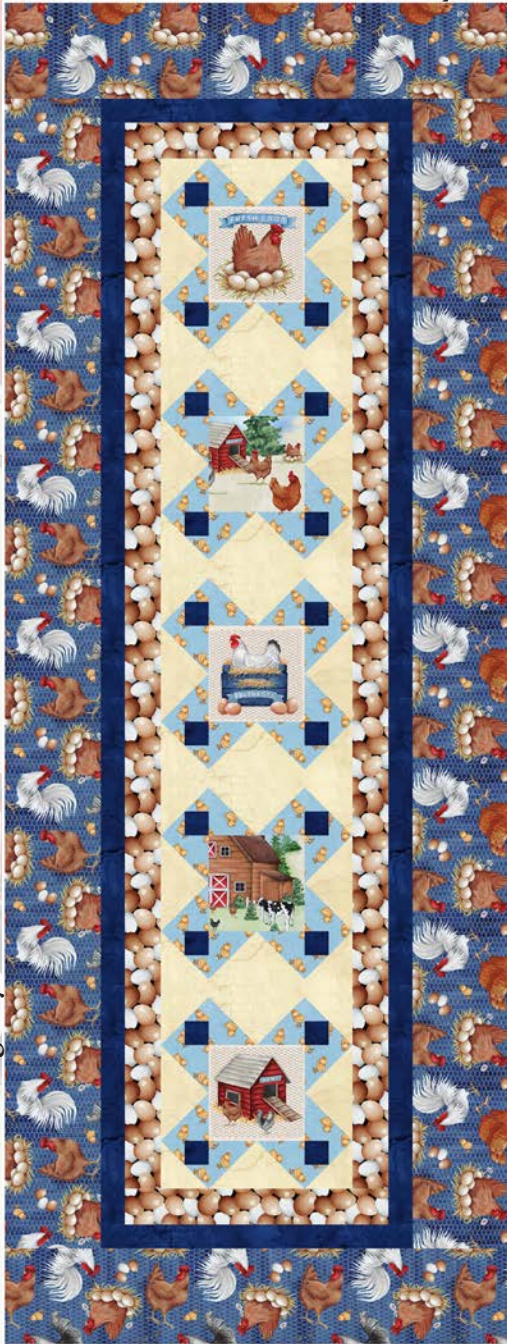
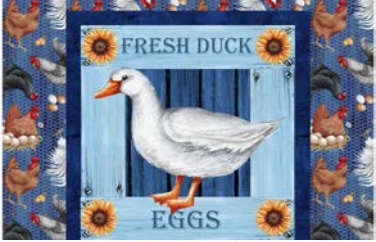

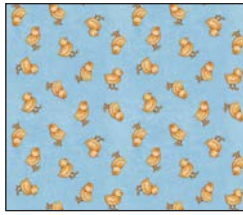

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## Materials

*Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.*

1/4 yard 2351-60 Scenic Farm - Lt. Green  
1/4 yard 2352-41 Chicken Patch - Ivory  
1/4 yard 2361-41 Eggs - Ivory  
1/3 yard 2358-70 Tossed Chicks - Lt. Blue  
1/2 yard 7101-41 Urban Legend - Ivory  
1/2 yard 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy  
2/3 yard 2354-77 Animal Blocks - Blue  
1-3/8 yards 2353-77 Tossed Chickens - Blue  
3-1/2 yards 2359-41 Barns, Tractors & Trucks - Ivory for backing  
25" x 61" piece of Air Lite® Colour Me 100% Cotton batting for Table Runner  
(6) 18" x 23" pieces of batting for Placemats

## Cut Fabrics

*Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.*

### From 2351-60 Scenic Farm - Lt. Green:

\*Cut one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 4-1/2" squares.

### From 2352-41 Chicken Patch - Ivory:

\*Cut one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut three 4-1/2" squares.

### From 2361-41 Eggs - Ivory:

\*Cut three 2" x WOF strips for border 1 (runner).

### From 2358-70 Tossed Chicks - Lt. Blue:

\*Cut one 1-7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty 1-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (A)

\*Cut three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty 2-1/2" squares.

### From 7101-41 Urban Legend - Ivory:

\*Cut one 1-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" strips.

\*Cut one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 2-7/8" squares; cut once diagonally. (B)

\*Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

### From 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy:

\*Cut seven 1-1/4" x WOF strips for border 1 (placemats).

\*Cut one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut twenty 1-1/2" squares.

\*Cut three 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

### From 2354-77 Animal Blocks - Blue:

\*Trim six 11-1/2" squares.

### From 2353-77 Tossed Chickens - Blue:

\*Cut four 1-1/4" x WOF strips for border 2 - top and bottom (placemats).

\*Cut six 3-3/4" x WOF strips for border 2 - sides (placemats).

\*Cut four 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3 (runner).

## TABLE RUNNER

### Assemble Blocks

*Note: Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.*

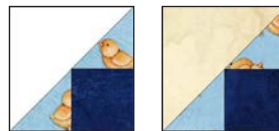


Figure 1 - Make (20) 2-1/2" units.

1. Sew a 2358-70 Tossed Chicks - Lt. Blue triangle A to one side of a 1-1/2" 7101-77 Urban Legend - Navy square. Press open. Sew another Lt. Blue triangle A to the adjacent side of the same square. Press open and trim ears. Sew a 7101-41 Urban Legend - Ivory triangle B to this unit and press open (*figure 1*). Repeat to make twenty 2-1/2" units.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2-1/2" 2358-70 Tossed Chicks - Lt. Blue squares. With right sides together, layer a marked Lt. Blue square on the left short end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" 7101-41 Urban Legend - Ivory rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch another Lt. Blue square to the opposite end of the same rectangle (*figure 2, next page*).

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Repeat to make a total of twenty 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" flying-geese units.

3. Noting fabric orientation, sew a Step 1 unit to opposite sides of a Step 2 unit and press the seams away from the center (*figure 3*). Repeat to make ten strips.

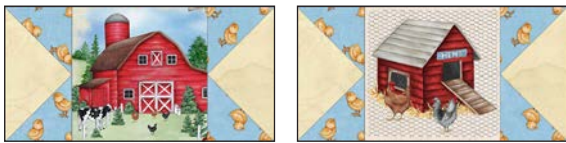


Figure 4 – Make (5) assorted units.

4. Sew the remaining Step 2 units to opposite sides of the 4-1/2" 2351-60 Scenic Farm - Lt. Green and 2352-41 Chicken Patch – Ivory squares (*figure 4*). Press the seams toward the center.

5. Sew one Step 3 strip to the top and one to the bottom of the Step 4 units to make five 8-1/2" blocks (*figure 5*). Press the seams in one direction.

## Assemble Table Runner

6. Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, lay out the Step 5 8-1/2" blocks and the four 1-1/4" x 8-1/2" sashing strips in one column, and join them together. Press the seams in one direction.

7. For border 1, join the three 2" 2361-41 Eggs – Ivory strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the runner through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the runner through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

8. Repeat Step 7 with the three 1-1/2" 7101-77 Urban Legend – Navy strips to make and add border 2.

9. Repeat Step 7 with the four 4-1/2" 2353-77 Tossed Chickens – Blue strips to make and add border 3.

## Finishing

10. With right sides together, layer the table runner atop the Barns, Tractors & Trucks – Ivory backing. Layer a piece of batting on top. Sew around the edge of the runner using a 1/4" seam allowance and leaving a 4" opening. Trim runner at the seam allowance.

11. Turn the table runner inside out, close the opening with a hand stitch (or pin to close it when topstitching), press, and topstitch 1/2" inside the edge. Quilt as desired.

## PLACEMATS

### Assemble Placemats

1. For border 1, cut four 1-1/4" 7101-77 Urban Legend – Navy strips into twelve 1-1/4" x 11-1/2" strips. Sew one strip to the top and one to the bottom of the 11-1/2" 2354-77 Animal Blocks – Blue squares. Press the seams toward the borders. Cut the remaining 1-1/4" White strips into twelve 13" lengths and sew one strip to each side of the placemats. Press the seams toward the borders.

2. For border 2 (top and bottom only), measure the width of the placemats through the center. Cut the 1-1/4" 2353-77 Tossed Chickens – Blue border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bot-

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tom of the placemats. Press seams toward borders.

3. For the sides of border 2, measure the vertical length of the placemats through the center. Cut the 3-3/4" 2353-77 Tossed Chickens – Blue border strips that length and sew one strip to each side of the placemats. Press seams toward borders.

## **Finishing**

4. Cut the 2359-41 Barns, Tractors & Trucks - Ivory backing fabric into six 18" x 23" rectangles. Layer the

placemat right sides together atop the backing rectangles. Layer a piece of batting on top. Sew around the placemats using a 1/4" seam allowance and leaving a 4" opening. Trim placemats at the seam allowance.

5. Turn placemats inside out, close the opening with a hand stitch (or pin to close them when topstitching), press, and topstitch 1/2" inside the edge. Quilt as desired.

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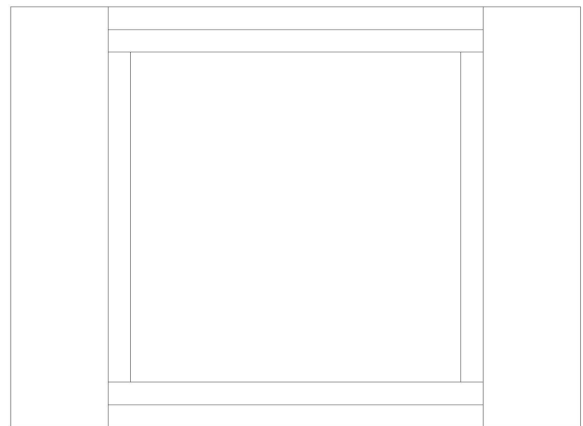
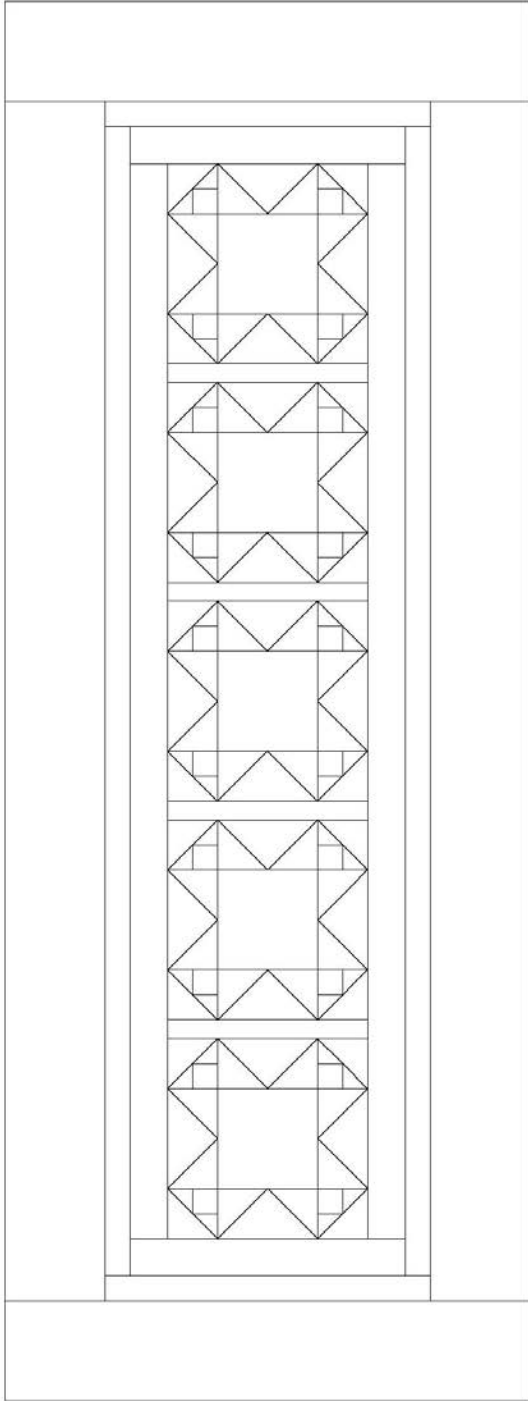


Table Runner and Placemat Diagrams
