⅓ yard	Urban Legend - Dark Purple (I)	7101-55*
3 ¹ / ₄ yards	Halloween Stripe - Purple (J)	1040G-55
4 yards	Tossed Pumpkins - Purple (Backing)	1039G-55

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Halloween Panel - Orange (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 21 ½" x 41 ½" panel.

From the Urban Legend - Orange (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Black (C), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.

From the Flying Witches - Purple (D), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x 44 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Moons - Black (E), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

From the Ghosts and Goblins - Black (F), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

From the Halloween Pumpkins - Orange (G), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares and (4) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (H), cut:

• (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Dark Purple (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Halloween Stripe - Purple (J), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 62 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 50 ½" LOF strips.


From the Tossed Pumpkins - Purple (Backing), cut:

• (2) 68" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 80" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of 3 ½" Fabric G square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2).

Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares

3. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 1 square and (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



4. Sew together (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 5. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.

- 6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 8. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.
