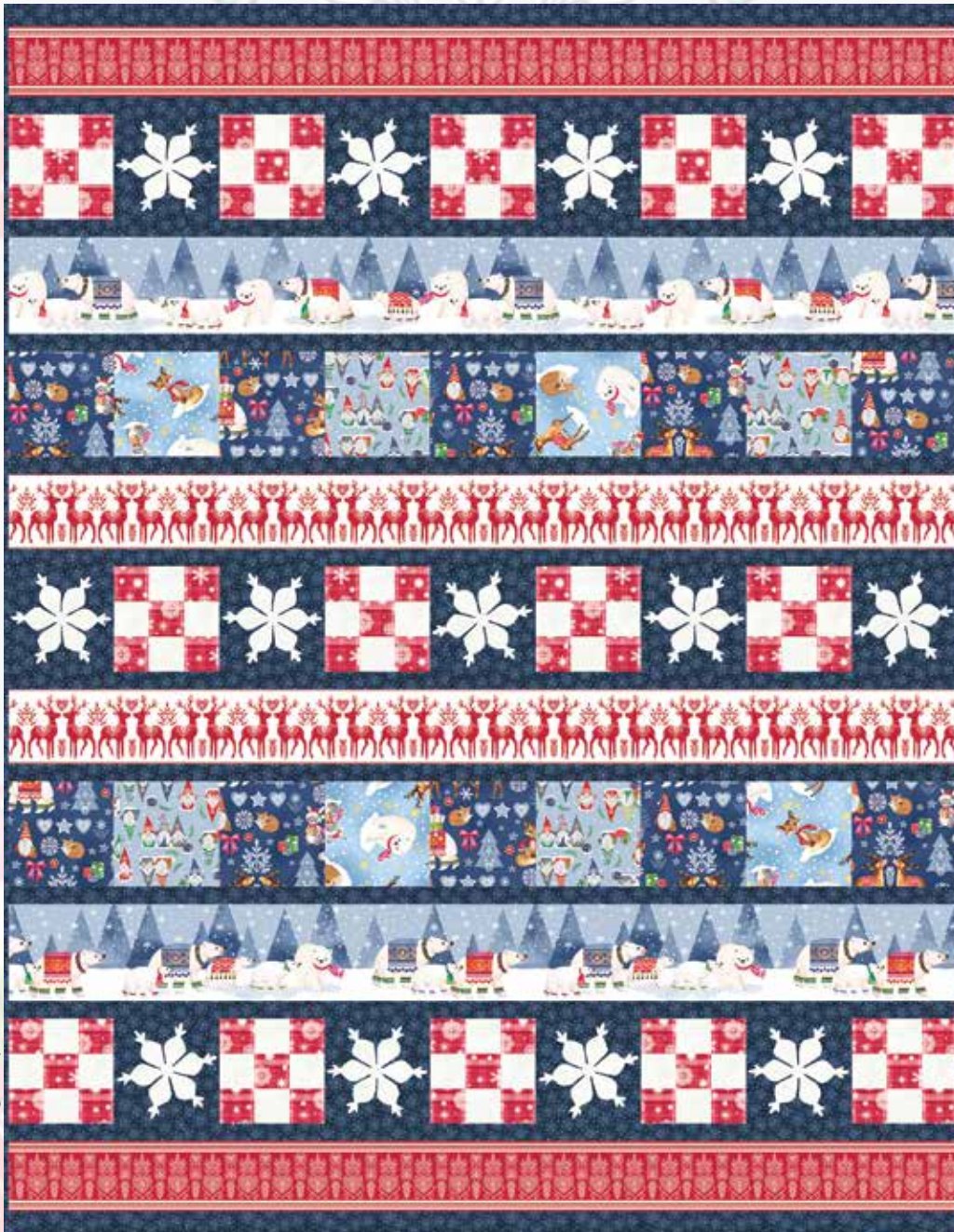

Materials

1 2/3 yards	Polar Bear Stripe - Slate (A)	9579-79
1 2/3 yards	Stripe - Red (B)	9576-88
1/2 yard	Snowflake on Plaid - Red (C)	9578-88
1 yard	Urban Legend - White (D)	7101-01
1 7/8 yards	Starlet - Cobalt (E)	6383-Cobalt*
1/2 yard	Decorative Animals - Dark Blue (F)	9573-77
1/4 yard	Tossed Animals - Light Blue (G)	9575-70
1/4 yard	Gnomes - Slate (H)	9577-79
4 1/2 yards	Patch - Blue (Backing)	9572-70

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Polar Bear Stripe - Slate (A), fussy cut:

- (2) 6" x 54 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a row of polar bears.

From the Strip - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 4 3/4" x 54 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on a White strip.
- (2) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on a Red strip.

From the Snowflake on Plaid - Red (C), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (70) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Urban Legend - White (D), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 1/2" squares.
- See instructions to cut (13) snowflakes.

From the Starlet - Cobalt (E), cut:

- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 6 1/2" squares.
- (16) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (12) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Decorative Animals - Dark Blue (F), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Animals - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Gnomes - Slate (H), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Patch - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 78" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 78" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (14) Block One squares total.

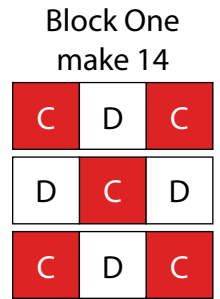

2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

4. Refer to Figure 2 to arrange and press (1) Fabric D snowflake onto (1) 6 1/2" Fabric E square.

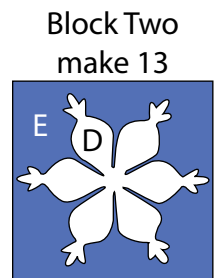

5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Two square.

6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (13) Block Two squares total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric B Red strip lengthwise to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Eleven.

8. Sew together (5) Block One squares and (4) Block Two squares, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Ten.

9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6" x 54 1/2" Fabric A strip lengthwise to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Nine.

10. Sew together (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric G square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric G square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric H square and (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, in that order, to make Row Four.

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11. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 3/4" x 54 1/2" Fabric B White strip lengthwise to make Row Five. Repeat to make Row Seven.

12. Sew together (5) Block Two squares and (4) Block One squares, alternating them, to make Row Six.

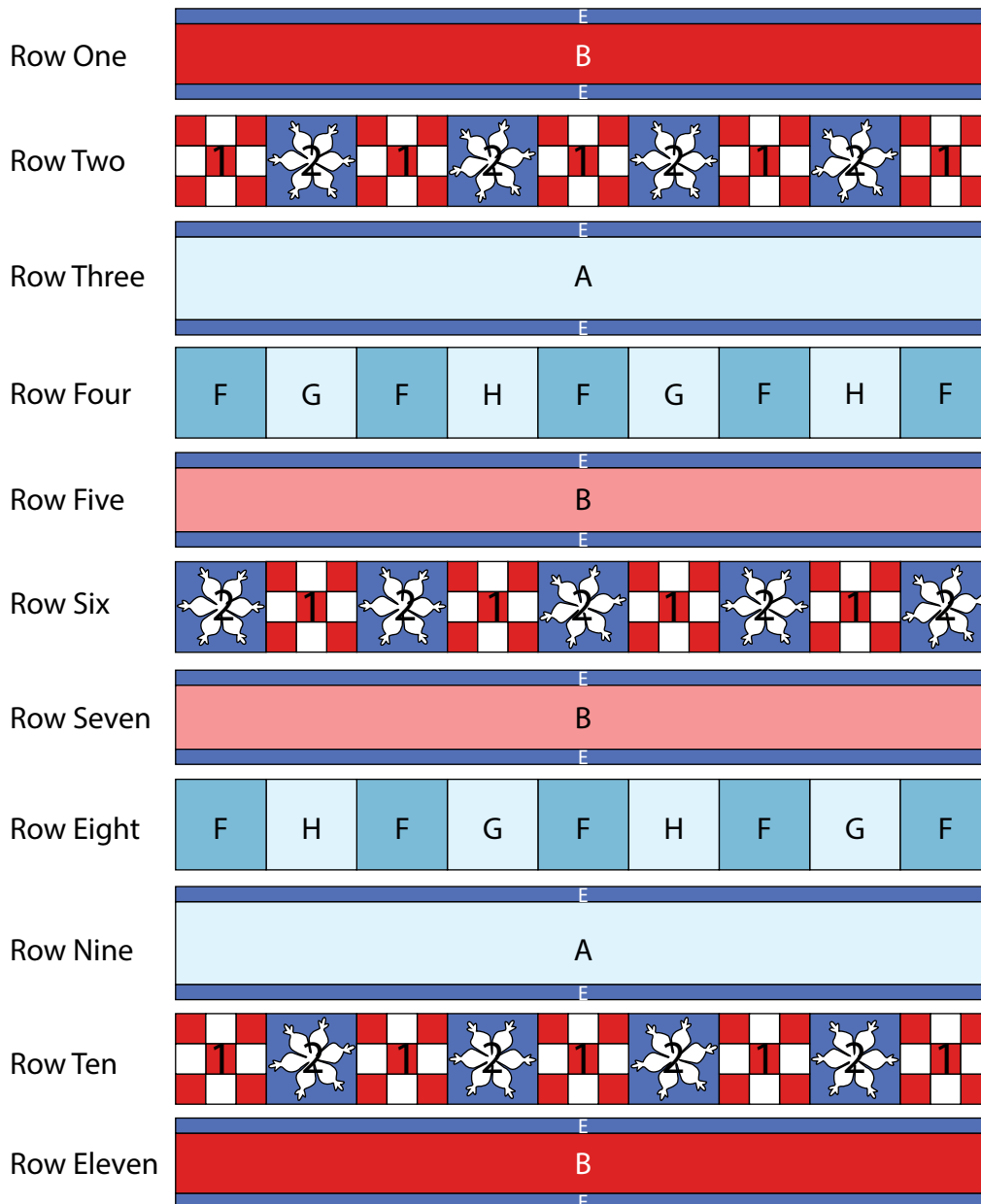
13. Sew (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric G square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric G square and (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square together in that order to make Row Eight.

14. Sew the (11) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.

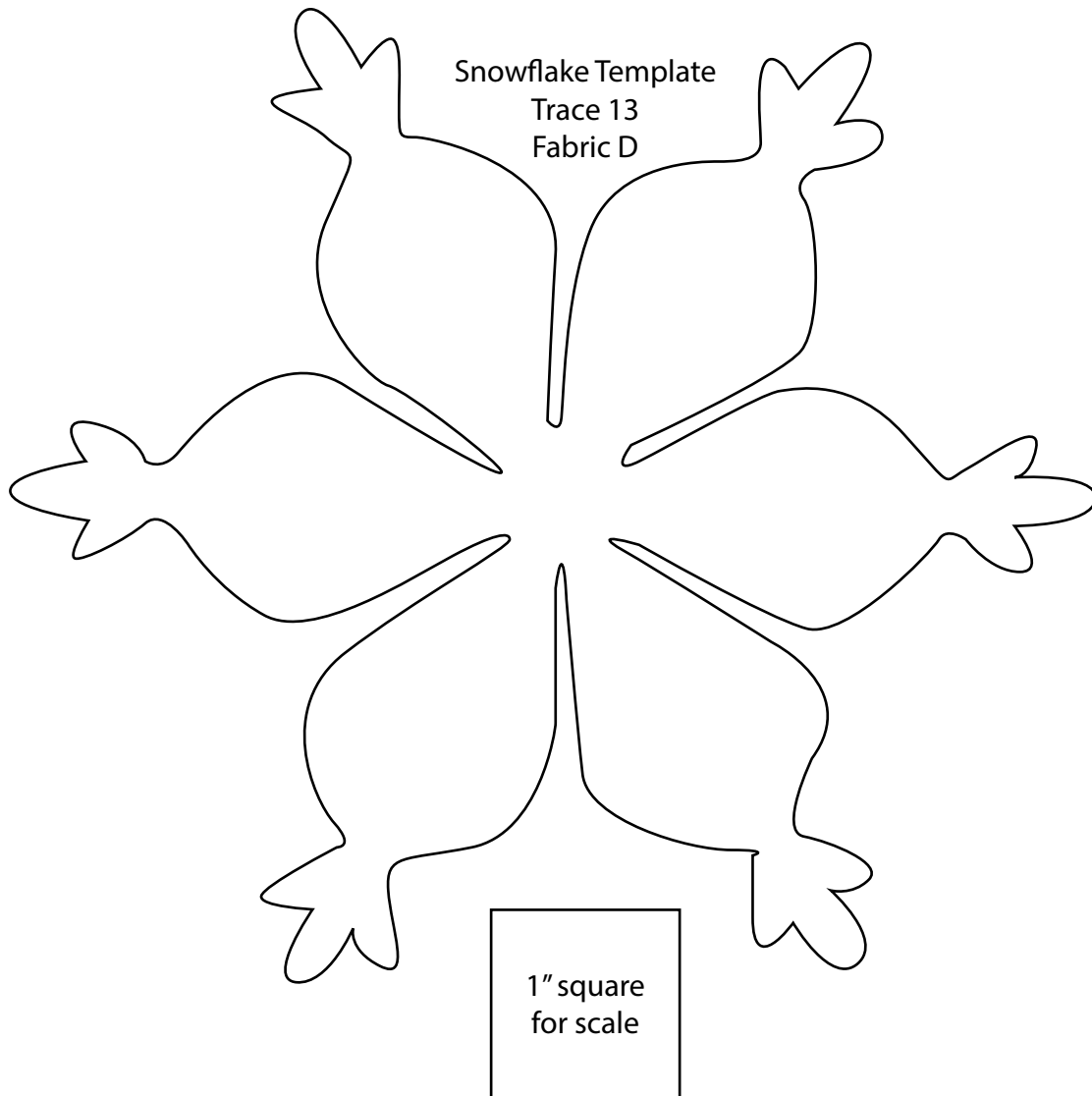
15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
