2/3 yard	Pineapples - Aqua (D)	1273-11
1/2 yard	Paisley - Pink (E)	1269-22
5/8 yard	Small Floral - Light Green (F)	1274-60
1 1/8 yards	Eclipse - White (G)	3955-White
3/8 yard	Flamingos and Cocktail - Pink (H)	1271-22
1/4 yard	Tossed Motifs - White (I)	1270-01
1/4 yard	Flip Flops - White (J)	1268-01
1/2 yard	Jot Dot - Rose (K)	9570-21
1 3/8 yards	Large Flamingo - Aqua (L)	1266-11
2/3 yard	Urban Legend - Dark Pink (M)	7101-22*

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Flamingo Panel - Pink (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 41 3/4" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Jot Dot - Chartreuse (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 41 3/4" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 49" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Hibiscus - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) 3" x 29" WOF strips.
- (3) 2 3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 3/4" x 44" strips.

#### From the Pineapples - Aqua (D), cut:

- (6) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Paisley - Pink (E), cut:

- (2) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (80) 3 1/4" triangles.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Small Floral - Light Green (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 3 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) 3 1/4" triangles.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Eclipse - White (G), cut:

- (1) 3 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 3 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) 3 1/4" triangles.
- (6) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 7/8" squares.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Flamingos and Cocktail - Pink (H), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Tossed Motifs - White (I), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Flip Flops - White (J), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Jot Dot - Rose (K), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 70 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 53 1/2" strips.

#### From the Large Flamingo - Aqua (L), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 73 1/2" strips.
- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips.

#### From the Urban Legend - Dark Pink (M), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Mini Flamingo - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 91" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 91" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.*

1. Sew (1) 2" x 41 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 41 3/4" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

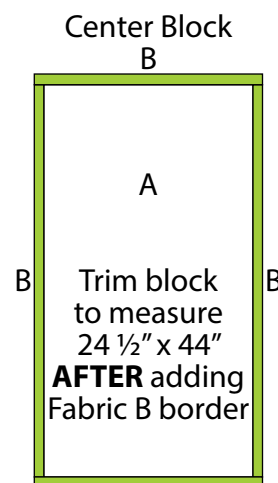

2. Place (1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of one  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (160) Unit 1 squares total.

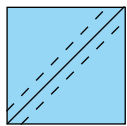

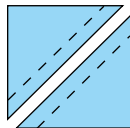

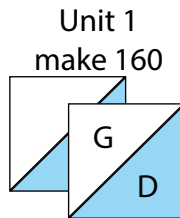

3. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (60) Unit 2 strips total.

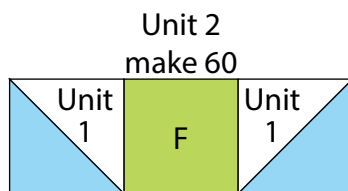

4. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E triangle and (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G triangle together to make (1) EG triangle. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F triangle and (1)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E triangle together to make (1) FE triangle. Sew the EG and FE triangles together along the long sides to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). The square should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (40) Unit 3 squares total.

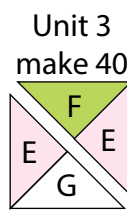

5. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make Row One (Fig. 7). Repeat to make Row Five.

6. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of the newly sewn strip to make Row Two (Fig. 7). Repeat to make Row Four.

7. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Three (Fig. 7).

8. Sew the (5) rows from Steps 5-7 together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 7).

9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (10) Block One squares total.

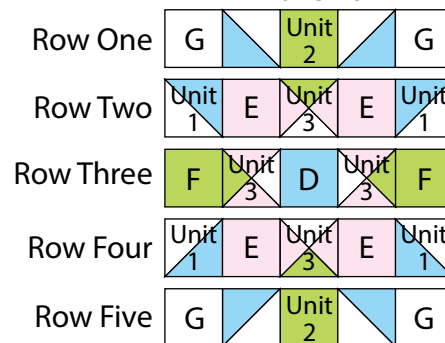

10. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

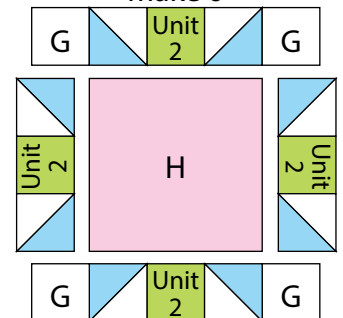

11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figures 9-10 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Three squares and (2) Block Four squares.

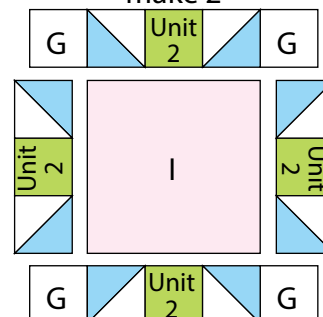

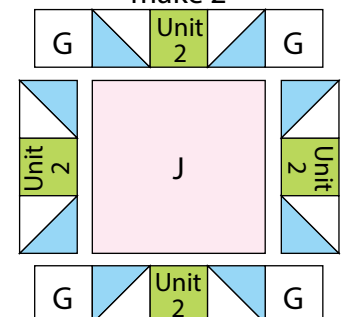

### Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 44" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 29" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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13. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 49" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 30 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

15. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

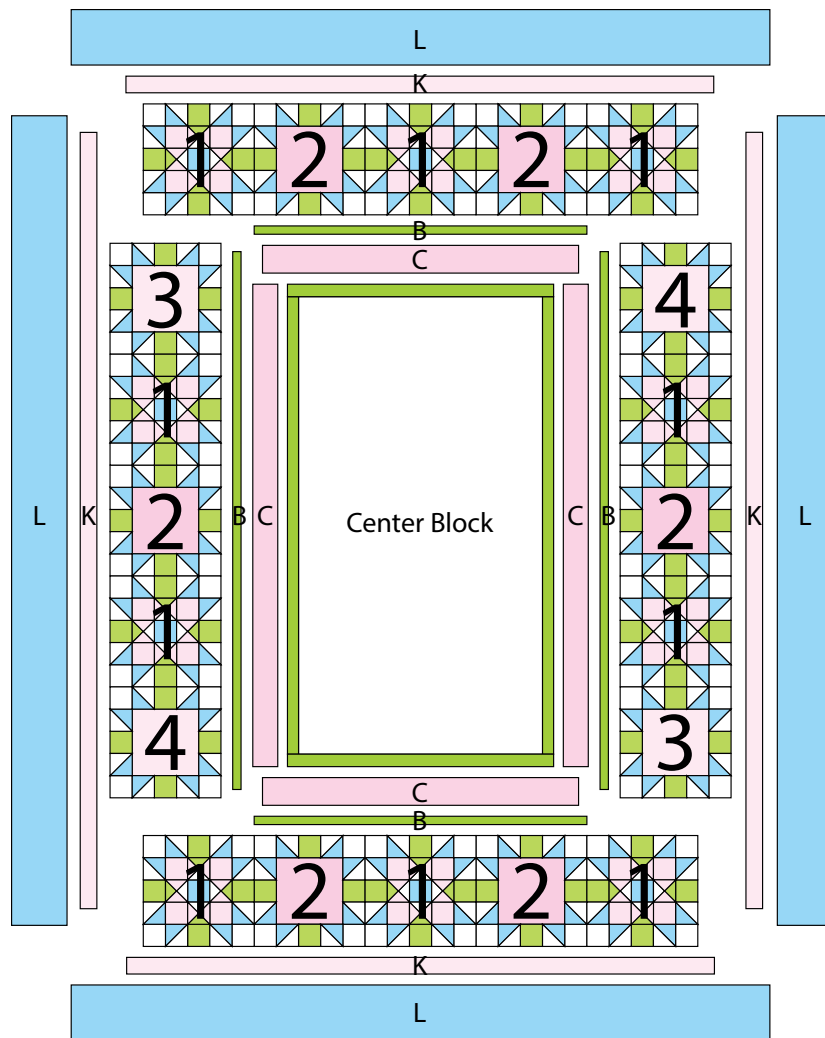
16. Sew (1) 2" x 70 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 53 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 73 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
