



½ yard	Circle Texture - Lime (B)	2461-60*
½ yard	Starlet - White (C)	6383-White
¼ yard	Stacked Bunnies - Light Blue (D)	2464-11
1 ¼ yards	Stacked Easter Eggs - Yellow (E)	2463-44
¼ yard	Tossed Easter Eggs - Pink (F)	2462-22
¼ yard	Line Dots - Yellow (G)	2456-44
¼ yard	Plaid - White (H)	2459-01
¼ yard	Floral - Coral (I)	2457-83
¼ yard	Circle Dots - White (J)	2460-01
2 ¾ yards	Tossed Bunnies - White (Backing)	2466-01

*Includes binding

Batting: 46" x 56"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Bunny Heads - Teal (A), cut:

- (1) 5 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 7/8" triangles.

From the Circle Texture - Lime (B), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starlet - White (C), cut:

- (4) 3 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (96) 3 3/8" triangles.

From the Stacked Bunnies - Light Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 5 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 7/8" triangles.

From the Stacked Easter Eggs - Yellow (E), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 3 1/2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips (piece as needed) and (12) 3" squares.

From the Tossed Easter Eggs - Pink (F), cut:

- (1) 5 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 7/8" triangles.

From the Line Dots - Yellow (G), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

From the Plaid - White (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

From the Floral - Coral (I), cut:

- (1) 5 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 5 7/8" triangles.

From the Circle Dots - White (J), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Tossed Bunnies - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 46" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 46" x 56" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (2) 3 3/8" Fabric C triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 3" Fabric B square. Sew (1) 5 7/8" Fabric A triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 2 squares, (6) Unit 3 squares, (6) Unit 4 squares, (12) Unit 5 squares and (6) Unit 6 squares.











3. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



4. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



5. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Three.

6. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Four.

7. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 5-6, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make 30 ½" x 40 ½" Center Block (Fig. 9).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)


8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.



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
