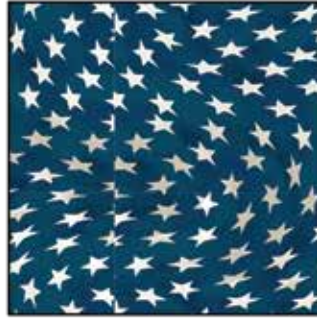

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Flying Eagle - Sky Blue (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 4 ½" squares.

From the Star - Navy (B), cut:

- (1) 4 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 4 ⅞" triangles.

From the Star - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) 5 ¼" triangles.

From the Urban Legend - Light Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ¼" x 11" strips.
- (2) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Scenic - Sky Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 11" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 11" squares.

From the Cloud Texture - Sunset (G), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Red (H), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Wordy Stripe - Red (I), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 17 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 62 ½" strips.

From the Cloud Texture - Sky Blue (J), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) 5 ¼" triangles.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

From the Flag - Navy (K), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Flag - Navy (Backing), cut:

- (1) 78" x 33" WOF strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 11" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 11" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) 12 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.

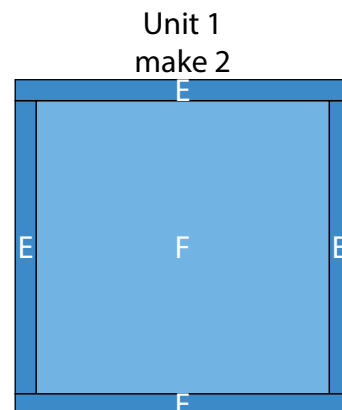

2. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip to the top of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

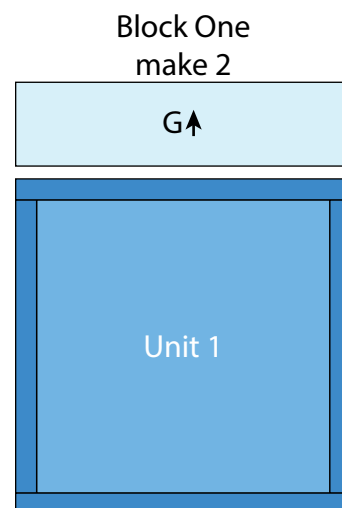
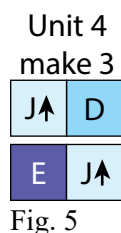

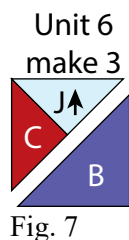
3. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to the left side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric J square to make the top row. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric J square to the left side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (3) Unit 2 squares total.



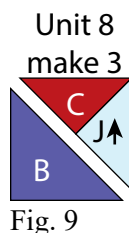
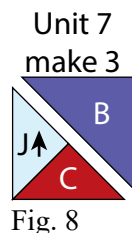
4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) of each unit square for Unit 3 through Unit 5.



5. Sew together (1) 5 ¼" Fabric C triangle and (1) 5 ¼" Fabric J triangle along a short side. Sew (1) 4 ⅞" Fabric B triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 6 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (3) Unit 6 squares total.



6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 8-10 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) of each unit square for Unit 7 through Unit 9.



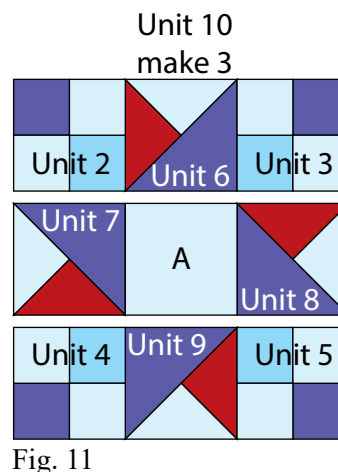
7. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 6 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 11).

8. Sew together (1) Unit 7 square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 8 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 11).

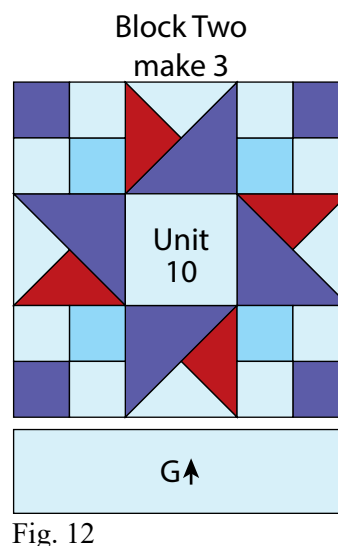
9. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 9 square and (1) Unit 5 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 11).

10. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 7-9 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Unit 10 square (Fig. 11).

11. Repeat Steps 7-10 to make (3) Unit 10 squares total.



12. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 10 square to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (3) Block Two rectangles total.



Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 13 while assembling the runner top.)

13. Sew together the (3) Block Two rectangles and (2) Block One rectangles, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square to each end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Runner Top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.

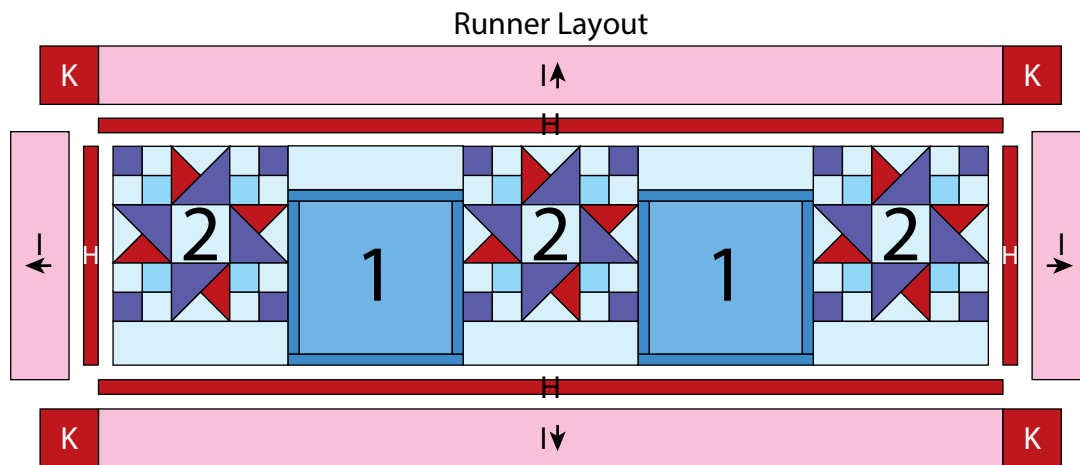

5/8 yard	Wordy Stripe - Red (C)	2044-88
1 1/2 yards	Flag - Navy (Backing)	2042-77

Batting: (4) 24" x 20"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Pillow Panel - 36-IN - Navy (A):

- (4) 15 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Urban Legend - Navy (B), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 17 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Wordy Stripe - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 16 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 16 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

From the Flag - Navy (Backing), cut:

- (2) 24" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 20" x 24" rectangles for the backings.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

19. Sew (1)

1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 15 1/2" Fabric A square.

Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 17 1/2"

Fabric B strip to the top

and to the bottom of the

Fabric A square to make

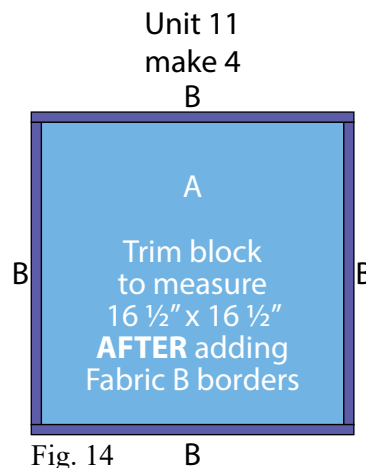
(1) Unit 11 square

(Fig. 14). Trim the unit to

measure 16 1/2" x 16 1/2".

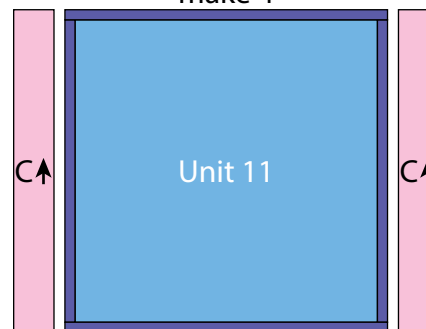
Repeat to make (4)

Unit 11 squares total.



20. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 11 square to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Block Mat Tops total.

21. Layer and quilt as desired.

22. Sew the (6) 8 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.

23. Bind as desired.
