

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Squirrels - Dusty Blue (A), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ½" squares.

From the Verona Basics - Green (B), cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

From the Snowflakes - Ice Blue (C), cut:

- (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" x 5 ½" strips.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

From the Panel 24 Inches - Royal Blue (D):

• Fussy cut (6) 10" squares, centered on blocks.

From the Snowflakes - Royal Blue (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₄" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/4" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Birds - Ice Blue (F), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Dusty Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 40 ½" LOF strips.

From the Patchwork - Royal Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 70" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 70" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 3" Fabric B square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4" x 5 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).





- 2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric B square to the lower right corner of the 4" x 5 ½" Fabric C to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.





4. Sew (1) 4" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) 5 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



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5. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 6). Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 12 ½". Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.




- 6. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 7). Repeat to make Row Three.
- 7. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 7). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 8. Sew together the (4) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $48 \frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 7).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 11. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric F square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 13. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 14. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 15. Bind as desired.



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
