## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel - Turquoise (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $81 / 2$ " squares each centered on a block.

From the Jot Dot - Red (B), cut:
-(6) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

- (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 \prime \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Jot Dot - Charcoal (C), cut:
- (3) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $11 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.

From the Starlet - White (D), cut:
-(3) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 481 / 2 "$ strips.

- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $11 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 \prime$ x $121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $151 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Tossed Footprints - White (E), cut:

-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (84) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Letters - Red (F), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Animal Faces - Teal (G), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Animal Silhouettes - Yellow (H), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Patch - Turquoise (I), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Animals and Letters - Turquoise (J), cut: -(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Jot Dot - Fog (K), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $11 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Animals - White (Backing), cut:
-(2) 66 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $66 " \times 81 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4>$ seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $81 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} \gg$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure $91 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$.
Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 11 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.

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3. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 squares total.
4. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 squares total.
5. Sew together (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, in that order from to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 5).
6. Sew together (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 5).
7. Sew the Left Side Border to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew the Bottom Border to the bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Unit 5 square.

8. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) $15 \frac{1}{2}$ ", Block One square (Fig. 6).
9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (6) Block One squares total.

10. Repeat Steps 4-8 and refer to Figures 7-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

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## A TO ZOO

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. Sew (1) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $481 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric J square to each end of (1) $51 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.


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
