Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Airplanes - Black (A), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Glow Sticks - Black (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Lightning - Black (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Starbursts - Black (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Snowflakes - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Butterflies - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Planets - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Lightbulbs - Black (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Cars - Black (I), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Alphabet Letters - Black (J), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Flashlights - Black (K), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Constellations - Black (L), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Night Sky - Black (M), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Jelly Fish - Black (N), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares and (2) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Fireflies - Black (O), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" squares and (8) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Eclipse - White (P), cut:

- (3) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (15) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (240) 2 ½" squares.
- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (124) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.
- (7) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 1 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Buildings - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 50" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 58" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric P strip to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric P strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.

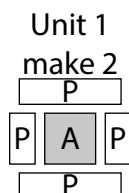

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-15 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 15.

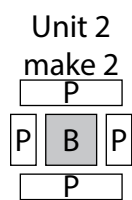

3. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric P square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 16). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 17).

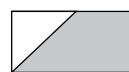

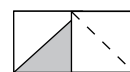

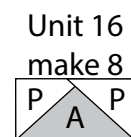

4. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric P square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 16 strip (Fig. 19).

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (8) Unit 16 strips total.

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figures 20-33 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (8) of each unit strip for Unit 17 through Unit 30.

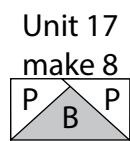

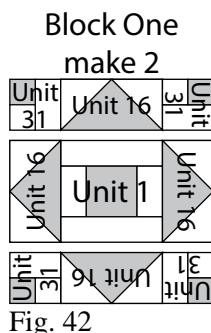
7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric A square to the top of (1) 1 1/2" Fabric P square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric P strip to the right side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 2 1/2" Unit 31 square (Fig. 34). Repeat to make (8) Unit 31 squares total.



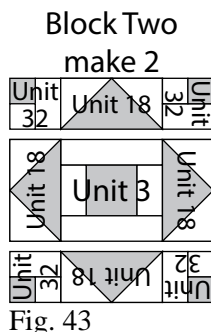
8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 35-41 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (8) of each unit square for Unit 32-38.



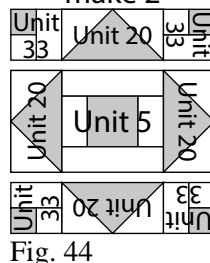
9. Sew (1) Unit 31 to each end of (1) Unit 16 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 16 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 42). Repeat to make a second Block One square.



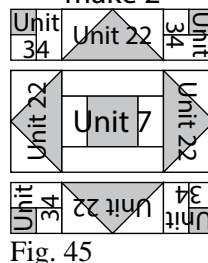
10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figures 43-49 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each block square for Block Two through Block Eight.



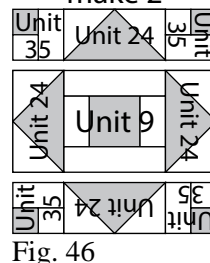

11. Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric P square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 50). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 50). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 51) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 39 squares (Fig. 52). Repeat to make (8) Unit 39 squares total.



12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figures 53-58 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (8) of each unit square for Unit 40 through Unit 45.



13. Sew (1) Unit 39 square to each end of (1) Unit 17 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 17 strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Block Nine square (Fig. 59). Repeat to make a second Block Nine square.

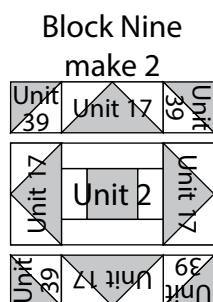

14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Figures 60-65 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each block square for Block Ten through Block Fifteen.

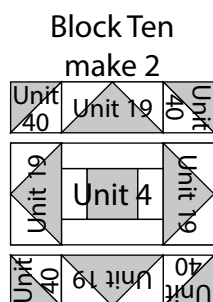

14. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Nine square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Ten square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 66).

15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to Figure 66 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Six.

16. Sew together the (6) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 40 1/2" x 48 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 66).

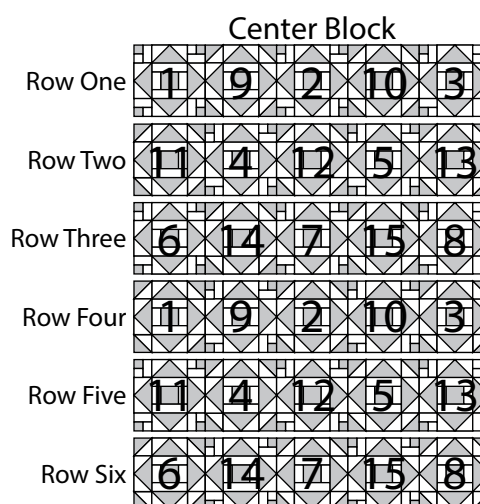

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

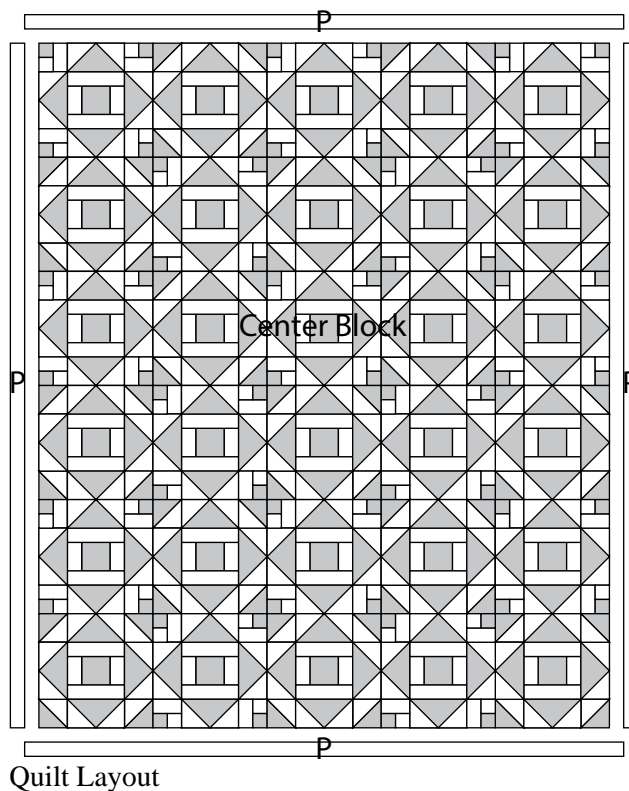
17. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.



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
