$11 / 3$ yards Tossed Mini Hearts - White/Multi (B) 2206-01
$11 / 2$ yards Stars - Navy (C) 2208-77*
$7 / 8$ yard Rainbow with Hearts - White/Multi (D)2205-01
$5 / 8$ yard Starlet Basics - Red (E) 6383-Red
$21 / 4$ yards Allover Hearts - White/Multi (F) 2210-01
2/3 yard Blocks - White/Multi (G) 2212-01
$51 / 4$ yards Inspirational Sayings - White/Multi (Backing)
2211-01
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Rainbow Flag - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $421 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Tossed Mini Hearts - White/Multi (B), cut:

- (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ OF strips. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 "$ x $191 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 221 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Stars - Navy (C), cut:
- (4) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $2 "$ x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $2 "$ x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $241 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 461 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Rainbow with Hearts - White/Multi (D), cut:
- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.


## From the Starlet Basics - Red (E), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2$ "x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 741 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Allover Hearts - White/Multi (F), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 761 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.


## From the Blocks - White/Multi (G):

- Fussy cut (8) $101 / 2 \prime$ squares, each centered on a block.

From the Inspirational Sayings - White/Multi (Backing), cut:
-(2) $92 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $72 " \times 92 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "' seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $421 / 2 " x 221 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $451 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $441 / 2 "$ x $241 / 2 "$ 。

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the $461 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (1) $2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric G square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ x $121 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square lengthwise. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ Block One rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One rectangles total.

6. Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 19 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 191 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 191 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 191 / 2$ " Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 26 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 7 \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $56 \frac{1}{2} \prime$ ' Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 76 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (8) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
