## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Large Floral with Bird - Ivory (A), cut:

- (2) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $61 / 2 "$ squares and
(1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ square.

From the Check - Gold (B), cut:

- (1) $57 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $57 / 8 "$ squares and (3) $3 "$ squares.


## From the Tear Drop Floral - Green (C), cut:

-(1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square, (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares and (1) $3 "$ square.

From the Tear Drop Floral - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 3 " square.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.

From the Wavy Floral Stripe - Red (E), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square and (1) $3 "$ square.
- (1) $13 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $13 / 4$ " x $201 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 34$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 23$ " WOF strips.

From the Teepees - Green (F), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares and (1) $3 "$ square.

From the Diamond Stripe - Gold (G), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares and (1) $3 "$ square.

From the Toile - Ivory (H), cut:

- (1) $57 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $57 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
-(1) $3 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3 " x 51 / 2 "$ strips and (4) $3 "$ squares.

From the Floral Stamp - Purple (I), cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square and (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Floral - Teal (J), cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square and (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Floral - Red (K), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 "$ square.
- (4) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 76 \frac{1}{2} \prime \prime$ strips.
- (4) $13 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 74$ " strips.
- (4) $13 / 4$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 63 "$ strips.
- (3) $13 / 4$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Check - Purple (L), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square and (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Circle Clover - Teal (M), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $51 / 2 "$ square and (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Diamond Stripe - Green (N), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 "$ square.

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.

Version \#1 Only
From the Floral Stripe - Ivory (O), cut:

- (4) $6 " \times 78 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(4) $6 " \times 38 "$ LOF strips.


## Version \#2 Only

From the Floral Stripe - Cocoa (O), cut:

- (4) $6 " \times 78 "$ LOF strips.
- (4) 6" x 38" LOF strips.


## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. From the Floral Stamp - Orange ( $\mathbf{P}$ ), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (2) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips.

From the Floral Stamp - Ivory (Q), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (8) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.

From the Teepees - Ivory ( R ), cut:

- (6) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Tear Drop Floral - Cocoa (S), cut:

-(2) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips.
From the Circle Clover - Cocoa (T), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

From the Large Floral with Bird - Cocoa (U), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Large Floral with Bird - Ivory (Backing), cut: -(2) $84 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $84 "$ x $84 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place 3 " Fabric C square on the left side of (1) $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place (1) 3" Fabric B square on the right side of the $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 5-7 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Unit 3 strip and (1) Unit 4 strip.

4. Sew (1) 3" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) 5 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 3 strip together lengthwise to make the middle row. Sew (1) 3" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 5

5. Place (1) $57 / 8 "$ Fabric H square on top of (1) $57 / 8$ "

Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 9). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 10) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $51 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.

6. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 12 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation while using (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip, (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric J square and (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric I square to make

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 13-15 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) Unit 10 strip.

8. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to each end of the Unit 7 strip to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 5 square and (1) Unit 9 strip together to make the middle row. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to each end of (1) Unit 10 strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $201 / 2 "$ Unit 11 square (Fig. 16).
9. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 11 square. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 23 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 11 square to make the Center Block (Fig. 17).

11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figures 19-25 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) of each unit strip for Unit 13 through Unit 19.

12. Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric $Q$ square to each end of (1) Unit 12 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 26).
13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figures 27-33 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block square for Block Two through Block Eight.

14. Sew together (1) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF Fabric D strip, (1) $11 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric Q strip and (1) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF Fabric S strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 34). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
15. Cut the (2) Strip Set 1 's into (32) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$

17. Sew together (1) Unit 20 strip, (1) Unit 21 strip and (1) Unit 22 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 23 square (Fig. 40).
18. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to the left side of (1) Unit 23 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 23 square to the left side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric H square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 24 square (Fig. 41). Repeat to make (16) Unit 24 squares total.

19. Repeat Steps 14-15 and refer to Figures 42-43 for fabric identification, placement and orientation while using (3) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric H strips and (3) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric U strips to make (32) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Unit 25 strips.
20. Sew (2) Unit 25 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 26 square (Fig. 44). Repeat to make (16) Unit 26 squares total.
21. Sew (1) Unit 26 square to the left side of (1) Unit 24 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 24 square to the left side of (1) Unit 26 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2$ " Block Nine square (Fig. 45). Repeat to make (8) Block Nine squares total.

22. Sew (1) Block Nine square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block One square to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 46).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the appropriate Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top. Only the Fabric $O$ strips are difference between the two different quilt versions.)
26. Center (1) 6 " x 38 " Fabric O strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
27. Repeat Step 26 to sew (1) 6" x 38 " Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 50).
28. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 50), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

29. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 34$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
30. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
31. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " $601 / 2 "$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 63 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
32. Repeat Steps 26-28 and refer to the quilt layout (Version \# 1 or Version \#2) and Figure 50 for fabric identification, placement and orientation while using (4) $6 " \times 78 "$ Fabric O strips to add the borders to the Center Block.
33. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 74$ " Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 \times 761 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
34. Layer and quilt as desired.
35. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric U strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
36. Bind as desired.
