



⅓ yard	Rosette Tile - Black (C)	2688-99
²⁄₃ yard	Chameleon - Purple (D)	1178-55
½ yard	Urban Legend - White (E)	7101-01
²⁄₃ yard	Mandala - Black (F)	2691-99
²⁄₃ yard	Chameleon - Yellow (G)	1178-43
3/4 yard	Small Starburst Floral - White (H)	2694-01
3/8 yard	Marble Tile - Royal (I)	2689-77
1/4 yard	Abstract Herringbone - Navy (J)	2690-78
⅓ yard	Starburst Floral - Black (K)	2686-99
½ yard	Gradient Stripe - Royal (L)	2685-77*
3 ½ yards	3D Medallion - Navy (Backing)	2692-78

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Rosette - Black (A), cut:

• (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 8 ½" squares.

From the Chameleon - Pink/Purple (B), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" squares.

From the Rosette Tile - Black (C), cut:

• (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 ½" squares.

From the Chameleon - Purple (D), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 44 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 47 ½" strips.

From the Urban Legend - White (E), cut:

• (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 ½" squares.

From the Mandala - Black (F), cut:

• (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Chameleon - Yellow (G), cut:

• (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2 ½" squares.

From the Small Starburst Floral - White (H), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ½" squares.

From the Marble Tile - Royal (I), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares.

From the Abstract Herringbone - Navy (J), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Starburst Floral - Black (K), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 47 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 55 ½" strips.

From the Gradient Stripe - Royal (L), cut:

• (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the 3D Medallion - Navy (Backing), cut:

• (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 63" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Place (1) 4 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).






2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 4 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 ½" Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).

- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (5) Unit 1 squares total.
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 2 squares.


5. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 7).

- 6. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
- 7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (36) Unit 3 strips total.






8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figure 10 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (36) Unit 4 strips.




9. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 4 strip along the Fabric E sides to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (36) Unit 5 strips total.




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10. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.



11. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.



12. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4 ½" Fabric H square, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 15).





13. Follow Figure 16 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric G square to the lower right corner of the 4 ½" Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 17).






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

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14. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 ½" Fabric I square to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (12) Block Three strips total.




- 15. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 19). Repeat to make Row Five.
- 16. Sew together (3) Block Three strips and (2) 4 ½" Fabric J squares, end to end alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 19). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 17. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three (Fig. 19).
- 18. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 15-17, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 44 ½" x 44 ½" Center Block (Fig. 19).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 19. Sew (1) 2" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 47 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 20. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 55 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the guilt top.
- 21. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 22. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric L strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 23. Bind as desired.
