$51 / 4$ yards Tonal Sun - Royal (Backing)
2444-75

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Banner Panel - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 43 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.


## From the Urban Legend - Red (B), cut:

- (3) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 43 "$ strips.
-(2) $2 " \times 25 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ WOF strips.
- (3) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 511 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 391 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 66 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 531 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Tossed Hot Air Balloon - Blue (C), cut:

-(3) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $4 " \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Tossed Kokopelli and Sun - Royal (D), cut:
-(1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Frog - White (E), cut:

- (5) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Sun - Black (F), cut:
-(5) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

## From the Border Stripe - Royal (G), cut:

- (2) $81 / 2 " \times 88^{\prime \prime}$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(2) $8 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 73 "$ LOF strips.
From the Tonal Sun - Royal (Backing), cut:
-(2) $92 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $77 " \times 92 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $x 43 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ 。

Top/Bottom Border make 2


Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 4. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
5. Sew (1) $4 " \times 36^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) 2" $\times 511 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $391 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 661 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Center (1) $81 / 2 " \times 88^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4 "$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
11. Repeat Step 10 to sew (1) $8 \frac{1 / 2 " \times 73 " \text { Fabric G strip }}{2}$ to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 4).
12. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 4), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.


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
