1/4 yard	Tossed Tools - Tan (I)	2561-30
1/4 yard	Motorcycle Silhouettes - Red (J)	2556-88
1 1/4 yards	Tossed Motorcycles - Tan (K)	2557-30
5 yards	Motorcycle Patch - Red (Backing)	2558-88

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From Motorcycle Panel-24 inches - Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 42 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Urban Legend - Charcoal (B), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (2) 3" x 22 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 47 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 71 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" strips.

From the Tools - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" WOF strips.
- (5) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/4" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/4" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Motorcycle Helmets - Tan (E), cut:

- (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 5" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.

From the American Flags - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - Gray (G), cut:

- (3) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (21) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (84) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Stars - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Tools - Tan (I), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 5 1/4" triangles.

From the Motorcycle Silhouettes - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Motorcycles - Tan (K), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips.
- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 59 1/2" strips.

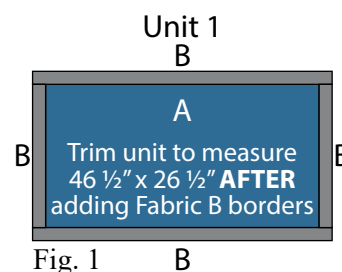
From the Motorcycle Patch - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 89" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 89" x 77" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 3" x 22 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 42 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 47 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 46 1/2" x 26 1/2".**



2. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the $46\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 2).

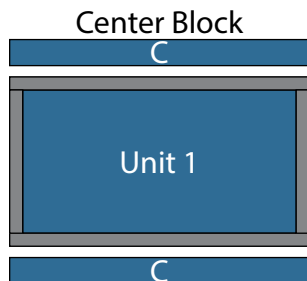

3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (2) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G triangles and (2) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C triangles to make (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (14) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (14) Unit 3 squares and (14) Unit 4 squares.

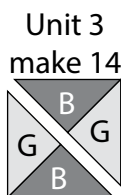

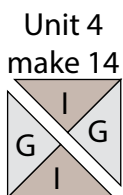

5. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to each end of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 5 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.

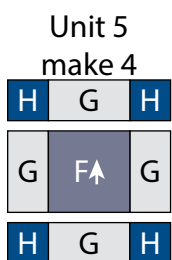

6. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Unit 5 square to make (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

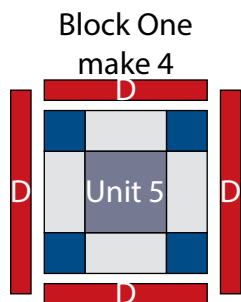

7. Refer to Figure 8 and sew together (3) Unit 2 squares, (3) Unit 3 squares and (3) Unit 4 squares end to end. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 6 " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two strip.

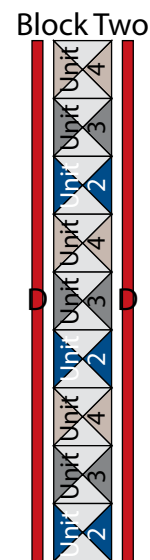

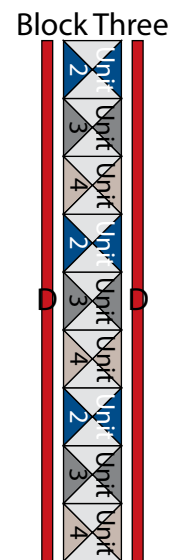

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Three strip.

9. Refer to Figure 10 and sew together (4) Unit 2 squares, (4) Unit 3 squares, (4) Unit 4 squares and (2) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips to make (1) Block Four strip.

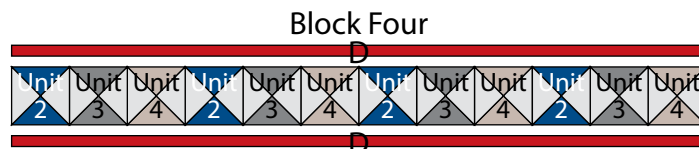

10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Five strip.

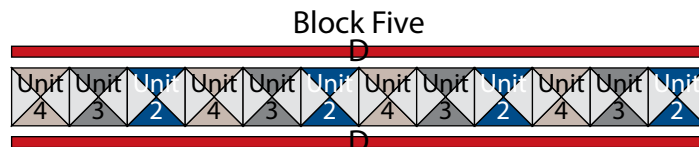

11. Sew (1) 5 " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the right side of the Block Two strip lengthwise to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 12).

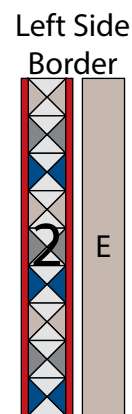

12. Sew (1) 5 " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the left side of the Block Three strip lengthwise to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 13).

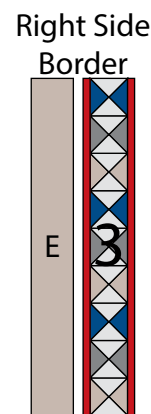

13. Sew (1) 5" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the Block Four strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 14).

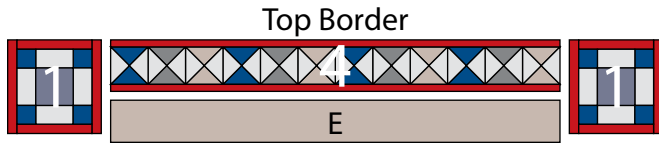

14. Sew (1) 5" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the top of the Block Five strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 15).

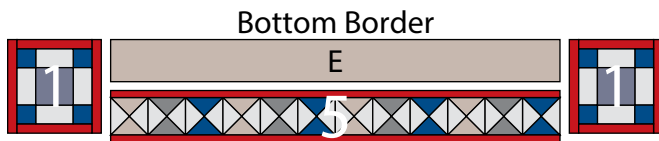

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

17. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

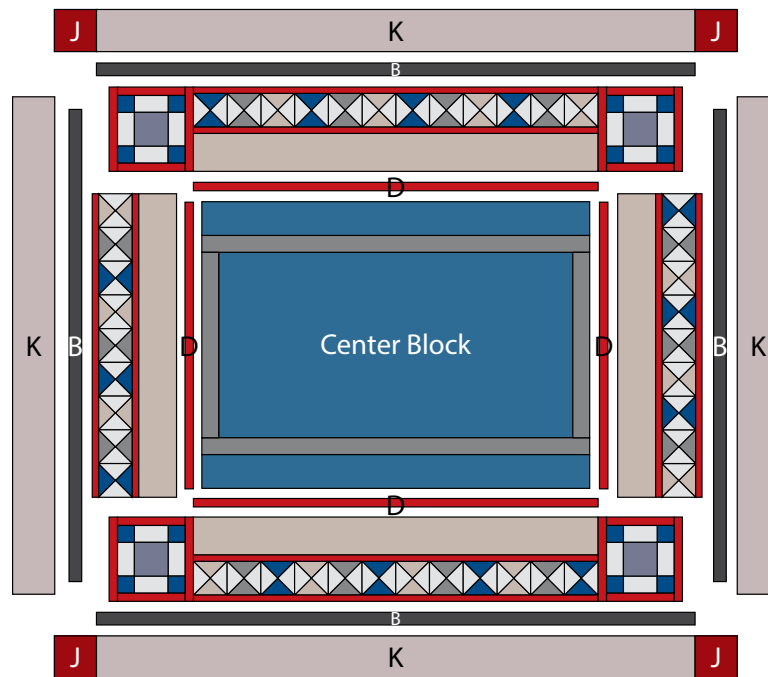
18. Sew (1) 2" x 56 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 71 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

19. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric J square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 71 ½" Fabric K strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.
