## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Solar System Panel-24 inches - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $22 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Suns - Yellow (B), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Rockets - Sky Blue (C), cut:
-(2) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Sky with Clouds - Sky Blue (D), cut:
- (2) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Starlet - Kelly (E), cut:

-(1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 8 "$ squares.

## From the Starlet - Turquoise (F), cut:

-(1) $33 / 8>x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 8$ squares.
From the Stars - Navy (G), cut:
-(3) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $33 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Starlet - Yellow (H), cut:
-(2) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $33 / 8$ " squares.

From the Planets - Navy (I), cut:
-(3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ strips.

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 391 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Astronauts, Planets and Rockets - Navy (J), cut: -(4) $6 \frac{1}{2} "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2} \prime \prime \times 611 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Astronauts - Navy (Backing), cut:
-(2) $61 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $61 " x 81 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ x $261 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $251 / 2 " \times 451 / 2$ ".

2. Place (1) $33 / 8$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) $33 / 8$ " Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.


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3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-6 for fabric identification and location to make (32) Unit 2 squares and (16) Unit 3 squares.
4. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $51 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (16) Block One squares total.

5. Sew together (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block One square, (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square, (1) Block One square, (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric D square, (1) Block One square, (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric C square, (1) Block One square and (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 8).
6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 9-11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
8. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1 / 2 "}{2 \prime} \times 61 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
