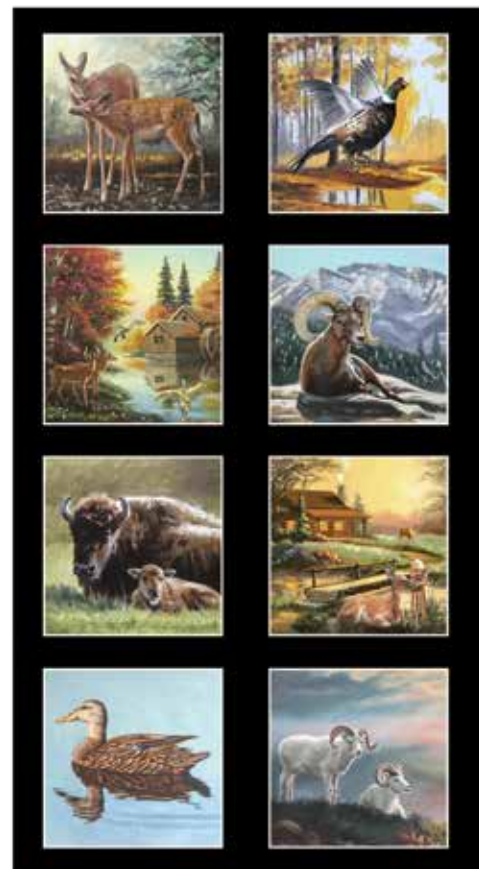

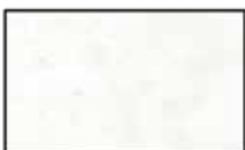

1 1/8 yards (1.03 m)	Urban Legend - Chocolate (B)	7101-37
7/8 yard (0.81 m)	National Treasure - Autumn Leaves (C)	8625-30
1/4 yard (0.23 m)	Grass Texture - Sage (D)	2955-66
1/3 yard (0.31 m)	Buffalo in Grass - Sage (E)	2948-66
1/3 yard (0.31 m)	Scenic Watermill - Amber (F)	2950-33
1/3 yard (0.31 m)	Ducks in Water - Sky Blue (G)	2952-11
1/3 yard (0.31 m)	Flying Quails - Sky Blue (H)	2949-11
5/8 yard (0.58 m)	Urban Legend - White (I)	7101-01
1/4 yard (0.23 m)	Water Ripples - Blue (J)	2954-11

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Continuous Blocks - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (8) 9 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (B), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 1/2" strips.

From the National Treasure - Autumn Leaves (C), cut:

- (11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the Grass Texture - Sage (D), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Buffalo in Grass - Sage (E), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Scenic Watermill - Amber (F), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Ducks in Water - Sky Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Flying Quails - Sky Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (I), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips.

From the Water Ripples - Blue (J), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Ivory (K), cut:

- (11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the Flying Ducks with Clouds - Blue (L), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Terra (M), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tonal Deer - Tan (Backing), cut:

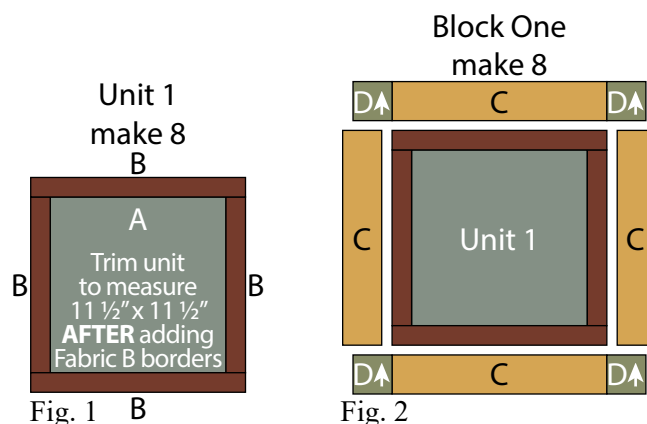
- (2) 71" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 71" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 11 1/2" x 11 1/2"**. Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 15 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.



3. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square to each end of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.

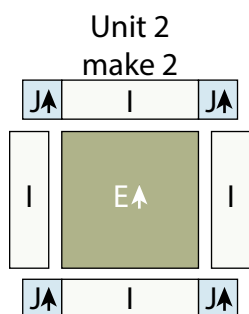

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Unit 3 squares, (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) Unit 5 squares.

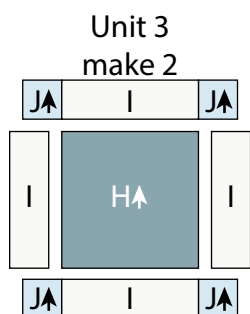

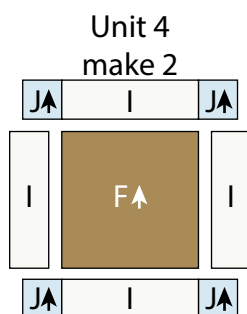

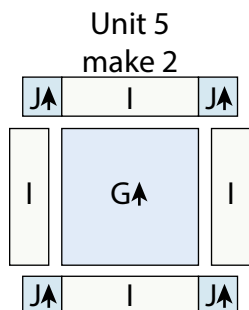

5. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square to each end of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric L square to make (1) $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.

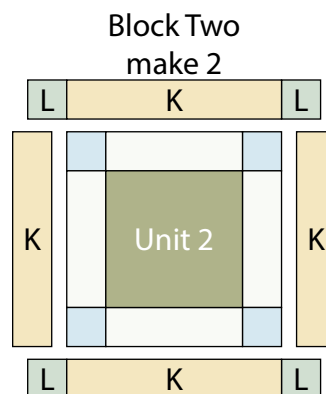

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 8-10 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares and (2) Block Five squares.

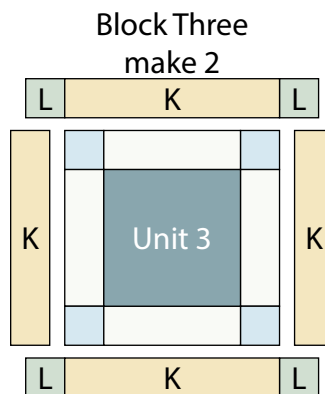

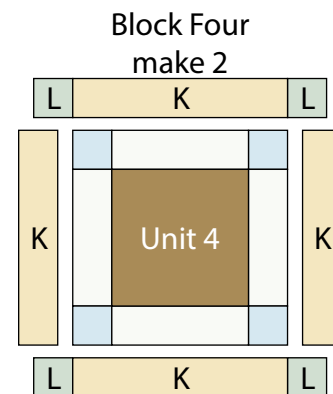

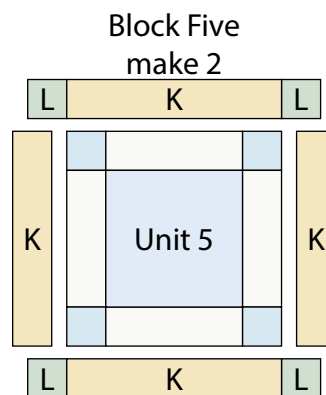

7. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 11).

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.

9. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 7-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 60 ½" x 60 ½" Center Block (Fig. 11).

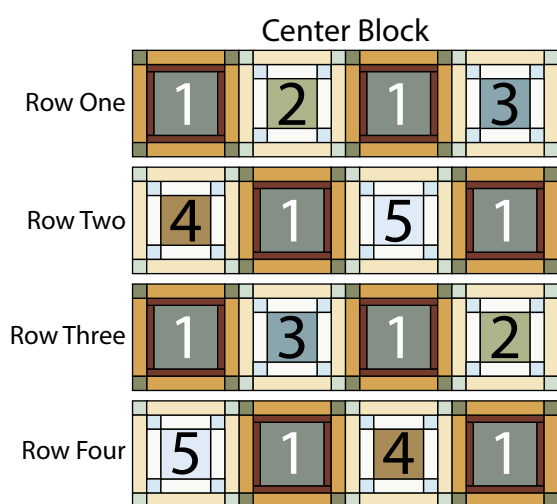

Quilt Top Assembly

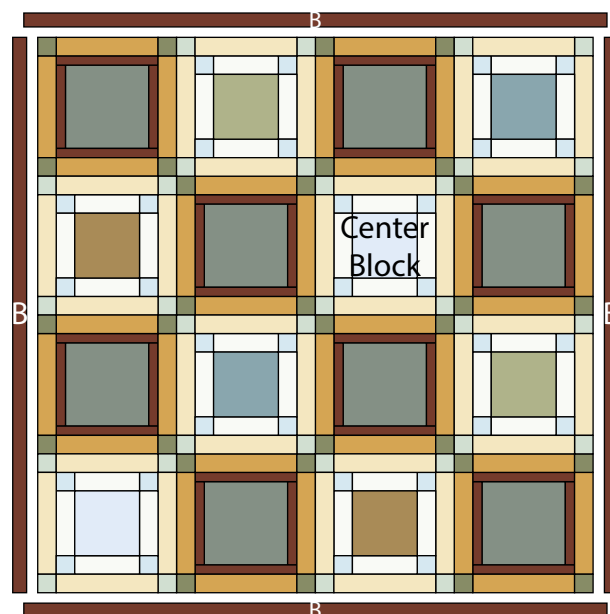
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
