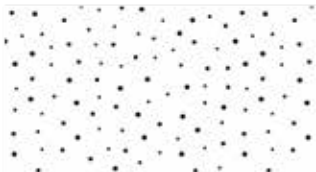

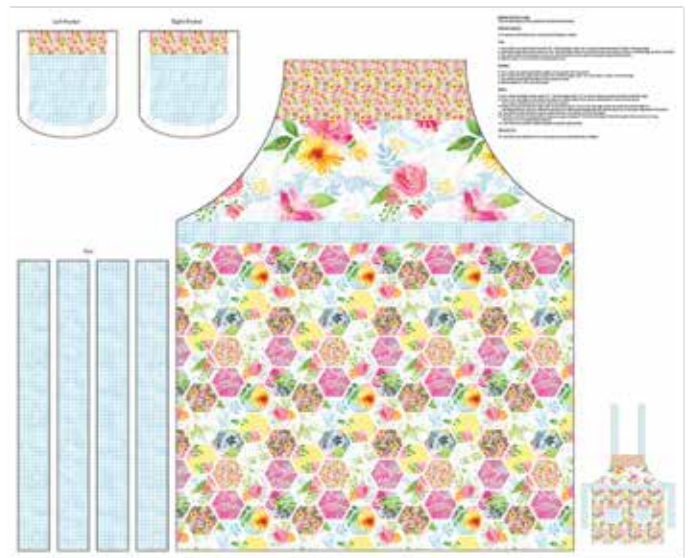

½ yard	Mini Packed Floral - Pink (C)	1111-22
½ yard	Wreaths - White (D)	1113-01
¾ yard	Large Floral with Wreaths - Light Blue (E)	1109-11
⅓ yard	Urban Legend - Gray (F)	7101-90
½ yard	Wreaths - Pink (G)	1113-22
½ yard	Urban Legend - Dark Pink (H)	7101-22
½ yard	Floral with Dot - Yellow (I)	1114-44
½ yard	Dot - White (J)	1118-01
⅓ yard	Urban Legend - Olive (K)	7101-65
1 ¼ yards	Large Floral with Wreaths - White (L)	1109-01
3 ½ yards	Hexis - White (Backing)	1110-01

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - White (A), cut:

- (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strip.

From the Mini Houndstooth - Light Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Mini Packed Floral - Pink (C), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ½" squares.

From the Wreaths - White (D), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (22) 4 ½" squares.

From the Large Floral with Wreaths - Light Blue (E), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 4 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Gray (F), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.

From the Wreaths - Pink (G), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (84) 2 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Dark Pink (H), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (84) 2 ½" squares.

From the Floral with Dot - Yellow (I), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 ½" squares.

From the Dot - White (J), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Olive (K), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.

From the Large Floral with Wreaths - White, cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

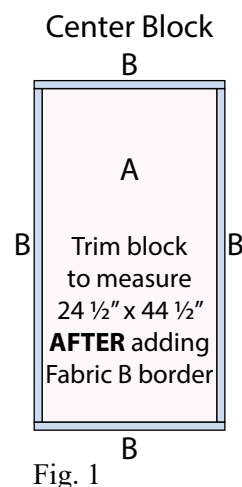
From the Hexis - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 60" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 80" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. **Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½"** to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric I square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

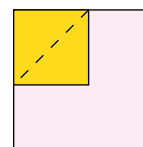

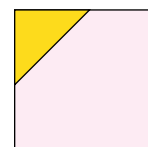

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric G square to the upper right corner, (1) 2 ½" Fabric I square to the lower left corner and (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square to the lower right corner of the 4 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).

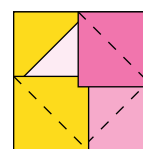

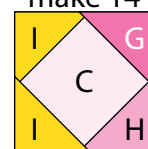

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (14) Unit 1 squares total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-16 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 12.

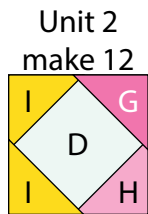

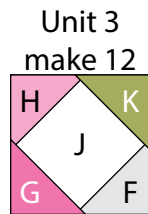

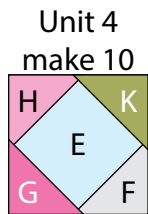

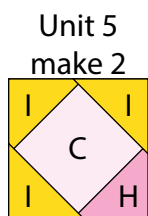

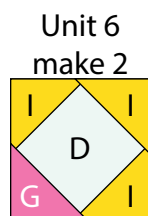

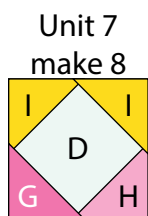

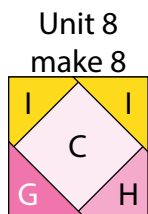

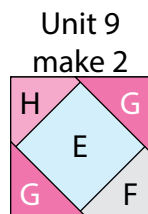

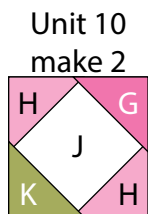

6. Follow Figure 17 and sew together (22) assorted unit squares into a 2 x 11 column to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

7. Follow Figure 18 and sew together (20) assorted unit squares into a 2 x 10 row to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

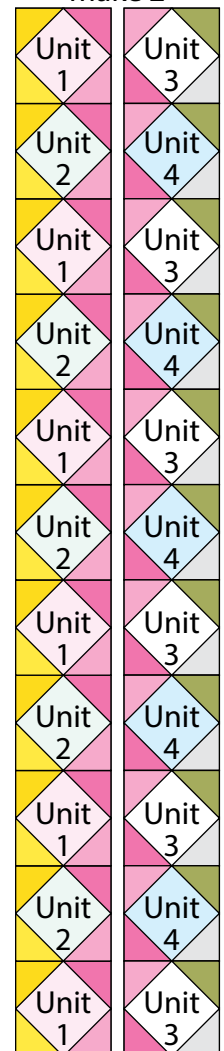

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

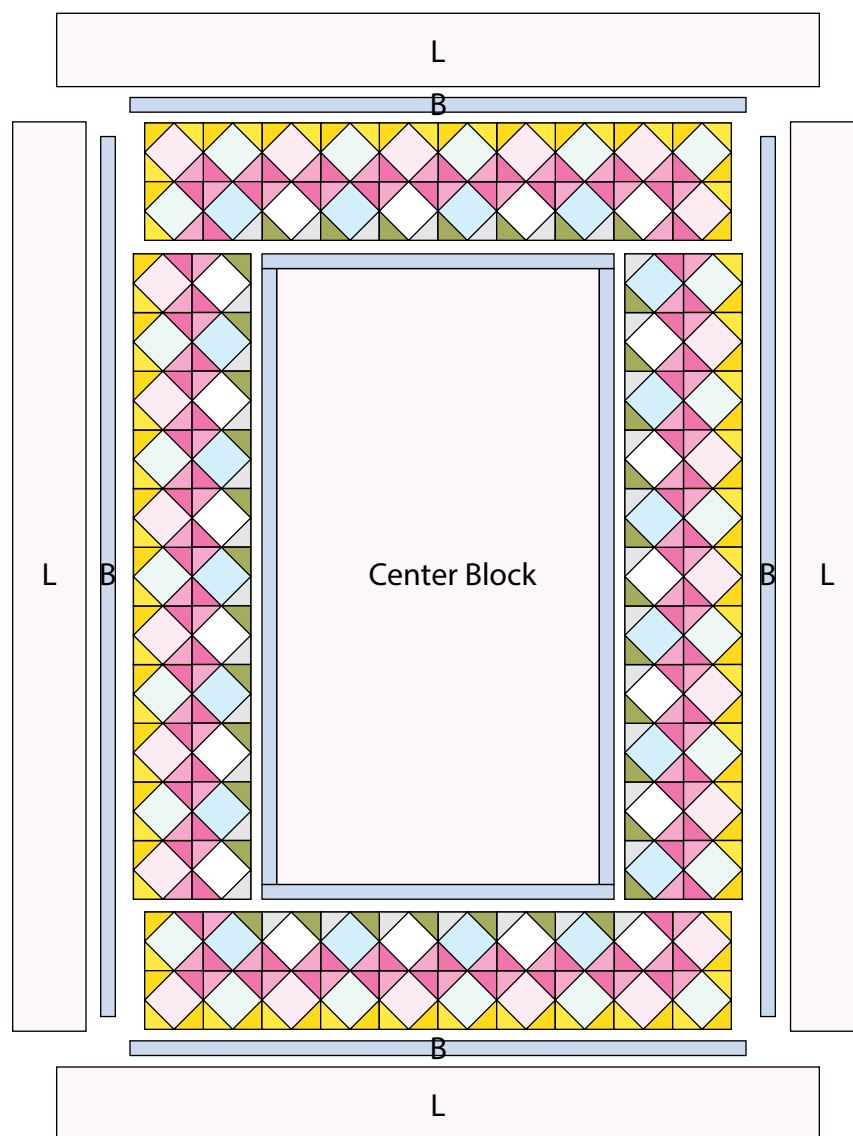
9. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
