### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Sewing/Knitting Notions - White (A), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ¼" squares, (2) 3 ½" squares, and (4) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Buttons - Pink (B), cut:

- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 ½" x 2" strips (Template 3), (2) 6 ½" x 2" strips (Template 4), (2) 5 ½" x 2 ½" strips (Template 3), (2) 5 ½" x 4 ½" (Template 4), (4) 5" x 2" strips (Template 2), (2) 4" x 1 ½" strips (Template 1), and (2) 4" x 2 ½" strips (Template 1).

#### From the Scissors - White on White (C), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 51 ½" strips.

#### • For Block 1:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3" squares (Template 1), (2) 3" x 7 ½" strips (Template 3), (2) 3" x 6" strips (Template 4), and (2) 2 ½" x 3 ½" (Template 2).
- (1) 8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8" x 9" strips and (2) 4 ½" x 9" strips.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (2) 3 ½" x 8" strips.

#### • For Block 3 & Block 5:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 5 ½" strips and (4) 4" squares (Template 11).
- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6" x 6 ½" strips.
- (1) 5" WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5" x 5 ½" strips and (4) 4" squares (Template 12).
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5" x 6" strips.
- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" x 5 ½" strips (Template 9) and (4) 4" squares (Template 10).

#### From the Pins & Needles - White (D), cut:

##### • Block 2 & Block 4:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6" x 5" strips (Template 5) and (4) 6" x 4" strips (Template 6).
- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6" x 4 ½" strips (Template 7) and (4) 5 ½" squares (Template 8).
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5" x 5 ¼" strips and (4) 5" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ¾" x 5 ¼" strips and (4) 4 ½" x 4 ¾" strips.

##### • Block 6:

- (1) 8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8" x 9" strips and (2) 8" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 3 ½" strips and (2) 4 ½" x 9" strips.
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ½" x 2 ½" strips (Template 2), (2) 3" x 7 ½" strips (Template 3) and (2) 3" x 6" strips (Template 4), and (2) 3" squares (Template 1).

#### From the Pin Circles - Charcoal (E), cut:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6" x 3" strips (Template 5), (2) 6" x 4" strips (Template 6), (2) 5" x 2" strips (Template 6), and (2) 4 ½" x 4" strips (Template 5).
- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ½" x 3 ½" strips (Template 8), (2) 5" x 3" strips (Template 7), (2) 5" x 3 ½" strips (Template 7), and (2) 3" x 3 ½" strips (Template 8).

#### From the Pins & Needles - Charcoal (F), cut:

- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 ¼" squares and (2) 3 ½" squares.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 53" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 43" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Stacked Thread Spools - White (G), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 2 ½" strips (Template 9), (2) 5 ½" x 3" strips (Template 10), (2) 5" x 2 ½" strips (Template 9), (2) 5" x 2 ½" (Template 10), (2) 5" x 3" (Template 11) and (2) 4" x 2 ½" strips (Template 11).
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3" x 5" strips (Template 12) and (2) 3" x 6" strips (Template 12).

#### From the Sewing Machines - White (H), cut:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6" x 3" strips (Template 5), (2) 6" x 4" strips (Template 6), (2) 5" x 2" strips (Template 6), (2) 5" x 3" (Template 7), and (2) 4 ½" x 4" strips (Template 5).
- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ½" x 5" strips (Template 7), (2) 3 ½" x 5 ½" strips (Template 8), and (2) 3 ½" x 3" strips (Template 8).

### Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Pin Cushions - White (I), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 9), (2) 6" x 3" strips (Template 12), (2) 5 1/2" x 3" strips (Template 10), (2) 5" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 9), (2) 5" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 10), (2) 5" x 3" strips (Template 11), (2) 5" x 3" strips (Template 12), (2) 4" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 11).

#### From the Ric-Rac Stripe - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips (Template 4), (2) 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 3), (4) 5" x 2" strips (Template 2), (2) 4" x 2 1/2" strips (Template 1) and (2) 4" x 1 1/2" strips (Template 1).
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 7 1/2" strips (Template 3) and (2) 2" x 6 1/2" strips (Template 4).


#### From the Yarn Spools - Pink (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 74" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Using your favorite paper-piecing method, refer to Figure 1 and Template 1 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 1 strips.
- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 2 and Template 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 2 strips.
- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 3 and Template 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 2 1/2" x 9" Unit 3 strips.
- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 4 and Template 4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 2 1/2" x 8" Unit 4 strips.



- Sew together (1) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) 4 1/2" x 9" Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right to make, the top row (Fig. 5).

- Sew together (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) 2 1/2" x 9" Unit 3 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 5).

- Sew together (1) 3 1/2" x 8" Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 4 strip and (1) 9" x 8" Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 5).

- Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 14" Block One square (Fig. 5).



- Repeat Steps 5-8 to make a second Block One square.

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 6 and Template 5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 5 1/4" Unit 5 squares.

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 7 and Template 6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 5 1/4" x 4 3/4" Unit 6 rectangles.

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 8 and Template 7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 4 1/2" x 5 1/4" Unit 7 rectangles.

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 9 and Template 8 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 5 1/4" x 5" Unit 8 rectangles.



14. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 4\frac{3}{4}''$  Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 6 rectangle and (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{3}{4}''$  Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, in that order to make the top row.

15. Sew together (1) Unit 5 square, (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}''$  Fabric A square and (1) Unit 7 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.

16. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5''$  Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 8 rectangle and (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.

17. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 14-16, lengthwise to make (1) 14'' Block Two square (Fig. 10).



18. Repeat Steps 14-17 to make a second Block Two square.

19. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 11 and Template 9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Unit 9 rectangles.

20. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 12 and Template 10 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  Unit 10 rectangles.

21. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 13 and Template 11 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$  Unit 11 rectangles.

22. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 14 and Template 12 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$  Unit 12 rectangles.









23. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 10 rectangle and (1)  $5'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.

24. Sew together (1) Unit 9 rectangle, (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric F square and (1) Unit 11 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.

25. Sew together (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$  Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 12 rectangle and (1)  $5'' \times 6''$  Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.

26. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 23-25, lengthwise to make (1) 14'' Block Three square (Fig. 15).

27. Repeat Steps 23-26 to make a second Block Three square.



28. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 16 and Template 6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 4\frac{3}{4}''$  Unit 13 rectangles.

29. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 17 and Template 7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$  Unit 14 rectangles.

30. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 18 and Template 8 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $5\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5''$  Unit 15 rectangles.

31. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 19 and Template 5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $5\frac{1}{4}''$  Unit 16 squares.







## Quilt 1

32. Sew together (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 14 rectangle and (1)  $5$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, in that order to make the top row.

33. Sew together (1) Unit 13 rectangle, (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F square and (1) Unit 15 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.

34. Sew together (1)  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 16 square and (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5$ " Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.

35. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 32-34, lengthwise to make (1)  $14$ " Block Four square (Fig. 20).



37. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 21 and Template 10 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 17 rectangles.

38. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 22 and Template 11 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5$ " Unit 18 rectangles.

39. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 23 and Template 12 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6$ " Unit 19 rectangles.

40. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 24 and Template 9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 20 rectangles.



41. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5$ " Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 18 rectangle and (1)  $6$ " x  $5$ " Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.

42. Sew together (1) Unit 17 rectangle, (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square and (1) Unit 19 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.

43. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 20 rectangle and (1)  $6$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.

44. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 41-43, lengthwise to make (1)  $14$ " Block Five square (Fig. 25).



45. Repeat Steps 41-44 to make a second Block Five square.

46. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 26 and Template 4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8$ " Unit 21 strips.

47. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 27 and Template 1 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 22 strips.

48. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 28 and Template 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 23 strips.

49. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 29 and Template 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9$ " Unit 24 strips.





50. Sew together (1) 3 1/2" x 8" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 22 strip and (1) 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.

51. Sew together (1) Unit 21 strip, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) 2 1/2" x 9" Unit 23 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.

52. Sew together (1) 8" x 9" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 24 strip and (1) 4 1/2" x 9" Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.

53. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 50-52 lengthwise to make (1) 14" Block Six square (Fig. 30).



54. Repeat Steps 50-53 to make a second Block Six square.

55. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.

56. Repeat Step 55 and refer to Figure 31 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.

57. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 55-56, in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 41" x 54 1/2" Center Block.



## Quilt 1

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

58. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 43" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


59. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

60. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 53" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

61. Layer and quilt as desired.

62. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.


63. Bind as desired.




Quilt Layout

Measurement is the size of fabric needed for that area.


