## Atelier - Fabrics in the Collection



Selected fabrics from the Jot Dot Collection


Materials
Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

One 2599P-35 Sewing Boutique 24" Panel - Tan 3/8 yard 2598-11 Measuring Tape - Lt. Blue 3/8 yard 2591-35 Tossed Sewing Items - Tan 3/8 yard 2594-11 Tossed Scissors - Lt. Blue 1/2 yard 2592-77 Tossed Thimbles \& Pins - Dk. Blue 1/2 yard 2596-77 Buttons - Dk. Blue
5/8 yard 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow
$2 / 3$ yard 9570-75 Jot Dot - Ocean
2-7/8 yards 2590-35 Dresses Bags \& Shoes in Blocks - Tan for backing
$48 "$ x $68 "$ piece of Air Lite ${ }^{\circledR}$ Colour Me 100\%
Cotton batting

## Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

## From 2599P-35 Sewing Boutique 24" Panel - Tan:

 *Trim to 22 " x 42".
## From 2598-11 Measuring Tape - Lt. Blue:

*Cut two 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty $1-3 / 4$ " squares.
*Cut one $4-1 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten $2-1 / 8$ " x 4-1/2" strips.

From 2591-35 Tossed Sewing Items - Tan:
*Cut three $1-3 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut sixty-four $1-3 / 4$ " squares.
*Cut one $4-1 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut sixteen $2-1 / 8$ " x 4-1/2" strips.

From 2594-11 Tossed Scissors - Lt. Blue:
*Cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.
From 2592-77 Tossed Thimbles \& Pins - Dk. Blue:
*Cut two $1-3 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $1-3 / 4$ " squares.
*Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twelve $2-1 / 8$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " strips and four $4-1 / 2$ " squares.

From 2596-77 Buttons - Dk. Blue:
*Cut five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

## From 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow:

*Cut one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut sixteen $2-1 / 2$ " squares.
*Cut four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut seventy-six $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " strips.

## From 9570-75 Jot Dot - Ocean:

*Cut four 1-3/4" x WOF strips for border 1.
*Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

## Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 1-3/4" 2592-77 Tossed Thimbles \& Pins - Dk. Blue squares. Noting the line orientation and with right sides together, layer a marked Dk. Blue square on the left short end of a $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow strip and stitch on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch another Dk. Blue square to the opposite end of the strip. Repeat to make twenty-four $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " units.

Repeat this step with the 1-3/4" 2591-35 Tossed Sewing Items - Tan, the 1-3/4" 2598-11 Measuring Tape - Lt. Blue squares, and the remaining $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow strips (figure 1).


Figure 1 - Make 76 assorted $1-3 / 4$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " units.
2. Matching fabrics, sew one Step 1 unit to opposite sides of one $2-1 / 8$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " print strip. Repeat with all the Step 1 units and the $2-1 / 8$ " $\times 4-1 / 2$ " strips to make thirty-eight assorted 4-1/2" blocks (figure 2). Press the seams toward the center.


Figure 2 - Make 38 assorted 4-1/2" blocks.
3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 2-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow squares. With right sides together, place one marked Marshmallow square on a corner of one 4-1/2" 2592-77 Tossed Thimbles \& Pins - Dk. Blue square and stitch on the drawn line. Repeat with the opposite corner of the same square. Trim seam allowances to $1 / 4$ " and press open. Repeat with the other corners of the square (figure 3). Make four 4-1/2" blocks.

## Assemble Quilt Top

4. For border 1, trim two 1-3/4" 9570-75 Jot Dot Ocean border strips to 42 ". Sew one strip to each side of the 2599P-35 Sewing Boutique 24" Panel - Tan and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the panel through the center. Trim two Ocean strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
5. For border 2, join the 2-1/2" 2594-11 Tossed Scissors - Lt. Blue strips together end to end using
diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. The quilt measures $28-1 / 2$ " $\mathrm{x} 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ up to here.
6. For border 3 and referring to the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, arrange twelve Step 2 blocks for each side of the quilt. Sew blocks together and sew one border strip to each side of the quilt center. Press the seam toward quilt center.
7. Repeat Step 6 with seven Step 2 and two Step 3 blocks and sew one border strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center.
8. Repeat Step 5 with the five 2-1/2" 2596-77 Buttons - Dk. Blue strips to make and add border 4.

## Finishing

9. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
10. Join the six 2-1/2" 9570-75 Jot Dot - Ocean binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
