. Cut at drawn line and two squares come forward, see sketch.



Continue with joining HST as below overviews so you get HST for 3 red stars, 3 green stars and 3 beige stars, see layout page 4.

Note: the corners and the edges are different on the stars.

Overview of half square triangles (HST):

Fabric A+D: 12 squares (take 12 squares of each = 24 HST)

Fabric A+E: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+I: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+M: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+Q: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric B+C: 6 squares

Fabric D+E: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+G: 3 squares (use 5)

Fabric D+I: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+K: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+M: 3 squares (use 5)

Fabric D+O: 3 squares (use 5)

Fabric D+Q: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+S: 3 squares (use 5)

Fabric A+F: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+K: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+O: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric A+R: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric B+D: 10 squares

Fabric D+F: 3 squares (use 5)

Fabric D+H: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+J: 2 squares

Fabric D+L: 3 squares

Fabric D+N: 2 squares (use 3)

Fabric D+P: 3 squares

Fabric D+R: 3 squares (use 5)

Trim all HST blocks to size $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Position the squares as layout on page 4.

Join the squares into 9 stars. Afterwards join the stars onto rows and join the rows.

The quilt top is now created.

QUILTING AND BINDING:

Layer top, batting and backing in fabric V and baste the pieces.

Quilt as you prefer by hand or by machine.

Sew top binding in fabric T.

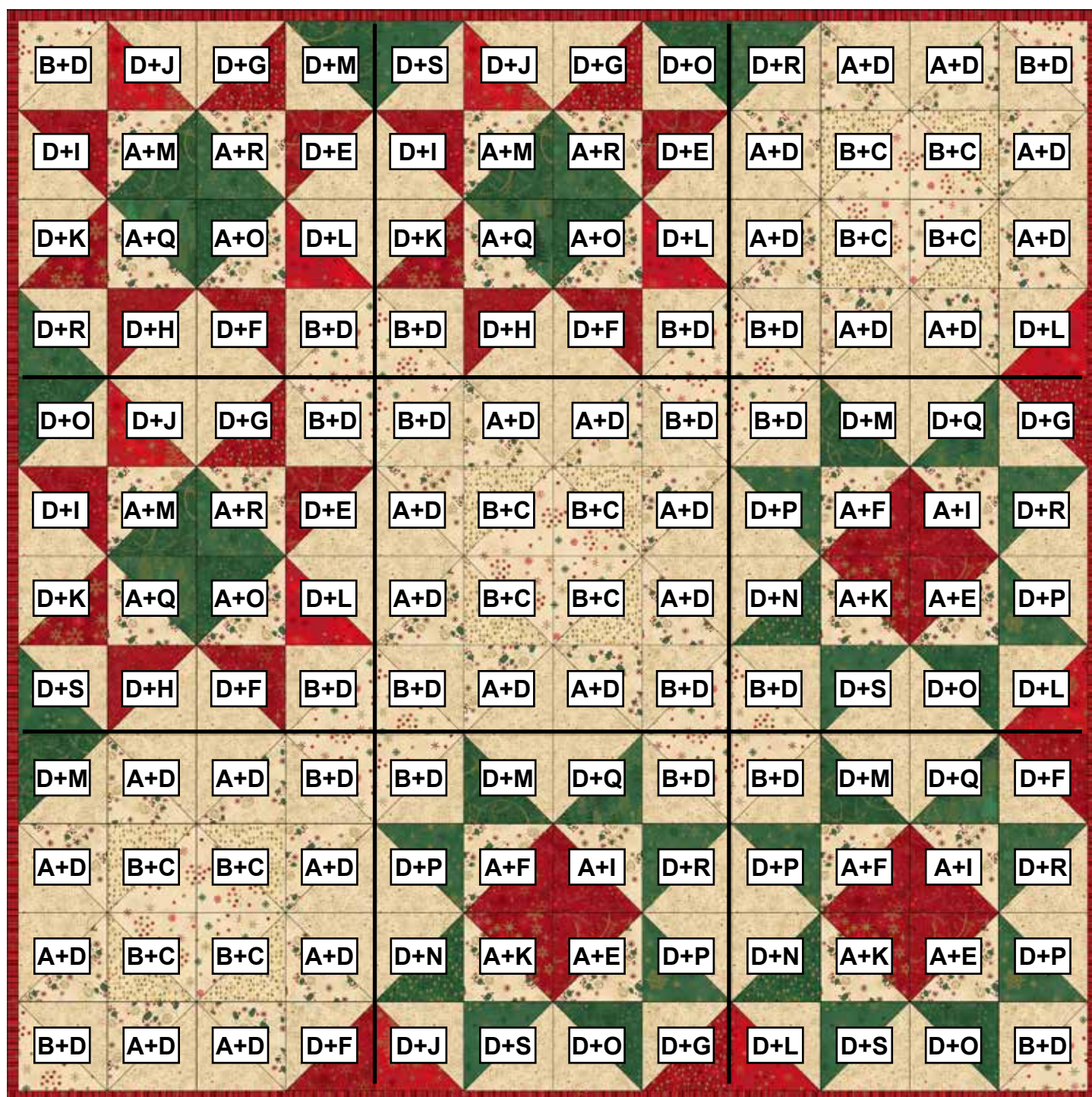
