Quilt #2

Designed by Fran Morgan **Finished Size:** 63" x 81"

Note: WOF means "width of fabric." Seam allowance is ¹/₄" throughout. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold binding. Tutorial available at fabriccafe.com. If double fold binding is preferred, an additional yard of fabric is needed.

MATERIALS

- * 1/4 yd large blue flower for Block "C"
- * 1/4 yd large green flower for Block "B"
- * 1/4 yd large pink flower for **Block "D"**
- * ½ yd large white flower for Block "A"
- * ²/₃ yd small blue flower for **Block** "E", "F" & border #3
- * ²/₃ yd small green flower for **Block** "E" & "G"
- * 1/3 yd small pink flower for Block "F" & "G"
- * ³/₄ yd small white flower for border #2
- * 1/4 vd blue circle for Block "B"
- * 1/4 yd green circle for Block "D"
- * 1/4 yd pink circle for Block "C"
- * 12/3 yds white circle for Block "E", "F" & "G"
- * ²/₃ yd dots for **Block "A"**
- * 1/3 yd stripe for binding
- * 5 yds black circle for backing

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From Large Flower Prints:

Blue

* Cut 1, 61/2" x WOF for Strip Assembly "C"

Greer

* Cut 1, 6½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "B"

Pink

* Cut 1, 6½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "D"

White

* Cut 2, 61/2" x WOF for Strip Assembly "A"

From Small Flower Prints:

Blue


- * Cut 1, 4½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, 4½" x 4½" squares for **Block "E" Assembly**
- * Cut 1, 4½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, 4½" x 4½" squares for **Block "F" Assembly**
- * Cut 8, 1½" x WOF for border #3

Green

- * Cut 1, 4½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, 4½" x 4½" squares for **Block "E" Assembly**
- * Cut 1, 4½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, 4½" x 4½" squares for **Block "G" Assembly**
- * Cut 7, 1½" x WOF for border #1

Pink

* Cut 1, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "



squares for Block "F" Assembly

* Cut 1, 4½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 8, 4½" x 4½" squares for **Block "G" Assembly**

White

* Cut 7, 3" x WOF for border #2

From Circle Prints:

Blue

* Cut 4, 2" x WOF for Block "B" Assembly

Greer

* Cut 4, 2" x WOF for Block "D" Assembly

Pink

* Cut 4, 2" x WOF for Block "C" Assembly

White

* Cut 6, 9½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 24, 9½" x 9½" for **Block** "E", "F" & "G"

From Dots:

* Cut 10, 2" x WOF for Block "A" Assembly



* Cut 8, 1¹/₄" x WOF for binding









Block "A" Assembly

Block "C" Assembly




Make 4, 91/2" x 91/2" Block "C"

Step 1: Block "A" Assembly


Referring to **Strip Assembly "A"** diagram, using 2 dots, 2" x WOF strips and one large white flower, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 12, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit "A"**. Referring to **Block "A" Assembly** diagram, using one **Unit "A"** and one dots, 2" x WOF strip, sew strip to one side; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 12, $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " **Block "A"**.

Step 2: Block "B" Assembly


Referring to **Strip Assembly "B"** diagram, using 2 blue circle, 2" x WOF strips and one large green flower, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Cut into 4, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit "B"**. Referring to **Block "B" Assembly** diagram,




Block "B" Assembly

Make 4, 91/2" x 91/2" Block "D"

using one **Unit "B"** and one blue circle, 2" x WOF strip, sew strip to one side; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 4, 9½" x 9½" **Block "B"**.

Step 3: Block "C" Assembly

Referring to **Strip Assembly** "C" diagram, using 2 pink circle, 2" x WOF strips and one large blue flower, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Cut into 4, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit** "C". Referring to **Block** "C" **Assembly** diagram, using one **Unit** "C" and one pink circle, 2" x WOF strip, sew strip to one side; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 4, $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " **Block** "C".


Block "E" Assembly



Using one white circle, 91/2" x 91/2" square and one small blue flower, 41/2" x 4½" square, sew from corner to corner



Trim 1/4" from stitch line. Using small green flower, repeat on opposite corner



Make 8. 9½" x 9½" Block "E"




Using one white circle, 91/2" x 91/2" square and one small pink flower, 41/2" x 4½" square, sew from corner to corner




Using one white circle, 91/2" x 91/2" square and one small green flower, 41/2" x 41/2" square, sew from corner to corner

Trim 1/4" from stitch line. Using small pink flower, repeat on opposite corner

Step 4: Block "D" Assembly

Referring to Strip Assembly "D" diagram, using 2 green circle, 2" x WOF strips and one large pink flower, 6½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Cut into 4, 6½" x 9½" Unit "D". Referring to Block "D" Assembly diagram, using one Unit "D" and one green circle, 2" x WOF strip, sew strip to one side; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 4, 9½" x 9½" Block "D".

Step 5: Block "E" Assembly

Referring to Block "E" Assembly, Step 1 diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of each small blue flower, 4½" x 4½" square. Using one white circle, 9½" x 9½" square and one small blue flower, 4½" x 4½" square, place right sides together as shown. Sew on drawn line. Referring to **Step** 2 diagram, trim ¹/₄" from stitch line. Referring to Finished **Block "E"** diagram, using one small green flower, 4½" x 4½" square, repeat on opposite corner as shown. Press and square block to 9½" x 9½". Repeat making 8, 9½" x 9½" Block "E".

Step 6: Block "F" Assembly

Referring to Block "F" Assembly, Step 1 diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of each small pink flower, 4½" x

4½" square. Using one white circle, 9½" x 9½" square and one small pink flower, 4½" x 4½" square, place right sides together as shown. Sew on drawn line. Referring to Step 2 diagram, trim 1/4" from stitch line. Referring to Finished **Block "F"** diagram, using one small blue flower, 4½" x 4½" square, repeat on opposite corner as shown. Press and square block to 9½" x 9½". Repeat making 8, 9½" x 9½" Block "F".


Step 7: Block "G" Assembly

Referring to Block "G" Assembly, Step 1 diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of each small green flower, 4½" x 4½" square. Using one white circle, 9½" x 9½" square and one small green flower, 4½" x 4½" square, place right sides together as shown. Sew on drawn line. Referring to Step 2 diagram, trim 1/4" from stitch line. Referring to Finished **Block "G"** diagram, using one small pink flower, 4½" x 4½" square, repeat on opposite corner as shown. Press and square block to 9½" x 9½". Repeat making 8, 9½" x 9½" Block "G".

Step 8: Quilt Assembly

Referring to Row Assembly diagram, alternating and rotating Blocks "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F" and "G" as shown, assemble 8 rows of 6 blocks each.

Step 9: Borders

For border #1, using small green flower, 1½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides. For border #2, repeat using small white flower, 3" x WOF border strips. For border #3, repeat using small blue flower, 1½" x WOF border strips.

Step 10: Backing & Binding

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using stripe, 1½" x WOF binding strips, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ½", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.
