



Sleeping Bag Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 35" x 43" panel.

From the Starlet - Papaya (B), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43" strips. • (2) 2" x 38" WOF strips.

From the Stripe - Black (C), cut:

• (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 36 ¹/₂" WOF strips. • (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Constellations - Black (D), cut: • (3) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Planets - Black (E), cut: • (3) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Shooting Stars - Black (F), cut: • (3) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Swirls with Stars - Orange (G), cut: • (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

From the Night Sky - Black (H), cut:

• (12) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

• (6) 3" x WOF strips for the ties.

From the Swirls with Stars - Blue (I), cut: • (12) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

From the Spaceships - Black (J), cut:

• (2) 76" x WOF strips for the lining. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 80" lining.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 35" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 38" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2¹/₂" x WOF Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Strip Sets total.

3. Cut the (6) Strip Sets into (84) 2 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3).





4. Sew (1) 2¹/₂" x WOF Fabric H strip to each side of (1)2¹/₂" x WOF Fabric G strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (3) Strip Sets total.

5. Cut the (3) Strip Sets into (42) 2 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Unit 2 strips (Fig. 5).



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
6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (42) Unit 3 squares total.


7. Fold (1) 3" x WOF Fabric H strip in half lengthwise and press (Fig. 7). Open the folded fabric and fold each long edge to the creased centerline and press (Fig. 8). Fold the pressed fabric in half again and press (Fig. 9). Top stitch down both long sides ¹/₈" in from the edge (Fig. 10). *Note: The strip will be 1/4 of the width of strip you start with.* Cut the strip in half to make (2) Ties (Fig. 11).

8. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make to make (12) Ties total.




9. Follow Figure 12 and sew (18) Unit 3 squares, (6) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares, (6) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares and (6) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares together. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn unit to make (1) Unit 4 rectangle.


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
10. Sew (12) Unit 3 blocks, (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares, (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares and (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares together into a 2 x 12 block matrix to make the Top Border (Fig. 13).



11. Sew (12) Unit 3 blocks, (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares, (5) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares and (3) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares together into a 2 x 12 block matrix to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 14).

Sleeping Bag Top Top Assembly

(Follow the Sleeping Bag Layout while assembling the *sleeping bag top.)*

12. Sew (1) Unit 4 block to the left side of the Center Block to make the middle row.


13. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and bottom of the middle row to make the sleeping bag top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Pin the ties to the sleeping bag as shown. Baste them in place using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

16. Sew the (7) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired, making sure to catch the tie ends in the binding.



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
