Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel-36inches - Navy (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 8 ¹/₂" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Starlet - White (B), cut:

(6) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.
(6) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Sky with Clouds - Sky Blue (C), cut:

• (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (52) 3" squares.

From the Astronauts - Navy (D), cut:

• (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 3" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Rockets - Sky Blue (E), cut:

• (2) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Planets - Navy (F), cut:

• (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) 3" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Suns - Yellow (G), cut:

- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 45 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 47 ¹/₂" strips.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Astronauts, Planets and Rockets - Navy (H), cut:

- (3) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 47 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 57 ¹/₂" strips.


From the Stars - Navy (Backing), cut:

• (2) 65" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 65" back.


Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ¹/₂" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure** 9 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂". Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.



2. Sew (1) 3" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (13) Block Two squares total.



3. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 3). Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.


4. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 3). Repeat to make Row Four.

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5. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 3-4, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $45 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $45 \frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 3).



Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 6. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

8. Layer and quilt as desired.

9. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired.



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
