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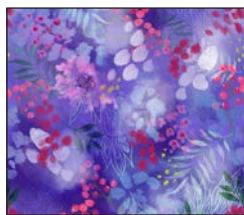

## Materials

*Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.*

One panel 2550P-55 Peacock Panel - Purple  
1/4 yard 9570-60 Jot Dot - Chartreuse  
3/8 yard 2542-60 Tossed Leaves – Chartreuse  
3/8 yard 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow  
1/2 yard 2549-55 Marble - Purple  
3/4 yard 2539-55 Abstract Floral - Purple  
3-7/8 yards 2548-22 Paisley - Pink for backing  
48" x 68" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting

## Cut Fabrics

*Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.*

### From 2550P-55 Peacock Panel – Purple:

\*Trim panel to 22" x 42".

### From 9570-60 Jot Dot – Chartreuse:

\*Cut five 1-1/4" x WOF strips for border 5.

### From 2542-60 Tossed Leaves – Chartreuse:

\*Cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

### From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow:

\*Cut eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips for borders 1 and 3.

### From 2549-55 Marble – Purple:

\*Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

### From 2539-55 Abstract Floral – Purple:

\*Cut five 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

## Assemble Quilt Top

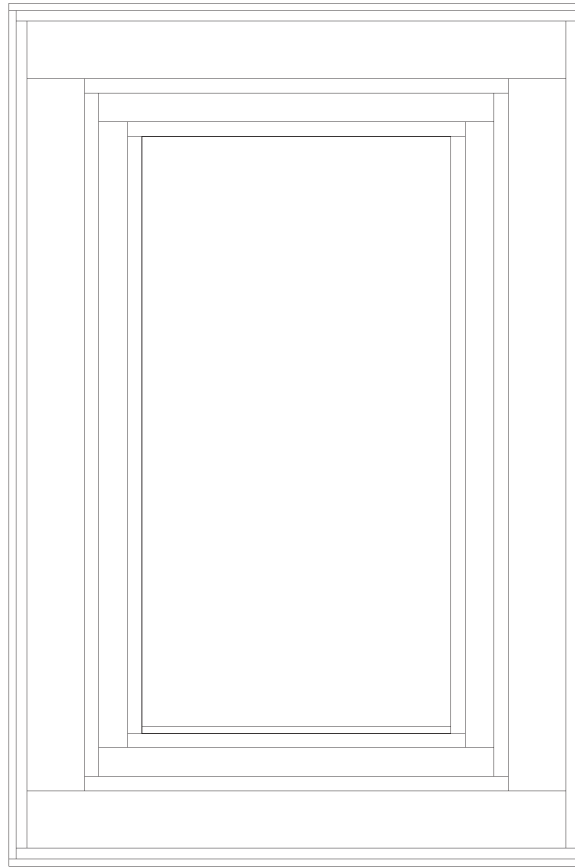
1. For border 1, join all the 1-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. Save remaining long strip for border 3.
2. Repeat Step 1 with the four 2-1/2" 2542-60 Tossed Leaves – Chartreuse strips to make and add border 2.
3. Repeat Step 1 the remaining 1-1/2" Marshmallow long strip to make and add border 3.
4. Repeat Step 1 with the five 4-1/2" 2539-55 Abstract Floral – Purple strips to make and add border 4.

5. Repeat Step 1 with the five 1-1/4" 9570-60 Jot Dot – Chartreuse strips to make and add border 5.

## Finishing

6. Create a sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

7. Join the six 2-1/2" 2549-55 Marble – Purple binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
