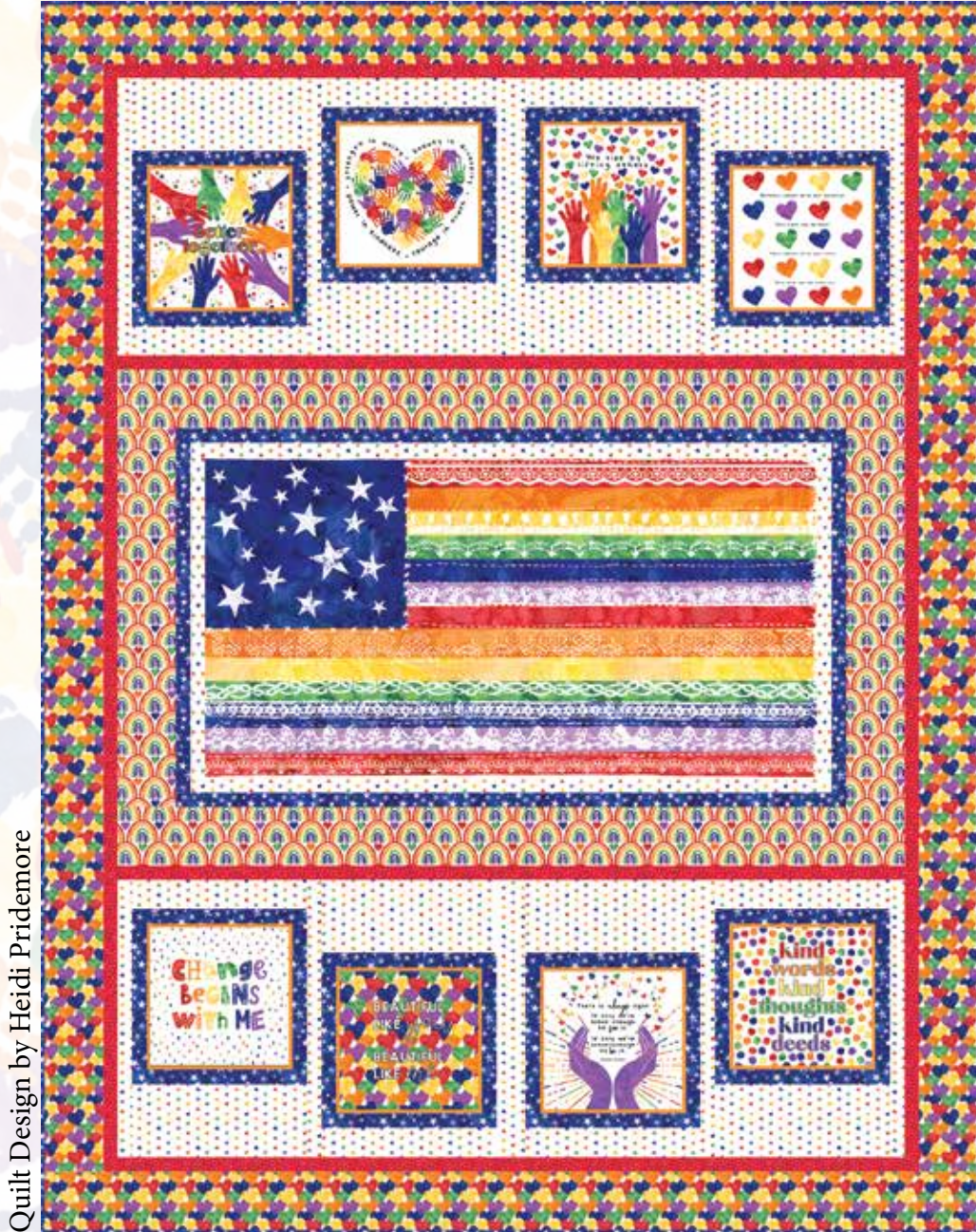

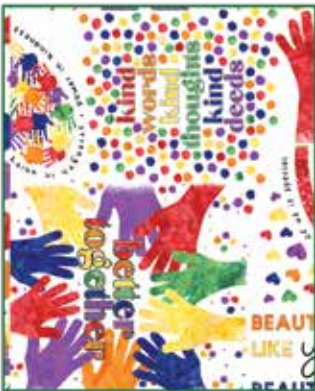

1 1/3 yards	Tossed Mini Hearts - White/Multi (B)	2206-01
1 1/2 yards	Stars - Navy (C)	2208-77*
7/8 yard	Rainbow with Hearts - White/Multi (D)	2205-01
5/8 yard	Starlet Basics - Red (E)	6383-Red
2 1/4 yards	Allover Hearts - White/Multi (F)	2210-01
2/3 yard	Blocks - White/Multi (G)	2212-01
5 1/4 yards	Inspirational Sayings - White/Multi (Backing)	2211-01

*Includes binding

Batting: 72" x 92"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Rainbow Flag - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 42 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Tossed Mini Hearts - White/Multi (B), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x OF strips. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 19 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 22 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" strips.

From the Stars - Navy (C), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Rainbow with Hearts - White/Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 26 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Starlet Basics - Red (E), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 74 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.

From the Allover Hearts - White/Multi (F), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Blocks - White/Multi (G):

- Fussy cut (8) 10 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

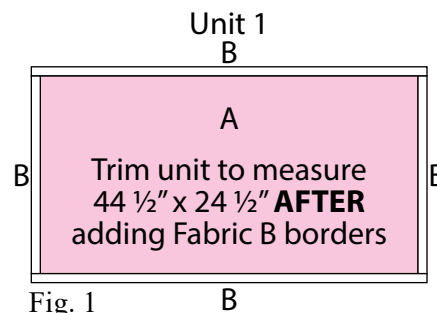
From the Inspirational Sayings - White/Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 92" back.

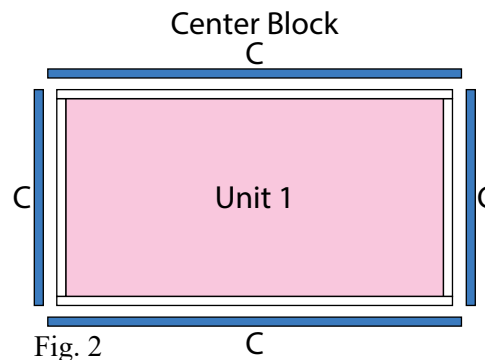
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

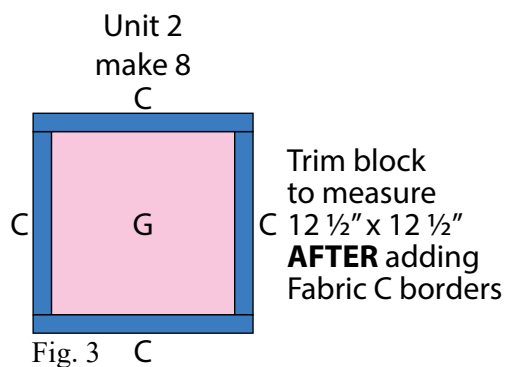
- Sew (1) 2" x 22 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 42 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 45 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 44 1/2" x 24 1/2"**.



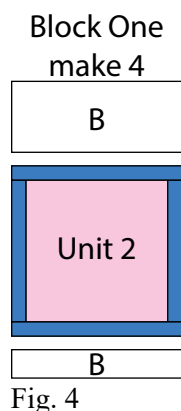
- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the 46 1/2" x 26 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 2).



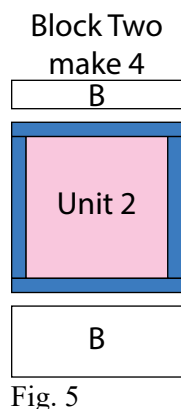
3. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.



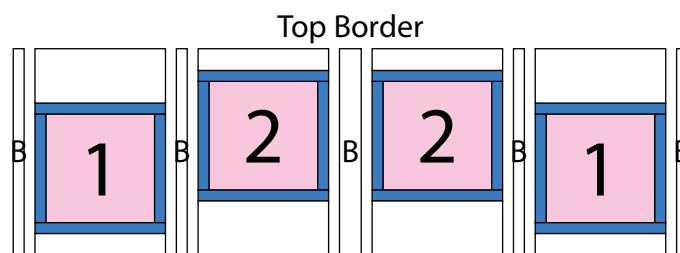
4. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" x 19 1/2" Block One rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One rectangles total.



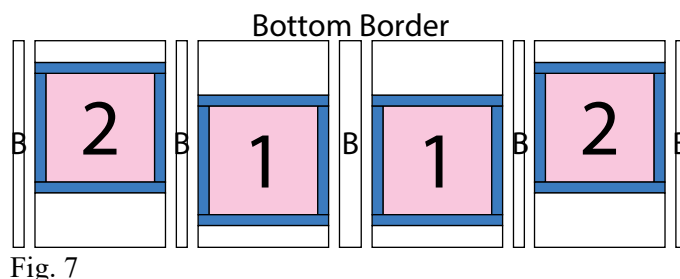
5. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square lengthwise. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" x 19 1/2" Block Two rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Block Two rectangles total.



6. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 2 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border.



7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

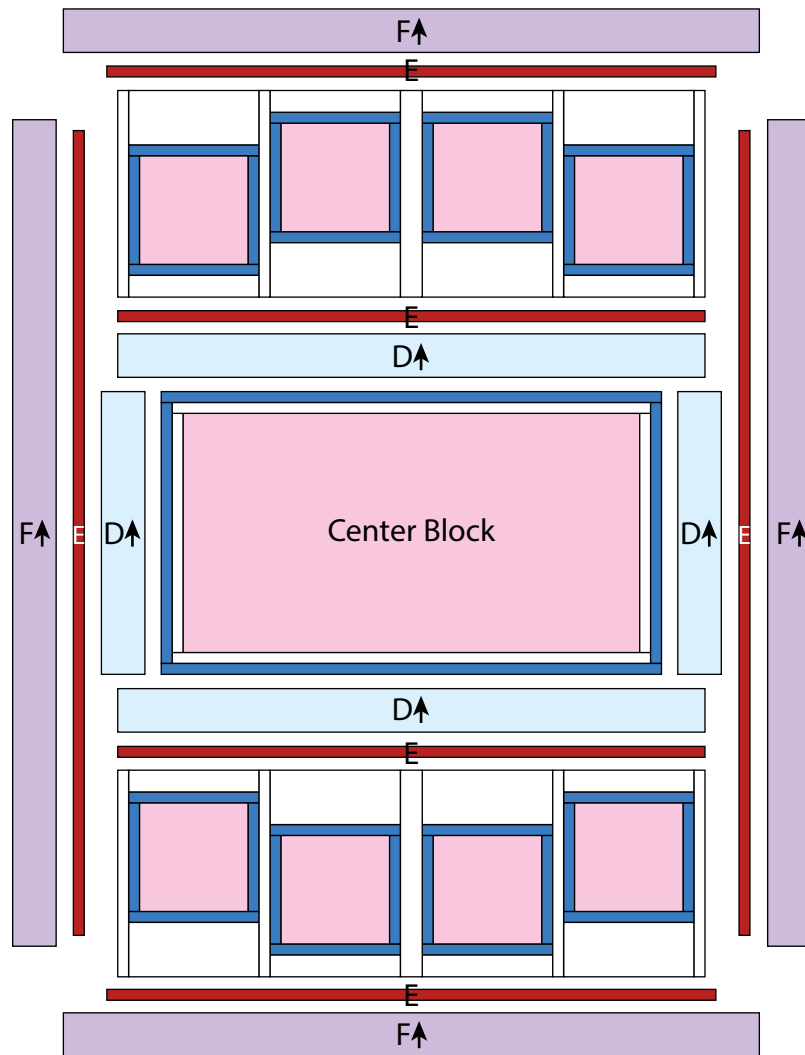
11. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 74 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
