
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

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Flag Panel - Blue (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 42 ½" x 22 ½" rectangle, centered on the flag.

From the Starlet - Navy (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 22 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 12" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 14" strips.

From the Starlet - Red (C), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ³/₄" x 44 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ³/₄" x 46 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 35" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 67 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

From the State Names - White (D), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Patriotic Blocks - Blue (E):

• Fussy cut (8) 11" x 12" rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Patriotic Hearts - Blue (F), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Patriotic Fireworks - Blue (G), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 69 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (16) Template 1 triangles.
- (16) Template 3 triangles.

From the Patriotic Abstract Stars - Blue (H), cut:

• (2) 4 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 \%" squares.

From the Starlet - Sky (I), cut:

- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 12 ½" strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 13 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - White (J), cut:

- (2) 4 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 \%" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 13 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 65 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (32) Template 2 triangles.

From the Patriotic Stars - Blue (K), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Patriotic Icons - Blue (L), cut:

- (16) Template 1 triangles.
- (16) Template 3 triangles.

From the USA with Fireworks - Blue (M), cut:

• (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ½" x 78 ½" strips.

From the Patriotic Icons - White (Backing), cut:


• (3) 86" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 86" x 89" back.

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
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 22 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 42 ½" x 22 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 45 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure 44 ½" x 24 ½".



2. Sew (1) 1 ³/₄" x 44 ¹/₂" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 2).



3. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11" x 12" Fabric E rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 14" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E rectangle. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 13 ½" to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Block One rectangles total.






4. Place (1) Fabric L-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric J-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 4). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.



- 5. Place (1) Fabric L-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric J-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 5). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 6). The unit should measure 4 ½" square.
- 6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (16) Unit 2 squares total.
- 7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figure 7 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (16) 4 ½" Unit 3 squares.



8. Place (1) 4 \(\gamma \) " Fabric H square on top of (1) 4 \(\gamma \) " Fabric J square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 ½" square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (32) Unit 4 squares total.



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9. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 4 square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from

behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (32) Unit 5



12. Sew (1) 1" x 12 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Block Two square. Sew (1) 1" x 13 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Block Two square to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Block Four square.



13. Sew (1) 1" x 12 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of (1) Block Three square. Sew (1) 1" x 13 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Block Three square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block Five square.



14. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 17).

15. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Two square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 18).

16. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block Five square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 19).



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17. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block Five square, (1) 2 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 20).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 35" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 46 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left side and to the right side of the Center Block.
- 20. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 70 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


- 21. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 22. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 65 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 23. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 74 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 24. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 25. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 78 ½" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 26. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 27. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 28. Bind as desired.
