## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Check - Cocoa (A), cut:

- (1) $143 / 4$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $143 / 4$ " square and (16) 3 " squares. Cut the $143 / 4$ " square across both diagonals to make (4) $143 / 4$ " triangles.

From the Chicken Scratch - Cocoa (B), cut:

- (2) $33 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $33 / 8 "$ squares.
- (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Dandelion - Gold (C), cut:

- (1) $5^{1 / 4} / 4 \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 4 "$ squares and (4) 3 " squares.
- (2) $33 / 8 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $33 / 8$ " squares.
-(2) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 3 " squares.
From the Check - Gold (D), cut:
- (2) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $33 / 8$ " squares.
- (2) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3" squares.

From the Old Fashioned Floral - Cocoa (E), cut:
-(6) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) $33 / 8$ " squares.

From the Bouquet with Dot - Ivory (F), cut:

- (1) 8 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 8 " squares and (2) $71 / 4$ "
squares. Cut the 8 " squares across both diagonals to make
(12) 8 " triangles.
- (7) $33 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (78) $33 / 8$ " squares.
- (4) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (46) 3 " squares.

From the Rings -Teal (G), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 68 "$ strips.
-(4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 70$ " strips.

From the Ferns - Teal (H), cut:

- (1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bouquet with Dot - Purple (I), cut:

- (1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Ferns - Purple (J), cut:

- (1) $143 / 4$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $143 / 4$ " square, (8) $33 / 8$ " squares, and (4) 3 " squares. Cut the $143 / 4$ " square across both diagonals to make (4) $143 / 4$ " triangles.

From the Berries - Purple (K), cut:

- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.

From the Ferns - Green (L), cut:

- (1) $143 / 4 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $143 / 4$ " square and
(4) 3 " squares. Cut the $143 / 4$ " square across both diagonals to make (4) $143 / 4 "$ triangles.

From the Dandelion - Green (M), cut:

- (1) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 8$ " squares.

From the Rings - Red (N), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares.

From the Bouquet with Dot - Red (O), cut:

- (1) $51 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 4 "$ squares.
- (1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bouquet with Dot - Cheddar (P), cut:

- (1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.


## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Check - Red (Q), cut:

- (1) 8 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 " squares and (8) $33 / 8$ " squares. Cut the 8 " squares across both diagonals to make (8) 8 " triangles.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Old Fashioned Floral - Teal (R), cut:

- (1) $143 / 4 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $143 / 4$ " square and
(8) $33 / 8$ " squares. Cut the $143 / 4$ " square across both diagonals to make (4) $143 / 4$ " triangles.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x 70 " strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 73$ " strips.

From the Berries - Ivory (S), cut:

- (1) 8 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $8 "$ squares and (2) $71 / 4$ " squares. Cut the 8 " squares across both diagonals to make (8) 8 " triangles.

From the Texture - Ivory (T), cut:

- (1) 8 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 8 " squares. Cut the $8 "$ squares across both diagonals to make (12) 8 " triangles.


## From the Berries - Purple (Backing), cut:

- (2) $81 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 81 " x 81 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $33 / 8 "$ Fabric E square on top of (1) $33 / 8 "$ Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (128) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-12 for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 10.

3. Sew together (1) 3" Fabric F square, (2) Unit 1 squares, (1) Unit 8 square and (1) 3 " Fabric G square, in that order from left to right, to make row one (Fig. 13).
4. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 3" Fabric D square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) 3 " Fabric F square and (1) Unit 2 square, in that order from left to right, to make row two (Fig. 13).
5. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) 3 " Fabric A square, (1) Unit 4 square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make row three (Fig. 13).
6. Sew together (1) Unit 3 square, (1) 3" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) 3" Fabric D square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make row four (Fig. 13).
7. Sew together (1) 3" Fabric J square, (1) Unit 3 square, (2) Unit 1 squares and (1) 3 " Fabric F square in that order from left to right to make row five (Fig. 13).
8. Sew together the (5) rows from Steps 3-7, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make (1) 13 " Block One square (Fig. 13).
9. Repeat Steps 3-8 to make a second Block One square.

10. Repeat Steps 3-8 and refer to Figures 14-19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Two squares, (2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares, (2) Block Five squares, (4) Block Six squares and (2) Block Seven squares.

11. Follow Figure 20 and sew together (10) assorted 8 "
triangles, (4) assorted $143 / 4 "$ triangles, (2) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric O squares and (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric C square to make (1) $71 / 4 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Block Eight strip. Repeat to make (4) Block Eight strips total.

12. Sew together (1) $71 / 4$ " Fabric $S$ square, (1) Block Eight strip and (1) $71 / 4 "$ Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 21). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

13. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 22).
14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Figure 22 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
15. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 13-14, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $501 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 22).

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 16. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric $P$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric $Q$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric $Q$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) Block Eight strip to each side of the Center Block.
19. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " \times 68 " \text { Fabric G strip to each side of the }}{}$ Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 70^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) $2 " \times 70 "$ Fabric R strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 73 " Fabric R strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## 22. Layer and quilt as desired.

23. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.


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
