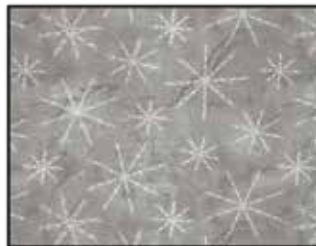

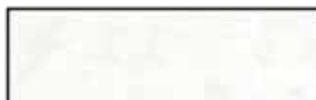

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 12 Days of Christmas Panel-36 inches - White (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Christmas Motifs - Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 4" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 4" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Tossed Cowboy Boots - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Music Sheet - White (D), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Snowmen - White (E), cut:

- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Urban Legend - Hunter (F), cut:

- (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Christmas Trees - White (G), cut:

- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Trucks - White (H), cut:

- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (I), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

From the Buffalo Check - Red (J), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

From the Urban Legend - Charcoal (K), cut:

- (4) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (64) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

From the Barbed Wire Snowflakes - Gray (L), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Ornaments - Red (M), cut:

- (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Candy Canes - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 79" x 87" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 4" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 4" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".**

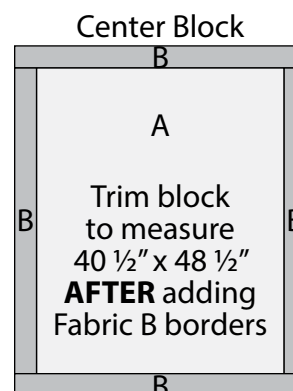

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2. Place (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 8 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

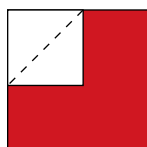

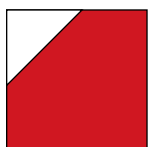

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 4 ½" Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).

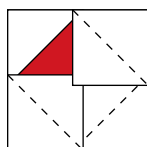

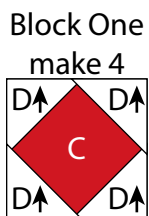

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) Block Two squares, (2) Block Three squares and (2) Block Four squares.

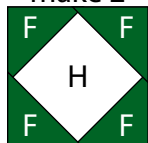

6. Sew together (1) 5 ¼" Fabric J triangle and (1) 5 ¼" Fabric I triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 ⅞" Fabric K triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (64) Unit 1 squares total.

7. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 8 ½" Block Five square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (16) Block Five squares total.

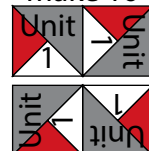

8. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Three square, (2) Block Five squares, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block Five square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 11).

9. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Four square, (2) Block Five squares, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Five square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 12).

10. Sew together (1) Block One square, (2) Block Five squares, (1) Block Two square, (2) Block Five squares and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 2" x 64 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 59 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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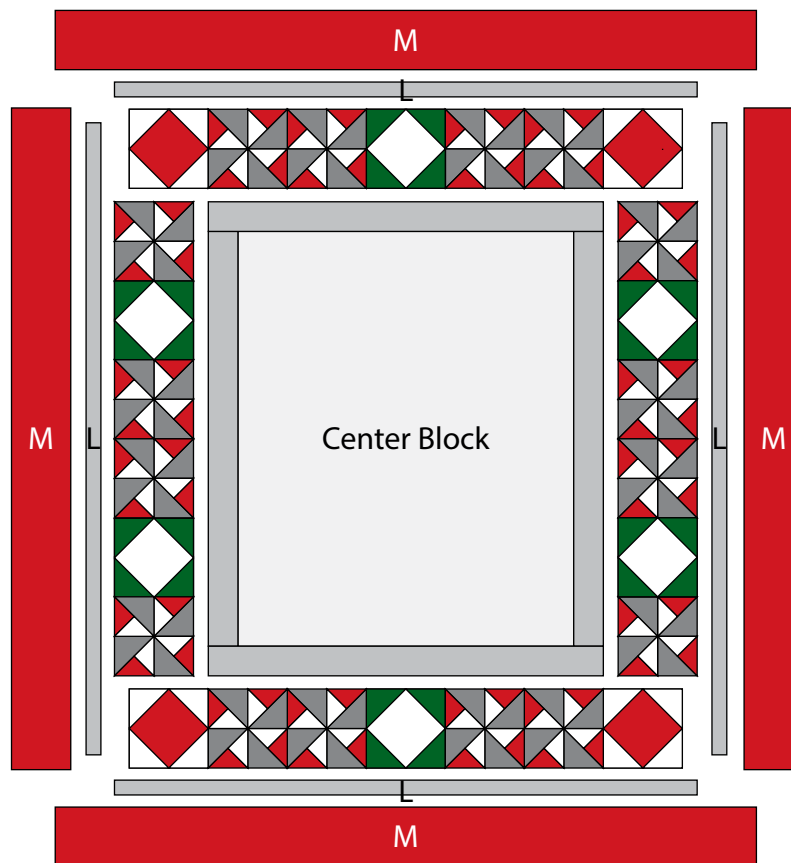
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14. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 71 ½" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
