#### Materials

Tossed Aliens - White (A)
Starlet - Royal (B)
Planet Dots - Black (C)
Space Ships - Black (D)
Starlet - Red (E)
Alien Collage - Blue (F)

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Aliens - White (A), cut: • (1)  $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

**From the Starlet - Royal (B), cut:** • (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strip.

**From the Planet Dots - Black (C), cut:** • (1) 10 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strip.

**From the Space Ships - Black (D), cut:** • (1) 30 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle.

**From the Starlet - Red (E), cut:** • (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strip.

**From the Alien Collage - Blue (F), cut:** • (1) 10 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strip.

#### **Block Assembly**

*Note:* Use a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance with right sides together *(RST)* unless otherwise noted.

Page 1

1. Fold (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and press.

2. Place the folded Fabric B strip along the long side of (1)  $30 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle, aligning the raw edges and pin in place. Make sure the right side of the Fabric A rectangle is facing up (Fig. 1).

3. Fold (1) 10 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric C strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and press.

4. Place the folded C strip on top of the Fabric A/Fabric B pieces, aligning the raw edges and pin in place (Fig. 2).


### Pillowcases

5. Stitch across the top of the layered fabrics using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig .3).



6. Fold the pillowcase in half width wise, aligning the raw edges of the Fabric A, Fabric B and Fabric C pieces. Pin in place. Stitch down the long side and across the bottom of the folded block unit (Fig. 4).



7. Turn the pillowcase right side out and press to complete Pillowcase One (Fig. 5).



8. Repeat Steps 1-7 and refer to Figure 17 for fabric identification and placement to make Pillowcase Two.


