$3 / 8$ yard Halloween Elements - Black (G) 2170-99
$3 / 8$ yard Eyes - Black (H)
7/8 yard Urban Legend - Light Brown (I) 7101-32*
1/4 yard Owl Argyle - Black (J) 2161-99
$12 / 3$ yards Skull Damask - Black (K) 2160-99
$41 / 3$ yards Halloween Patch - Black (Backing) 2169-99

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Halloween Panel - 24 inches - Taupe (A):
-Fussy cut (1) $23 " \times 43 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

## From the Urban Legend - Black (B), cut:

-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 43 "$ strips.
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 27 "$ WOF strips.
From the Bats - Orange (C), cut:

- (3) 3 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 " $\mathrm{x} 451 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Portraits - Black (D), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $51 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Suns \& Moons - Taupe (E), cut:

-(28) Template 1 triangles.

- (28) Template 3 triangles.

From the Roses - Black (F), cut:
-(8) Template 2 triangles.
From the Halloween Elements - Black (G), cut:
-(12) Template 2 triangles.
From the Eyes - Black (H), cut:
-(8) Template 2 triangles.

From the Urban Legend - Light Brown (I), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 551 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Owl Argyle - Black (J), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2} " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Skull Damask - Black (K), cut:

- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 571 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Halloween Patch - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 77 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $62 " \times 77 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " x 43 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $23 " \times 43 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 27 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $251 / 2 \prime$ x $451 / 2 "$.

2. Place (1) Fabric E Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric H Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 2). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

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3. Place (1) Fabric E Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric H Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 3). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) block. Trim the unit to measure $51 / 2$ " square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make a second Unit 1 square.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 5-15 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of $51 / 2$ " unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 12.

6. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the top of (1) Unit 2 square along the Fabric H sides to make (1) $51 / 2$ " $\times 101 / 2$ " Block One rectangle (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 17-21 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Two rectangles, (2) Block Three rectangles, (2) Block Four rectangles, (2) Block Five rectangles and (2) Block Six rectangles.

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8. Sew (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric D square, (1) Block Two rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle together in that order from top to bottom to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 22).
9. Sew (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block Two rectangle and (1) Block One rectangle together in that order from top to bottom to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 23).

10. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block Five rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square together in that order from left to right to make the Top Border (Fig. 24).

11. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Five rectangle, (1) Block Six rectangle and (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric D square together in that order from left to right to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 25).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 12. Sew (1) $3 " \times 451 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
14. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric J square to each end of (1) $61 / 2 "$ x $421 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
