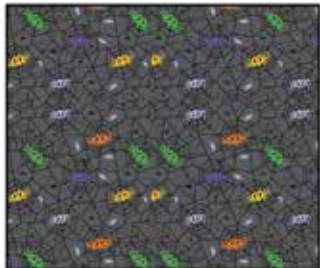

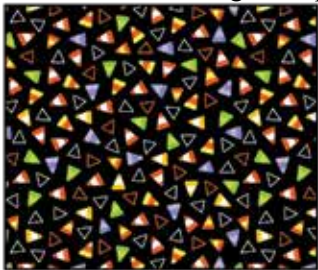

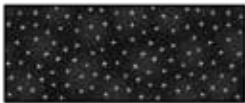

1/4 yard	Tossed Halloween Candy - Light Purple (C)	2742-50
1/4 yard	Trick or Treaters Collage - Gray (D)	2741-95
1/4 yard	Starlet - Lilac (E)	6383-Lilac
1/4 yard	Trick or Treater Patch - Light Purple (F)	2732-50
3/8 yard	Spiders or Spider Web - Gray (G)	2734-95
1/4 yard	Ghosts & Goblins - Green (H)	2739-66
3/8 yard	Bats - Orange (I)	2736-33
3/8 yard	Tossed Trick or Treaters - Orange (J)	2740-33
5/8 yard	Starlet - Black (K)	6383-Black
1/2 yard	Plaid - Orange (L)	2738-33
1/2 yard	Starlet - Papaya (M)	6383-Papaya*
3 1/2 yards	Candy Corn - Black (Backing)	2735-99

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Halloween Pumpkins - Black (A), cut:

- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Starlet - Kelly (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Halloween Candy - Light Purple (C), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Trick or Treaters Collage - Gray (D), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Starlet - Lilac (E), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Trick or Treater Patch - Light Purple (F), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Spiders or Spider Web - Gray (G), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Ghosts & Goblins - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Bats - Orange (I), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Trick or Treaters - Orange (J), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Starlet - Black (K), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (7) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Plaid - Orange (L), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Starlet - Papaya (M), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Candy Corn - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 70" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 5 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) Block One squares total.

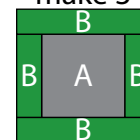

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two squares, (3) Block Three squares, (3) Block Four squares and (3) Block Five squares.

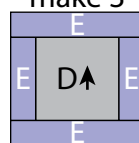

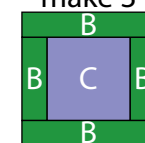

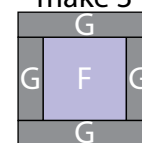

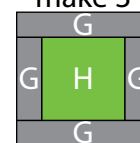
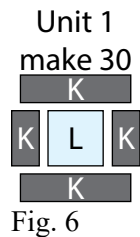

3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric L square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric L square to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (30) Unit 1 squares total.



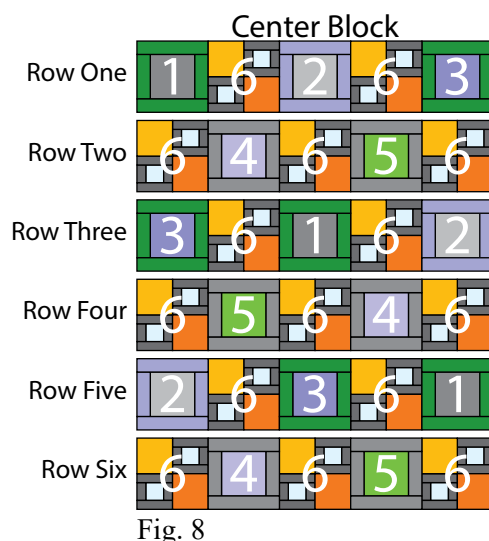
4. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric I square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric J square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 ½" Block Six square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (15) Block Six squares total.



5. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row (Fig. 8).

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 8 for component identification and placement to make Row Two through Row Six.

7. Sew together the (6) Rows from Steps 5-6, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 40 ½" x 48 ½" Center Block (Fig. 8).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

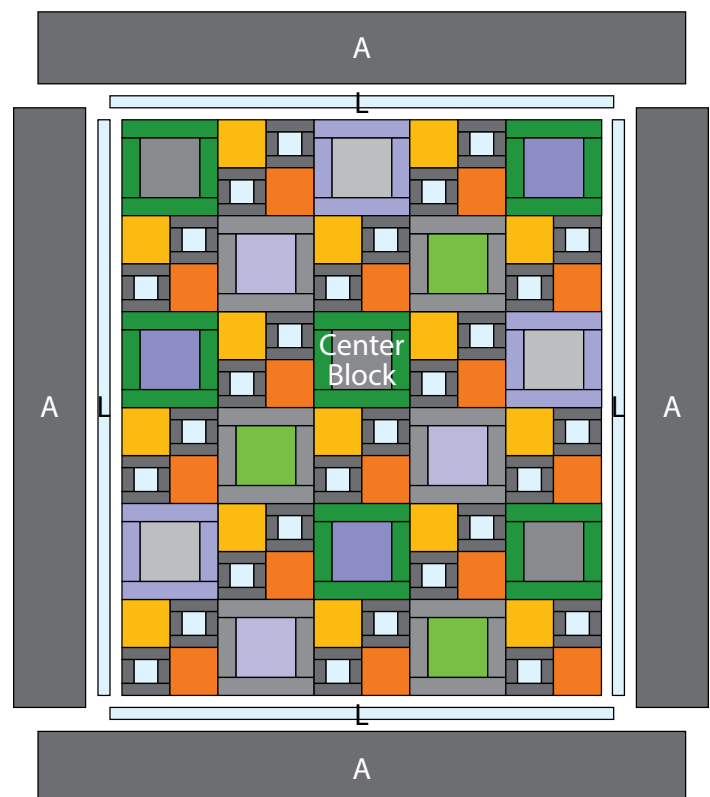
8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
