



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Floral Banner Panel 24-in - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Chameleon - Turquoise (B), cut:

- (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43" strips.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 27" WOF strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 53 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. • (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 37 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Marble Texture - Black (C), cut:

• (1) 5 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " triangles. • (1) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Floral Texture - Red (D), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 6 ¹/₄" triangles.
- (1) 5 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ⁷/₈" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- (1) 5 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ⁷/₈" squares.
- (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Floral and Butterfly - Sky Blue (E), cut:

• (2) 6 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 6 ¹/₄" squares and (4) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares across both diagonals to make (28) 6 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Marble Texture - White (F), cut:

• (1) 6 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₄" squares and (2) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 ¹/₄" triangles.

From the Large Butterfly - Sky Blue (G), cut:

• (2) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 5 ¹/₂" x 8" strips.

From the Floral Texture - Sky Blue (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2" \times 57 \frac{1}{2}"$ strips.
- (2) 2" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

From the Scatter Butterfly - White (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (1) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ¹/₂" x 20 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Small Butterfly - Black (J), cut:

• (1) 5 ⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ⁷/₈" squares. Cut (4) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

From the Large Blooms - Black (K), cut:

- (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $65 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Scatter Butterfly - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 93" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 73" x 93" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a ¹/₄" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x 27" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 25 ¹/₂" x 45 ¹/₂".






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2. Sew together (1) 6 ¹/₄" Fabric E triangle and (1) $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric D triangle along a short side. Sew (1) 5 ⁷/₈" Fabric C triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.



3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 8.



4. Place (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 5 ¹/₂" x 8" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¹/₄" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Unit 9 strip.


5. Place (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the right side of (1) 5 ¹/₂" x 8" Fabric G strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¹/₄" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 strip.



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6. Place (1) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 13). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 14) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 5 ¹/₂" square to make (2) Unit 11 squares (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (8) Unit 11 squares total.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 16 for fabric identification and placement to make (4) Unit 12 squares.




Inner Side Border

8. Sew together (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Fabric G strip, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 6 square and (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Fabric G strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 17). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.

9. Sew together (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 6 square and (1) Unit 10 strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Inner Top Border (Fig. 18). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.






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10. Sew together (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Unit 7 square and (1) Unit 11 square, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Outer Side Border (Fig. 19). Repeat to make a second Outer Side Border.



11. Sew together (1) Unit 12 square, (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) 5 ¹/₂" x 20 ¹/₂" Fabric I strip, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) Unit 11 square and (1) Unit 12 square, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 20). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 12. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 2" x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) Outer Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 2" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.

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
