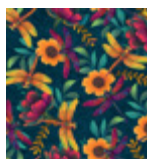

(E) Intermix	Teal	3188-67	1⅛ yards (1.03m)

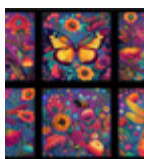

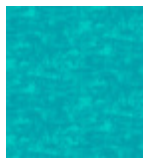

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Cutting

Notes:

- Please make sure to check www.blankquilting.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.
- *Always measure your quilt top before cutting and sewing borders and adjust if necessary.

Fabric A, cut:

(6) 4½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with 45-degree diagonal seams for borders; subcut

(2) 4½" x 52½"

(2) 4½" x 48½" strips*

Fabric B, cut:

(1) 6½" x WOF; subcut

(6) 6½" squares

Fabric C, cut:

Fussy cut (6) 11" squares

Fabric D, cut:

(2) 4" x WOF; subcut

(12) 4" squares

(4) 3½" x WOF; subcut

(48) 3½" squares

Fabric E, cut:

(5) 2½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with 45-degree diagonal seams for borders; subcut

(2) 2½" x 48½"

(2) 2½" x 40½" strips*

(6) 3½" x WOF; subcut

(24) 3½" x 6½" rectangles

(24) 3½" squares

Fabric F, cut:

(2) 4" x WOF; subcut

(12) 4" squares

(6) 2½" x WOF for the binding

(1) 12½" x WOF; subcut

(12) 1¼" x 12½" rectangles

(12) 1¼" x 11" rectangles

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Block Assembly

Note:

- All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm) unless otherwise noted.
- Sew pieces right sides together.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 4" and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** squares.
2. Place a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** square RST on opposite corners of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** square. Stitch on the drawn lines, trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press both corners open. Repeat on remaining corners to make (1) BE unit measuring $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square (**Fig. 1**). Make (6).
3. Place a marked 4" **Fabric D** square RST on (1) 4" **Fabric F** square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line and press open (**Fig. 2**). Square up to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make a total of (24) DF units.
4. Place a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** square RST on the left end of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press corner open. Repeat on opposite end to make (1) DE unit measuring $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (**Fig. 3**). Make (24).

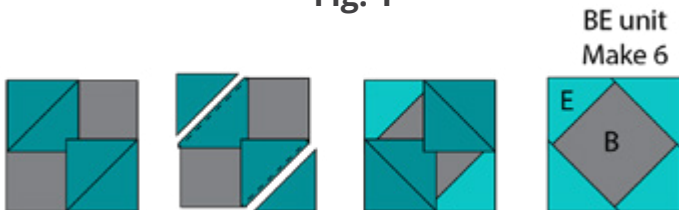

5. Lay out (4) each DE and DF units and (1) BE into (3) rows of (3). Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) Diamond block (**Fig. 4**). Make (6) Diamond blocks measuring $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

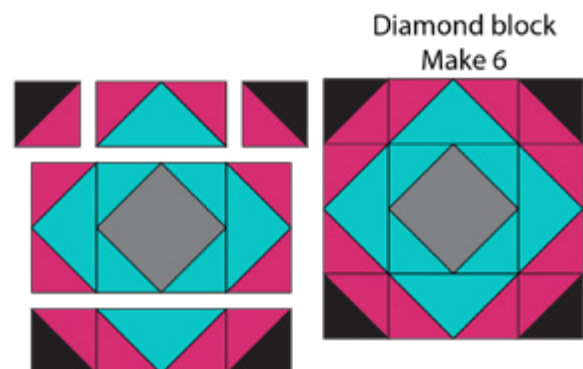

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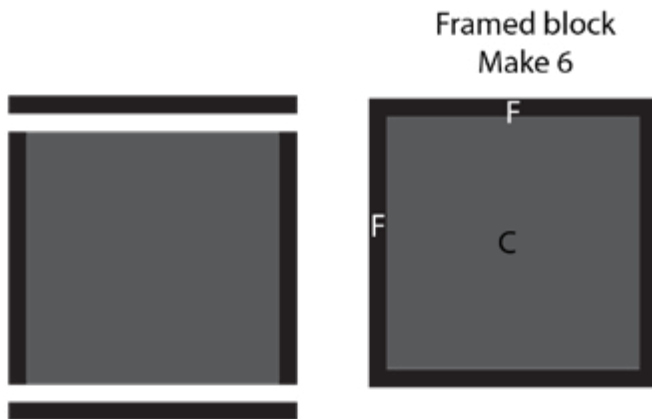
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6. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" **Fabric F** rectangles to opposite sides of (1) 11" **Fabric C** square. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** rectangles to the top and bottom to make (1) Framed Block (**Fig. 5**). Make (6) Framed Blocks measuring $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

7. Lay out (6) Diamond Blocks and (6) Framed Blocks into (4) rows of (3) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the Quilt Center.
8. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
9. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** strip to the top and bottom to make the quilt top which measures $48\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finishing

10. Sew together the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **Fabric F** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
11. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top.
12. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
13. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
14. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

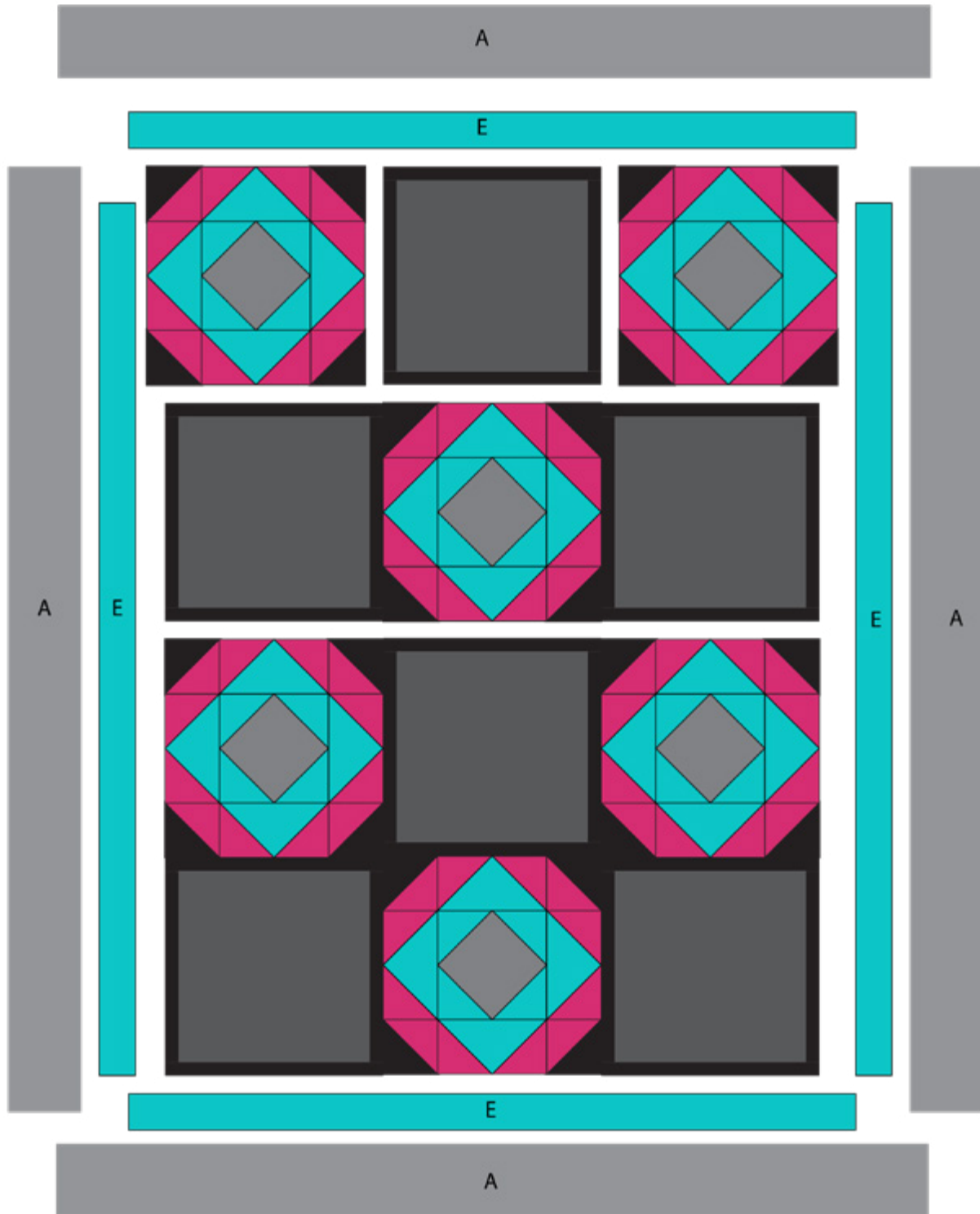
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Quilt Layout



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
