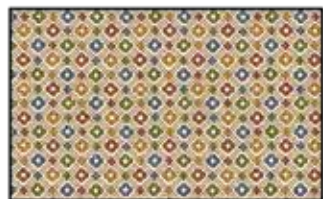

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### Materials

(1) Fat ¼ Bundle	Barn Dance Fat ¼ Bundle - Multi (A)	
1 ⅔ yards	Twig with Dots - Ivory (B)	1075-41
1 ⅔ yards	Twig Wreaths - Ivory (C)	1074-41
⅔ yard	Floral Geo - Ecrú (D)	1081-47
⅞ yard	Twig with Dots - Red (E)	1075-88
¾ yard	Weave Texture - Brown (F)	1078-39*
7 ½ yards	Quilt Stars - Ecrú (Backing)	1080-47

\*Includes binding

Batting: 90" x 90"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Barn Dance Fat ¼ Bundle - Multi (A), cut:

- From each of (18) Medium and Dark Fat ¼'s:
- (2) 5 ¼" squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (8) 5 ¼" triangles.
- (8) Template 2 triangles.
- (8) Template 4 diamonds.

#### From the Twig with Dots - Ivory (B), cut:

- (144) Template 1 triangles.
- (144) Template 3 triangles.

#### From the Twig Wreaths - Ivory (C), cut:

- (144) Template 1 triangles.
- (144) Template 3 triangles.

#### From the Floral Geo - Ecrú (D), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 76 ½" strips.

#### From the Twig with Dots - Red (E), cut:

- (4) 3 ¼" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ¼" x 76 ½" strips.
- (4) 3 ¼" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ¼" x 82" strips.

#### From the Weave Texture - Brown (F), cut:

- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Quilt Stars - Ecrú (Backing), cut:

- (3) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 90" x 90" back.

### Block Assembly

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.**

1. Place (1) Fabric C-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 1). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

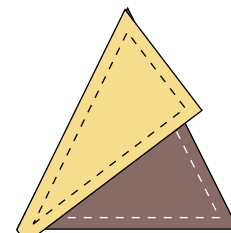

2. Place (1) Fabric C-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 2). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) Unit 1 block. Trim the block to measure 4 ½" square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 3).

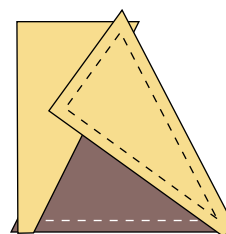

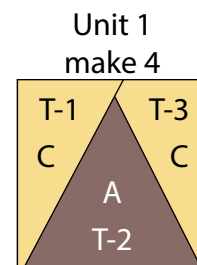

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 2 square, (1) 4 ½" Unit 3 square, (1) 4 ½" Unit 4 square and (1) 4 ½" Unit 5 square.

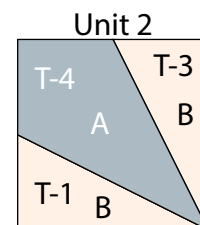

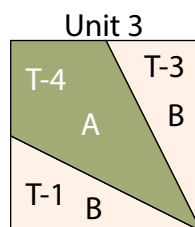

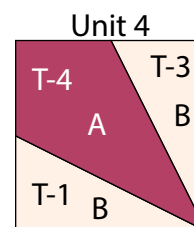

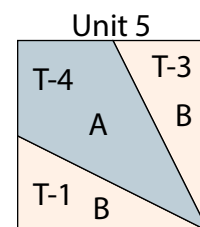

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5. Sew (4) assorted  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric A triangles together to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 6 square (Fig. 8).

6. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 1 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.

7. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 6 square to make Row Two.

8. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 1 square and (1) Unit 5 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three.

9. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 6-8 together, in numerical, order to make (1) Finished Block (Fig. 8).

10. Repeat Steps 1-9 to make (36) Finished Blocks total.

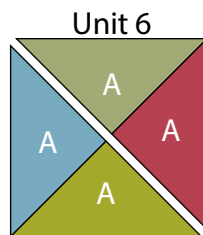

make 36

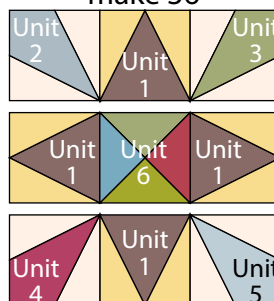

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

11. Sew (6) Finished Blocks together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (6) rows total.

12. Sew the (6) rows together to make the Center Block.

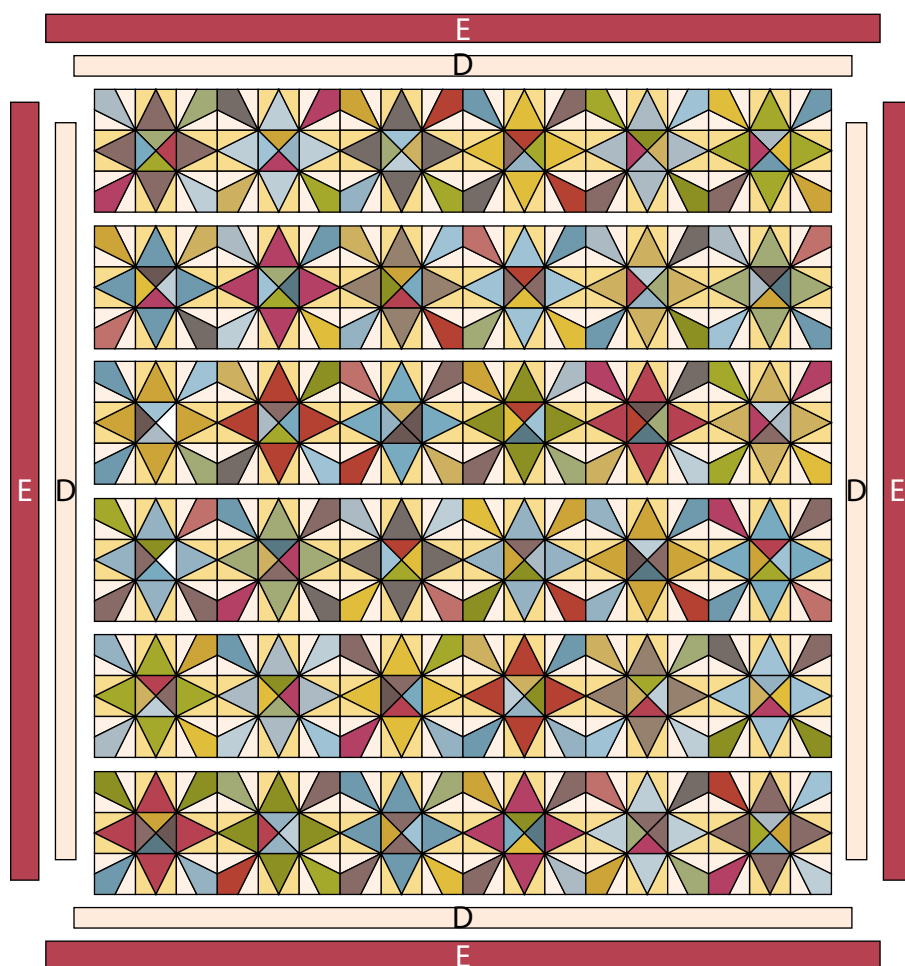
13. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $72\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $76\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $76\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $82$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

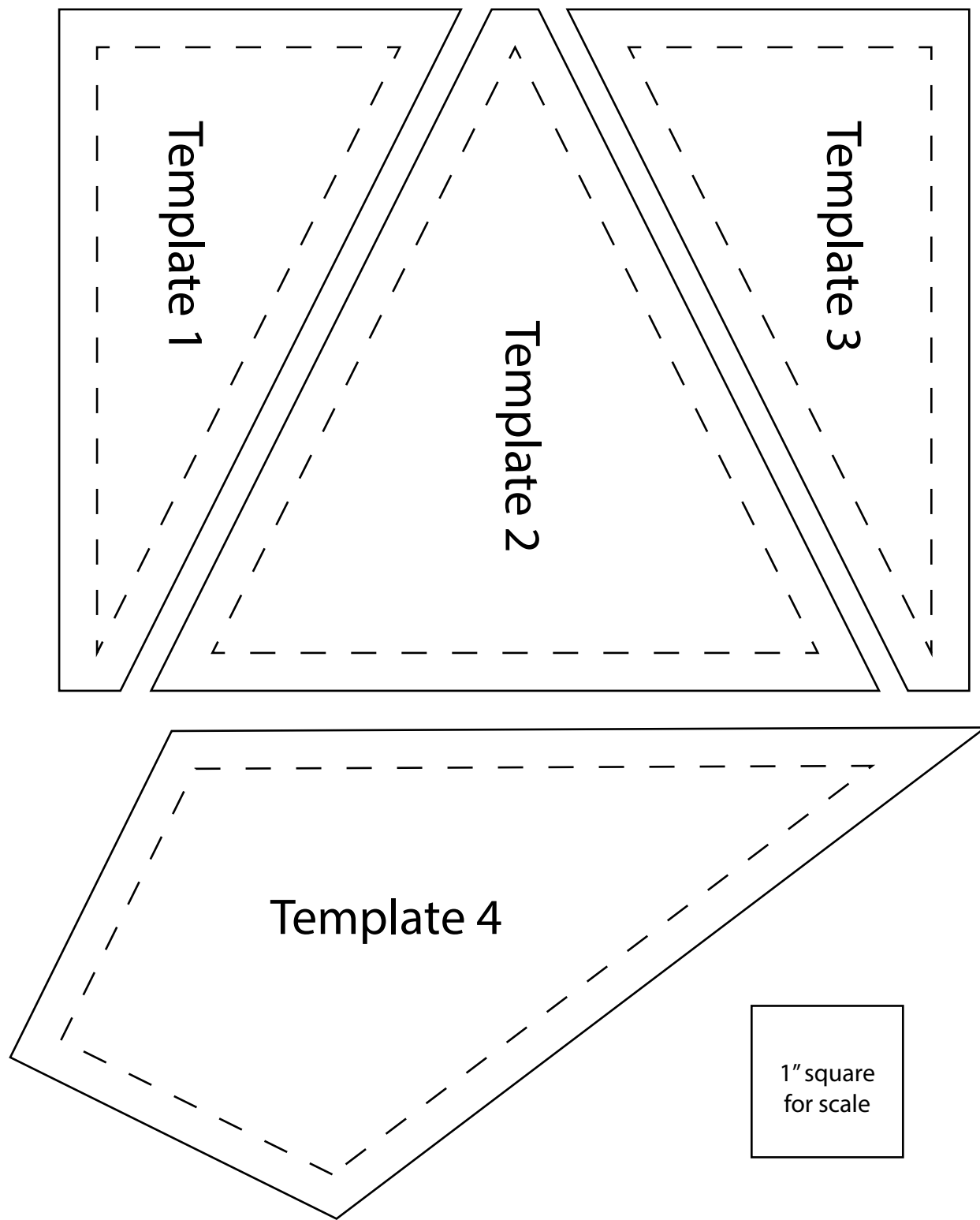
16. Sew the (9)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
