1 yard	Jot Dot - Black (C)	9570-99
3/4 yard	Zebras - Light Gray (D)	2527-90
3/8 yard	Lions & Tigers - Amber (E)	2518-35
⅓ yard	Elephants - Light Gray (F)	2519-90
⅓ yard	Hippos - Light Gray (G)	2522-90
⅓ yard	Giraffes - Amber (H)	2521-35
⅓ yard	Animal Skins - Amber (I)	2526-35
¾ yard	Leaves - Green (J)	2520-66*
4 yards	Monkeys - Black (Backing)	2523-99

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic Jungle Stripe - Green (A), cut:

• (1) 20 ½" x 12 ½" WOF strip.

From the Jot Dot - Fog (B), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" x 5 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 29" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₄" x 22 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 20 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 14" strips.

From the Jot Dot - Black (C), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₄" x 27 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 22" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 21" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Zebras - Light Gray (D), cut:

• (1) 23 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 23 ½" x 2 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 19 ½" strips.

From the Lions & Tigers - Amber (E), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" square.

From the Elephants - Light Gray (F), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" square.

From the Hippos - Light Gray (G), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" square.

From the Giraffes - Amber (H), cut:

• (1) 10 ½" square.

From the Animal Skins - Amber (I), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

From the Leaves - Green (J), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Monkeys - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 68" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 68" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 20 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to each side of the 12 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 14" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make (1) 14" x 22" Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1).
- 2. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 22" Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 1 strip. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 strip to make the 15 ½" x 23 ½" Center Block (Fig. 2).



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3. Sew together (1) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) 4 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric J strip and (1) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) 12 ½" x 9 ½" Block One rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Block One rectangles total.





4. Sew together (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) 4 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 5 ½" x 12 ½" Block Two strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block Two strips total.



- 5. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.
- 6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 12 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.





7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) 12 ½" Block Four square (Fig. 7).




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
8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 8-10 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Seven square.







9. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Three square lengthwise to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



10. Sew together (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two strip and (1) Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 12).



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11. Sew together (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two strip and (1) Block Seven square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 13).






Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 23 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 19 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 27 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 21" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 29" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 17. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 18. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 19. Bind as desired.
