







¾ yard (0.69 m)	Urban Legend - Terra (B)	7101-33
1 ¼ yards (1.15 m)	Grass Texture - Sage (C)	2955-66
1 ⅞ yards (1.03 m)	Urban Legend - Chocolate (D)	7101-37*
½ yard (0.46 m)	Tonal Deer - Tan (E)	2957-30
⅞ yard (0.81 m)	Urban Legend - White (F)	7101-01
¼ yard (0.23 m)	Flying Ducks with Clouds - Blue (G)	2956-11
⅓ yard (0.35 m)	Urban Legend - Ivory (H)	7101-41
1 ⅔ yards (1.53 m)	Flying Quails - Sky Blue (I)	2949-11

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Scenic Watermill - Amber (A), cut:

- Fussy cut (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Urban Legend - Terra (B), cut:

- (2) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ¼" triangles.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Grass Texture - Sage (C), cut:

- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper right to the lower left to make (96) 3 ⅞" right to left triangles.  
*Note: You will use (48) 3 ⅞" triangles.*
- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper left to the lower right to make (96) 3 ⅞" left to right triangles.  
*Note: You will use (48) 3 ⅞" triangles.*

#### From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (D), cut:

- (2) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ¼" triangles.
- (3) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 53" strips.
- (3) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 43 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tonal Deer - Tan (E), cut:

- (3) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Urban Legend - White (F), cut:

- (2) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ¼" triangles.
- (3) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Flying Ducks with Clouds - Blue (G), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" squares.

#### From the Urban Legend - Ivory (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 50 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ¾" x 41" WOF strips.

#### From the Flying Quails - Sky Blue (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 55 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 ½" x 53 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the Foliage - Amber (J), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Buffalo in Grass - Sage (K), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Scenic Blocks - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 73" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 73" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Place (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric E square on top of (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (48) Unit 1 squares total.



## Quilt 2


2. Sew (1) 4 1/4" Fabric D triangle and (1) 4 1/4" Fabric F triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) 3 7/8" Fabric C triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 squares total.




3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) of each unit square for Unit 3 through Unit 5.




4. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the bottom right corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (24) Unit 6 squares total.




5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figures 10-12 for component identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (24) of each unit square for Unit 7 through Unit 9.




6. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (24) Unit 10 strips total.





7. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the left side of (1) Unit 9 square to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (24) Unit 11 strips total.




8. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 10 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (3) Block One squares total.



9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 16-17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two squares and (6) Block Three squares.



10. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Three square to make Row One (Fig. 18).
11. Sew (1) Block Three square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row Two (Fig. 18).
12. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block Three square to make Row Three (Fig. 18).
13. Sew the (1) Block Three square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Four (Fig. 18).
14. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 10-13 lengthwise to make the 36 1/2" x 48 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 18).



### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*


15. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 50 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 41" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 53" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 43 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 55 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 53 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.



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
