



#### Materials

1 panel	36" Book Panel - White (A)	9620P-01
1 ½ yards	Ants on Red - Red (B)	9630-88
1 1/8 yards	Starlet - Yellow (C)	6383-Yellow
½ yard	Bugs in Garden - Green (D)	9624-66
½ yard	Ladybugs - White (E)	9626-01
3/4 yard	Starlet - Turquoise (F)	6383-Turquoise
²⁄₃ yard	Dragonflies - Dark Blue (G)	9623-77
½ yard	Dots - White (H)	9629-01
⁵⁄8 yard	Ladybugs - Green (I)	9626-66*
4 ½ yards	Bugs in Rectangles - Blue (Backin	g) 9621-71

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the 36" Book Panel - White (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 8 ½" squares each centered on a block.

#### From the Ants on Red - Red (B), cut:

- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 11 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 8 ½" strips.

#### From the Starlet - Yellow (C), cut:

- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 68 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 56 ½" strips.

#### From the Bugs in Garden - Green (D), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Ladybugs - White (E), cut:

• (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 ½" triangles. *Note: Only (62) triangles will be used.* 

#### From the Starlet - Turquoise (F), cut:

• (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (124) 5 ½" triangles.

#### From the Dragonflies - Dark Blue (G), cut:

• (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Dots - White (H), cut:

• (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 ½" triangles. *Note: Only (62) triangles will be used.* 

#### From the Ladybugs - Green (I), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


### Page 1

#### From the Bugs in Rectangles - Blue (Backing), cut:


• (2) 80" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 80" back.

#### **Sewing Instructions**

1. Sew (1) 2" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure 10 ½" square Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.



3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (1) Fabric E triangle, (2) Fabric F triangles and (1) Fabric H triangle to make (1) Unit 2 square. Repeat to make (62) Unit 2 squares total.




4. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make (31) Unit 3 strips total. Pay attention to the orientation of the units.





5. Sew (4) 4 ½" Fabric D squares and (3) Unit 3 strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 5 below). Repeat to make (5) Sashing Strips total.

#### **Quilt Top Assembly**


(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 6. Sew (4) Unit 3 strips and (3) Block One squares together, alternating them, to make (1) Block Row (Fig. 6 below). Repeat to make (4) Block Rows total.
- 7. Sew (5) Sashing Strips and (4) Block Rows together, alternating them, to make the Center Block.
- 8. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 10. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 11. Bind as desired.
