

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 - Inch Block Panel - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 10" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Golden Swirl - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13" strips.

From the Golden Dot - White (C), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 11 ½" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Glitter Ornament - Black (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ½" squares.

From the Golden Deer - Red (E), cut:

• (24) Template 2 triangles.

From the Snowflake - White (F), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ½" squares.
- (24) Template 1 triangles.
- (24) Template 3 triangles.

From the Golden Swirl - Black (G), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ½" squares.
- (11) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Tossed White Dove - Red (H), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (I), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Scallop Fan - Red (J), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 56 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Black (K), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Golden Swirl - Red (Backing), cut:

• (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 78" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


- 1. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 11** ½" x 11 ½". Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.
- 2. Sew (1) 1" x 11 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.




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3. Place (1) Fabric F Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric E Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 3). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.





- 4. Place (1) Fabric F Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric E Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 4). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Trim the block to measure 4 ½" square.
- 5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (24) Unit 2 squares total.



Unit 2 make 24 T-1 Fig. 5


6. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 7).

- 7. Follow Figure 8 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric G square to the lower right corner of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 9).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (24) Unit 3 squares total.





9. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric F square to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



10. Sew together (4) 2 ½" Fabric H squares and (3) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (5) Block Three strips total.




- 11. Sew together (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square and (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Three.
- 12. Sew together (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Four.

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
13. Sew together the (5) Block Three strips and the (4) rows from Steps 11-12 in numerical order, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the $44 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $58 \frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 12).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 15. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.
