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Materials

One 2772P-99 Christmas Panel 24" – Black panel 1/8 yard 2769-41 Chickadees with Flowers - Ivory 1/4 yard 2762-41 Holy - Ivory 1/4 yard 2764-44 Ditsy Trees with Ornaments - Gold 1/4 yard 2766-99 Ornaments - Black 1/4 yard 2765-99 Floral with Paisley - Black 1/3 yard 7101-66 Urban Legend - Hunter 3/8 yard 2763-88 Scroll - Red 1/2 yard 7101-98 Urban Legend - Black 1-1/2 yards 7101-41 Urban Legend - Ivory 3 yards 2770-41 Tossed Ornaments - Ivory

Cut Fabrics

for backing

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 2772P-99 Christmas Panel 24" – Black panel: *Trim to 21-3/4" x 39-3/4."

From 2769-41 Chickadees with Flowers – Ivory, cut: *One 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 3-1/2" squares.

From 2762-41 Holy – Ivory, cut:

*One 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" strips.

*One 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips.

From 2764-44 Ditsy Trees with Ornaments – Gold, cut:

*Four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 2766-99 Ornaments - Black, cut:

*Two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 2-1/2" squares.

From 2765-99 Floral with Paisley – Black, cut: *Four 1-3/4" x WOF strips for border 3.

From 7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter, cut:

*Two 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-two 2" squares. *One 4-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 4-1/4" squares; cut twice diagonally (triangle A).

From 2763-88 Scroll – Red, cut:

*One 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

*One 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips, and

- Four 1-1/8" squares

From 7101-98 Urban Legend – Black, cut:

*Six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 7101-41 Urban Legend – Ivory, cut:

*One 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut sixteen 2" squares.

*Two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:

- Sixteen 2" x 3-1/2" strips

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips

*One 4-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Six 4-1/4" squares; cut twice diagonally. (A)

- Three 3-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (B)

*One 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

- Three 3-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (B)

*One 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips

- Three 3-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (B)

*One 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Twenty 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

- Three 3-7/8" squares (for a total of 12); cut once diagonally. (B)

*Five 1-1/8" x WOF strips for border 4.

*Ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips: four for border 1 and six for border 6.

From 2770-41 Tossed Ornaments – Ivory, cut:

*Two 52" x WOF panels, pieced horizontally.

Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" 2762-41 Holy – Ivory strip to the bottom of a 2-1/2" 2766-99 Or-

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naments – Black square (a). Press the seam toward the strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" Holy – Ivory strip to the left of this unit (b). Press as before. Sew a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" 7101-41 Urban Legend – Ivory strip to the top (c), and a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Urban Legend – Ivory strip to the right (d).






Figure 1 – Make (20) 6-1/2" blocks.

Sew a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" 2763-88 Scroll – Red strip to the bottom (e) and a 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" Red strip to the left (f). Finally, sew a 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" Urban Legend – Ivory strip to the top (g) and a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Ivory strip to the right (h) of the unit (*figure 1*). Repeat to make twenty 6-1/2" blocks.

Note: The blocks can be chain-pieced, i.e., do the same step for all the blocks.




Figure 2 – Make (6) 6-1/2" blocks.

2. Sew a 7101-41 Urban Legend – Ivory triangle A to a 7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter triangle A. Press the seam toward the darker fabric. Sew an Urban Legend – Ivory triangle B to this unit. Press the seam toward triangle B. Repeat to make twenty-four units. Sew the units in rows of two, press the seams in one

direction, then join the rows to make six 6-1/2" blocks (*figure 2*). Press the final seam open.

3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 2"7101-66 Urban Legend – Hunter squares. Noting the line orientation and with right sides together, layer a marked Hunter square on the left short end of a 2"x 3-1/2"7101-41 Urban Legend – Ivory strip and stitch on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch another Hunter square to the opposite end of the same strip (*figure 3*). Repeat to make sixteen 2"x 3-1/2" flying-geese units.

4. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 3 unit to opposite sides of a 3-1/2" 2769-41 Chickadees with Flowers – Ivory square to make the center strips. Press the seams toward the center. Repeat to make four units. Sew a 2" 7101-41 Urban Legend – Ivory square to opposite sides of the remaining Step 3 units to make eight rows. Press the seams away from the center. Sew one row to the top and one to the bottom of the center strips to complete four 6-1/2" blocks (figure 4, next page). Press the seams open.


Assemble Quilt Top

- 5. For border 1, trim two 1-1/2" 7101-41 Urban Legend Ivory border strips to 39-3/4". Sew one strip to each side of the 2772P-99 Christmas Panel 24" Black panel and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the panel through the center. Trim two 1-1/2" Ivory strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 6. For border 2, join the 1-1/2" 2764-44 Ditsy
 Trees with Ornaments Gold strips together
 end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the
 vertical length of the quilt top through the
 center and cut two border strips that length.
 Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top
 and press the seams toward the border strips.
 Measure the width of the quilt top through
 the center. Cut two border strips that length
 and sew one to the top and one to the bottom.
 Press the seams toward the borders.
- 7. Repeat Step 6 with the four 1-7/8" 2765-99 Floral with Paisley Black strips to make and add border 3.
- 8. For border 4, sew together three 1-1/8" 7101-41 Urban Legend Ivory strips and cut two 46-1/2" lengths. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt center and press the seams toward the border strips. Trim the last two 1-1/8" Ivory strips to 28-1/2", sew a 1-1/8" 2763-88 Scroll Red square to both ends of the strips, press the seams toward the squares, and sew one strip to

- the top and one to the bottom. The quilt measures 30-1/2" x 48-1/2" up to here.
- 9. For border 5 and referring to the quilt photo and diagram for block placement and orientation, arrange eight blocks for each side of the quilt. Sew blocks together and sew one border strip to each side of the quilt center. Press the seam toward quilt center.
- 10. Repeat Step 9 with eight assorted blocks on each strip, and sew one border strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center.
- 11. Repeat Step 6 with the last 1-1/2" 7101-41 Urban Legend Ivory strips to make and add border 6.

Finishing

- 12. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
- 13. Join the six 2-1/2" 7101-98 Urban Legend Black binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. With wrong sides together, fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
