1 ¼ yards	Starlet - Berry (B)	6383-Berry*
1 ⅜ yards	Eiffel Tower with Flowers and Butterflies - White (C)	1679-01
⅔ yard	Starlet - Petal (D)	6383-Petal
½ yard	Hearts - White (E)	1686-01
⅜ yard	Butterflies - Light Blue (F)	1682-17
⅝ yard	Eiffel Tower - White on White (G)	1683-01W
⅜ yard	Floral Collage - Pink (H)	1684-22
2 ⅛ yards	Hot Air Balloons - White (I)	1681-01
5 ⅛ yards	Scenic - Green (Backing)	1687-66

*Includes binding

Batting: 72" x 92"

(Recommended: Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Paris Panel - Light Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21 ½" x 41" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Starlet - Berry (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 41" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 ½" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Eiffel Tower with Flowers and Butterflies - White (C), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 44 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Starlet - Petal (D), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Hearts - White (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Butterflies - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4 ½" squares.

From the Eiffel Tower - White on White (G), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (29) 4 ½" squares.

From the Floral Collage - Pink (H), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 4 ½" squares.

From the Hot Air Balloons - White (I), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 74 ½" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 ½" x 64 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Scenic - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 92" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 41" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 ½" x 41" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½"**.

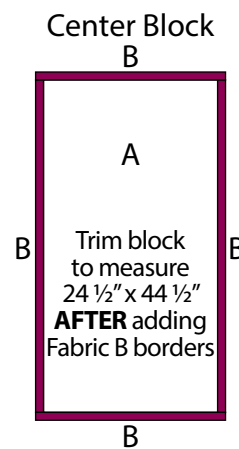

2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (8) 4 ½” Fabric G squares, (4) 4 ½” Fabric F squares and (4) 4 ½” Fabric H squares to make the Left Side Border.

3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (8) 4 ½” Fabric G squares, (4) 4 ½” Fabric F squares and (4) 4 ½” Fabric H squares to make the Right Side Border.

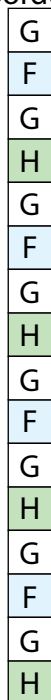

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (6) 4 ½” Fabric G squares, (4) 4 ½” Fabric F squares and (3) 4 ½” Fabric H squares to make the Top Border.

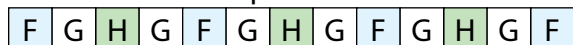

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (7) 4 ½” Fabric G squares, (3) 4 ½” Fabric F squares and (3) 4 ½” Fabric H squares to make the Bottom Border.

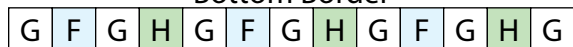

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew (1) 6 ½” x 44 ½” Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½” x 36 ½” Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 56 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 38 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 2 ½” x 58 ½” Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½” x 42 ½” Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 62 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 44 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

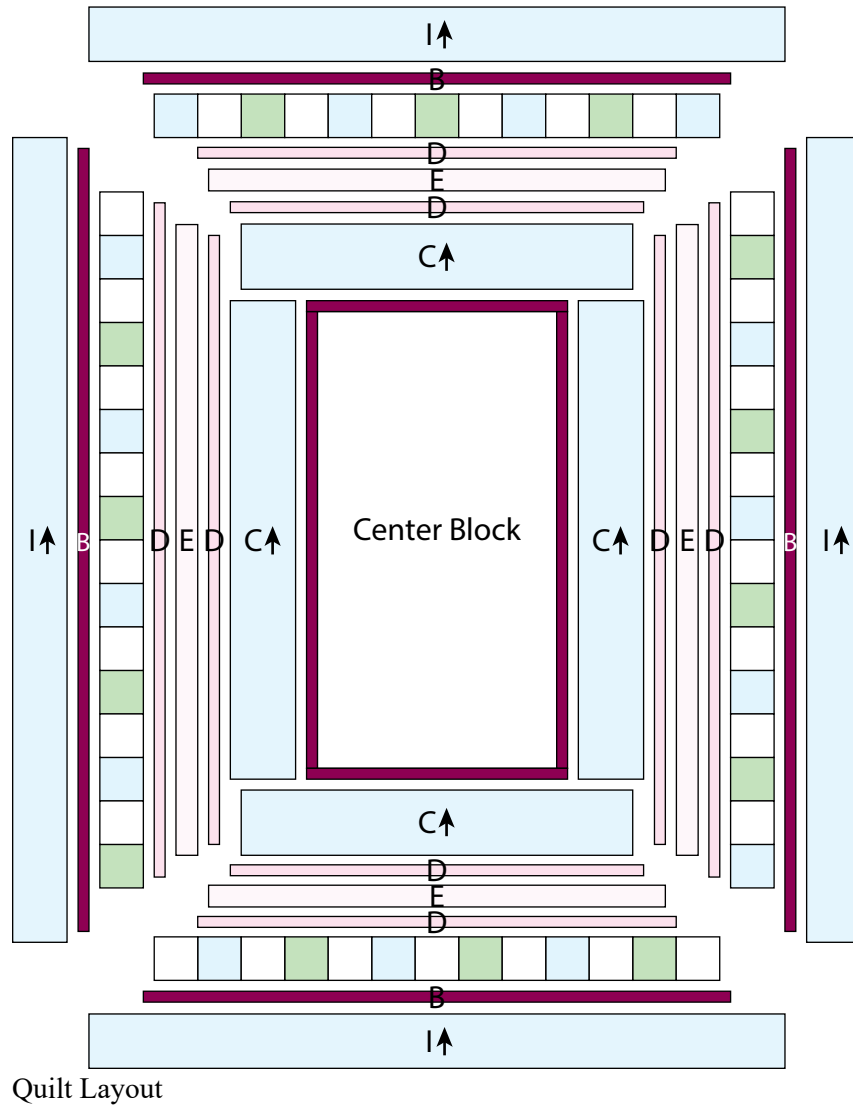
12. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 72 ½” Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½” x 54 ½” Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 5 ½” x 74 ½” Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½” x 64 ½” Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (8) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.



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
