1/4 yard	Tossed Aliens - White (E)	1990G-01
1/4 yard	Galaxy Stars - Black (F)	1994G-99
⅔ yard	Alien Collage - Blue (G)	1991G-77
3/8 yard	Green Alien Heads - Green (H)	1993G-66
1 ¼ yards	Space Ships with Aliens - Black (I)	1995G-99
5 yards	Space Ships - Black (Backing)	1992G-99

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Alien Panel - 24 inches - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 20 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Starlet - White (B), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 31 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 23 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 66 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 47 ½" strips.

#### From the Planet Dots - Black (C), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 3" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 3 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Starlet - Red (D), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 33 ½" WOF strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tossed Aliens - White (E), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Galaxy Stars - Black (F), cut:

• (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Alien Collage - Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 6 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Green Alien Heads - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Space Ships with Aliens - Black (I), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 68 ½" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 57 ½" strips.

#### From the Space Ships - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 86" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 86" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 23 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure  $22 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



2. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).



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- 3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Step 2-3 to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

5. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (16) assorted 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips and (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

6. Follow Figure 7 and sew together (11) assorted 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.





#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 8. Sew (1) 3" x 42 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 27 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 31 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.
