





#### **Materials**

1 ½ yards	Jot Dot - Red (B)	9570-88*
3/8 yard	Jot Dot - Charcoal (C)	9570-92
1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>3</sub> yards	Starlet - White (D)	6383-White
½ yard	Tossed Footprints - White (E)	2655-01
1/4 yard	Tossed Letters - Red (F)	2649-88
1/4 yard	Tossed Animal Faces - Teal (G)	2654-67
1/4 yard	Tossed Animal Silhouettes - Yellow (H) 2657-44

## **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Book Panel - Turquoise (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 8 ½" squares each centered on a block.

#### From the Jot Dot - Red (B), cut:

- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

# From the Jot Dot - Charcoal (C), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.

#### From the Starlet - White (D), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.

### From the Tossed Footprints - White (E), cut:

• (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (84) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Tossed Letters - Red (F), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Tossed Animal Faces - Teal (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

## From the Tossed Animal Silhouettes - Yellow (H), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

### From the Patch - Turquoise (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 63 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 ½" x 48 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

# From the Tossed Animals and Letters - Turquoise (J), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.

## From the Jot Dot - Fog (K), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.


# From the Tossed Animals - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 81" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 9** ½" x 9 ½". Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.



3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 squares total.






4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 squares total.



- 5. Sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square and (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square, in that order from to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 5).
- 6. Sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square and (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 5).
- 7. Sew the Left Side Border to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew the Bottom Border to the bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Unit 5 square.



- 8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric D strip to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 15 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) 15 ½" Block One square (Fig. 6).
- 9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (6) Block One squares total.

10. Repeat Steps 4-8 and refer to Figures 7-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.












11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 10). Repeat to make Row Three.

- 12. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 10). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 13. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 11-12, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 45 ½" x 60 ½" Center Block (Fig. 10).




## **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
14. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 15. Sew (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric J square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

- 17. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 18. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 19. Bind as desired.
