





Every Which Way - Quilt 1

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/4 yard 9570-33 Jot Dot - Orange

1/4 yard 9570-88 Jot Dot - Red

1/4 yard 2470-55 Circles - Purple

1/4 yard 2471-67 Argyle - Teal

1/4 yard 2473-99 Dots - Black

1/4 yard 2476-44 Tetris Geo - Mustard

3/8 yard 2469-99 Diamond & Circle Geo - Black

3/8 yard 2476-22 Tetris Geo - Pink

1/2 yard 2469-55 Diamond & Circle Geo - Purple

1/2 yard 2473-67 Dots - Teal

1/2 yard 2475-88 Irregular Stripes - Red

5/8 yard 9570-45 Jot Dot - Gold

3/4 yard 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal

7/8 yard 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue

1-5/8 yards 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons - Red

2-1/8 yards 9570-09 Jot Dot - Marshmallow

5-1/2 yards 2474-99 Tracks Geo - Black for backing 83" x 95" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton

batting

Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 9570-33 Jot Dot – Orange:

*Cut one 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut five 5-3/4" **A** squares.

From 9570-88 Jot Dot - Red:

*Cut one 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 5-3/4" **A** squares.

From each:

2470-55 Circles – Purple 2473-99 Dots - Black

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut five 6-1/2" E squares.

From *each*:

2471-67 Argyle – Teal 2476-44 Tetris Geo - Mustard

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 6-1/2" **E** squares.

From *each*:

2469-99 Diamond & Circle Geo – Black 2476-22 Tetris Geo - Pink

*Cut two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut five 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **B** rectangles and five 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **D** rectangles.

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" **C** rectangles.

From 2469-55 Diamond & Circle Geo – Purple:

*Cut three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **B** rectangles and eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **D** rectangles.

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut sixteen 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" C rectangles.

From 2473-76 Dots – Teal:

*Cut two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 6-1/2" E squares.

From 2475-88 Irregular Stripes – Red:

*Cut three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut six 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **B** rectangles and six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **D** rectangles.

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twelve 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" **C** rectangles.

From 9570-45 Jot Dot – Gold:

*Cut one 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut five 5-3/4" **A** squares.

*Cut seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 9570-76 Jot Dot - Teal:

*Cut two 5-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut eight 5-3/4" **A** squares.

*Cut eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

From 9570-77 Jot Dot - Dk. Blue:

*Cut one 5-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut six 5-3/4" **A** squares.

*Cut nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons – Red:

*Cut three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut six 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **B** rectangles and six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **D** rectangles.

Every Which Way - Quilt 1

*Cut one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twelve 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" C rectangles.

From 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow:

*Cut five 5-3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty 5-3/4" A squares.

*Cut two 8-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **B-1** rectangles.

*Cut two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" C-1 rectangles.


Assemble Blocks

Notes:

- a. Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.
- b. The number of blocks varies by the color combination (refer to the quilt photo), so note the difference in unit numbers constructed. The following are the block colorways (Table 1):

Block Diagram – Block 1 is depicted on the instructions.

^{*}Cut eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3.

^{*}Cut seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

1. Sew a **C** rectangle to an **E** square. Press the seam open. Sew a **B** rectangle to the top of this unit (*figure 1*). Press. Repeat to make thirty assorted units.




Figure 2 – Make 240 assorted.

2. Mark two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow A squares (a). Layer a marked A square atop a Jot Dot color A square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the marked lines (b), cut vertically and horizontally to make four equal squares (c), then cut each square on the drawn lines to make eight half-square triangles (d). Press open and trim dog ears (figure 2). Repeat with the remaining A squares to make 240 2-1/2" assorted half-square triangles (HST).

3. Sew two Step 2 HST into strips. Repeat with all the HST (*figure 3*) to make 120 assorted strips. Press the seams in one direction.

4. Referring to Table 1 above for fabric combination and noting fabric orientation on the diagram below, sew a Step 3 HST strip to the left side of a **D** rectangle (*figure 4*). Press the seam toward the rectangle. Repeat to make thirty assorted trips.

5. Sew the Step 4 strips to the right side of the Step 1 units (*figure 5*). Press.



6. Repeat Step 4 with the remaining **C** rectangles and the Step 3 HST strips. Sew the strips to the bottom of the Step 5 units (*figure 6*). Press open.



7. Repeat Step 4 with the Step 3 HST strips and the 9570-09 Jot Dot – Marshmallow **C-1** rectangles. Press. Repeat to make thirty assorted strips. Sew the strips to the left side of the Step 6 units (*figure 7*). Press the seams open.




Figure 8 – Make 30 assorted.

8. Repeat Step 4 with the remaining Step 3 HST and the Marshmallow **B-1** rectangles. Sew the strips to the bottom of the Step 7 units to make thirty assorted 12-1/2" blocks (*figure 8*). Press the seams open.

Assemble Quilt Top

- 9. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement as you lay out six rows of five blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row and press the seams open.
- 10. Sew the rows together and press the seams in one direction.
- 11. For border 1, join the seven 1-1/2" 9570-09 Jot Dot Marshmallow strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure


the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

- 12. Repeat Step 11 with the seven 1-1/2" 9570-45 Jot Dot Gold strips to make and add border 2.
- 13. Repeat Step 11 with the eight 4-1/2" 2472-88 Spiral Hexagons Red strips to make and add border 3.
- 14. Repeat Step 11 with the eight 1-1/2" 9570-76 Jot Dot Teal strips to make and add border 4.

Finishing

- 15. Create a sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
- 16. Join the nine 2-1/2" 9570-77 Jot Dot Dk. Blue binding strips end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
