Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/8 yard 1795-55 Leaves - Purple
1/8 yard 1796-67 Tree Mushroom - Jade
1/8 yard 1797-67 Sea Shell - Jade
1/8 yard 1798-55 Sky - Purple
1/8 yard 1799-75 Water - Blue
1/4 yard 1794-55 Tree Bark - Purple
1/4 yard 1794-75 Tree Bark - Blue
1/4 yard 1796-55 Tree Mushroom - Purple
1/4 yard 1796-75 Tree Mushroom - Blue
1/4 yard 1797-55 Sea Shell - Purple
1/4 yard 1797-75 Sea Shell - Blue
1/4 yard 1798-75 Sky - Blue
1/4 yard 1799-55 Water - Purple
1/2 yard 1795-75 Leaves - Blue
5/8 yard 7101-50 Urban Legend - Lt. Purple
1-1/4 yards 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy
4-1/8 yards 1796-75 Tree Mushroom - Blue for backing
24" x 68" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting for Table Runner
(6) 23" x 18" pieces of batting for Placemats

Cut Fabrics

*Notes: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.
TR = Table Runner, PM = Placemats.*

From each:

1795-55 Leaves - Purple
1796-67 Tree Mushroom - Jade
1797-67 Sea Shell - Jade
1798-55 Sky - Purple
1799-75 Water - Blue
*Cut one 2-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips (TR).

From 1794-55 Tree Bark - Purple:

*Cut two 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut four 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips (TR).

From each:

1794-75 Tree Bark - Blue
1796-55 Tree Mushroom - Purple
1797-75 Sea Shell - Blue
1799-55 Water - Purple
*Cut two 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut two 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" (TR) and six 2-1/4" x 8" strips (PM).

From each:

1796-75 Tree Mushroom - Blue
1797-55 Sea Shell - Purple
*Cut three 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut three 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" (TR) and six 2-1/4" x 8" strips (PM).

From 1798-75 Sky - Blue:

*Cut two 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut six 2-1/4" x 8" strips (PM).

From 1795-75 Leaves - Blue:

*Cut one 2-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips (TR).
*Cut five 3" x WOF strips for border 2 (TR).
*Cut nine 2-1/4" x WOF strips for border 2 (PM).

From 7101-50 Urban Legend - Lt. Purple:

*Cut thirteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips: four for border 1 (TR) and nine for border 1 (PM).

From 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy:

*Cut sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding: five for TR and eleven for PM.

Assemble Table Runner

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.

1. Following the table runner diagram below for fabric placement, sew together thirty $2\text{-}\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\text{-}\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and press the seams in one direction (*figure 1*).

2. For border 1, sew four $1\text{-}\frac{1}{2}$ " 7101-50 Urban Legend - Lt. Purple strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the table runner through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side. Measure the width of the table runner through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
3. Repeat step 2 with the five 3 " 1795-75 Leaves - Blue strips to make and add border 2.

Finishing

4. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the table runner and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with the raw edges of the runner.
5. Join five $2\text{-}\frac{1}{2}$ " 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the table runner, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the runner and stitch it in place by hand to finish.

Assemble Placemats

1. Following the placemat diagram below for fabric placement, sew together seven $2\text{-}\frac{1}{4}$ " x 8 " strips and press the seams in one direction (*figure 2*). Repeat to make six placemat center blocks.

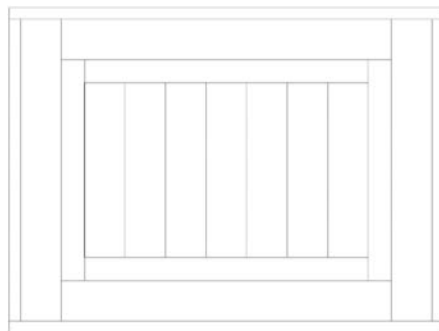
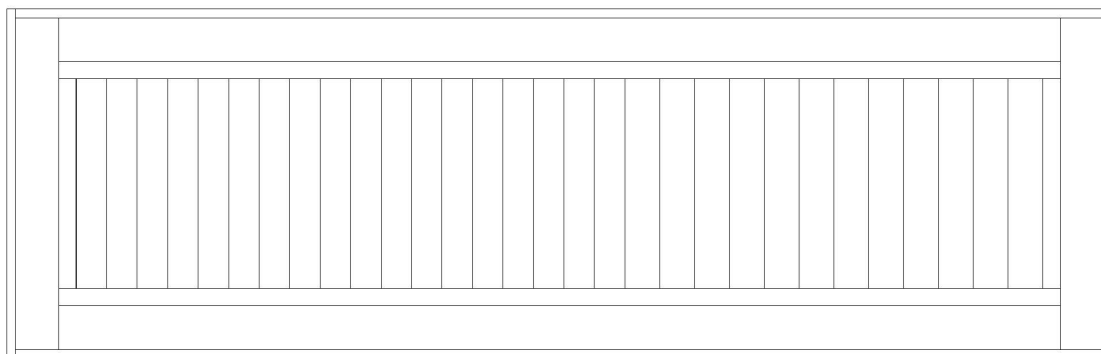
2. For border 1, sew the remaining 1-1/2" 7101-50 Urban Legend - Lt. Purple strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the placemat blocks through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side. Measure the width of the block through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Repeat with the other center blocks. Press the seams toward the borders.

3. Repeat step 2 with the nine 2-1/4" 1795-75 Leaves - Blue strips to make and add border 2.

Finishing

4. Cut six 23" x 18" rectangles of the 1796-75 Tree Mushroom – Blue for the placemats backing. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the placemats and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the placemats.

5. Join the eleven remaining 2-1/2" 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of each placemat, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the placemats and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
