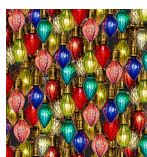

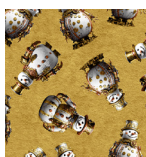
## Fabric Requirements

(A) Steampunk Christmas Bulbs	Blue	4819-77	½ yard (0.46m)
(B) Steampunk Snowmen	Gold	4822-30	¼ yard (0.23m)
(C) Snowflakes	Gold	4824-30	¼ yard (0.23m)
(D) Steampunk Candy Canes	Green	4825-66	⅜ yard (0.34m)
(E) Steampunk Gingerbread Men	Red	4827-88	⅜ yard (0.34m)
(F) Steampunk Christmas Panel	Red	4833P-88	1 yard (0.91m)
(G) Mélange	Green	4509-807	⅜ yard (0.34m)
(H) Mélange	Black on Black	4509-908*	⅝ yard (0.57m)

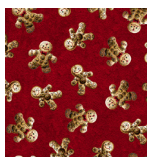

## Cutting Instructions

### Notes:

- Please make sure to check *blankquilting.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.

### Fabric A, cut:

(6) 2" x WOF for border 5

### Fabrics B and C, from each cut:

(1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (4) 4½" x 8½" rectangles

### Fabrics D and E, from each cut:

(2) 4½" x WOF; subcut (8) 4½" x 8½" rectangles

### Fabric F:

Trim panel to 43½" wide x 35½" high

### Fabric G, cut:

(5) 2" x WOF for border 1

### Fabric H, cut:

(7) 2½" x WOF for binding

### Fabric I, cut:

(11) 1½" x WOF: 5 for border 2 and 6 for border 4

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

### Notes:

- All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.
- Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 5) while assembling the quilt top.

1. For border 1, trim (2) 2" **Fabric G** strips to  $35\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew them to either side of the **Fabric F** panel and press the seams away from the center. Sew the remaining 2" **Fabric G** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Cut two  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press as before.
2. For border 2, sew the (5)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric I** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips to that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips to that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. The quilt measures  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " to this point.
3. For border 3, lay out (2) rows of (5)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles: (2) **Fabric D**, (2) **Fabric E**, and (1) **Fabric C**, as shown. Sew the rectangles together in each row. Press the seams in one direction. Sew a row to each side of the panel. Press the seams toward the center (**Fig. 1**).

4. Repeat step 3, except add a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** rectangle to the ends of each row. Sew one row to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center. Press as before (**Fig. 2**).

5. Repeat step 2 with the (6)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric I** strips to make and add border 4.
6. Repeat step 2 with the (6) 2" **Fabric A** strips to make and add border 5.

## FINISHING

7. Sew together the (7)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
8. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
9. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.

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10. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides
11. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.
