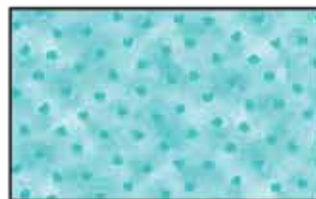

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Party Balloons - Blue (A), cut:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6" squares.

From the Tonal Hearts - Turquoise (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¼" x 6" strips.
- (3) 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ¼" x 7 ½" strips.

From the Presents - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 6" square.

From the Birthday Candles - White (D), cut:

- 6" square.

From the Cupcakes - White (E), cut:

- 6" square.

From the Happy Birthday Words - White (F), cut:

- 6" square

From the Party Hats - Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ½" squares.
- (16) Scallops.

From the Starlet - White (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Tonal Stars - Red (I), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.
- (16) Scallops.

From the Starlet - Yellow (J), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

From the Jot Dots - Purple (K), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

Tonal Hearts - Purple (L), cut:

- (14) Scallops.

From the Birthday Cakes - Turquoise (M), cut:

- (14) Scallops.

From the Birthday Candles - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (1) 56" x 28" WOF strip for the backing.

Runner Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 6" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 7 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Block One square.

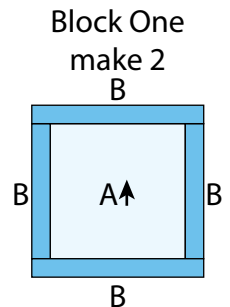

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block square for Block Two through Block Five.

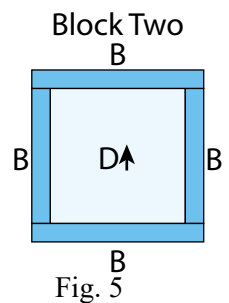

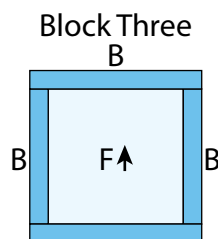

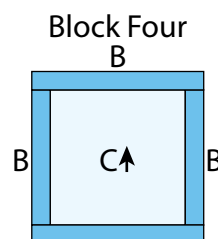

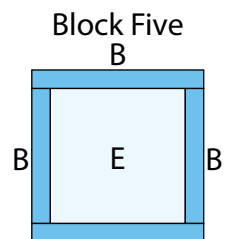

3. Sew (1) 2" Fabric I square, (1) 2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip and (1) 2" Fabric J square together in that order left to right to make the top row (Fig. 6). Repeat to make the bottom row.

4. Sew (1) 2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square to make the middle row (Fig. 6).

5. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 3-4 together lengthwise to make (1) 7 1/2" Block Six square (Fig. 6).

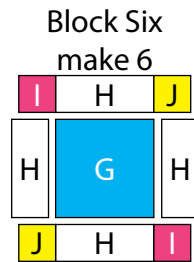

6. Repeat Steps 3-5 to make (6) Block Six squares total.

7. Follow Figure 7 and sew together the (12) pieced blocks into a 2 x 6 matrix to make the Unit 1 rectangle.

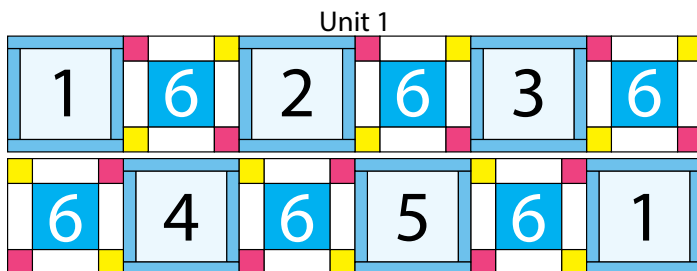

8. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric K strip to each end of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the Unit 2 rectangle (Fig. 8).

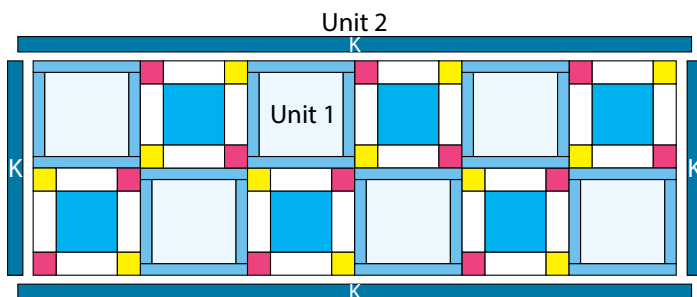

9. Place (2) Fabric L pieces on top of each other right sides together. Sew around the curved edge of the pieces leaving the straight side open for turning.

10. Turn the scallop right side out and press to make (1) Fabric L scallop (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (7) Fabric L scallops total.

11. Repeat Steps 9-10 using the Fabric G, Fabric I and Fabric M pieces to make (8) Fabric G scallops, (8) Fabric I scallops and (7) Fabric M scallops.

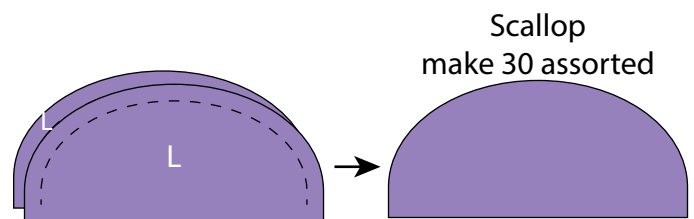

12. Place (11) assorted scallops along the top edge of the Unit 2 rectangle, aligning the raw edges. Sew the scallops in place to make the Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 10).

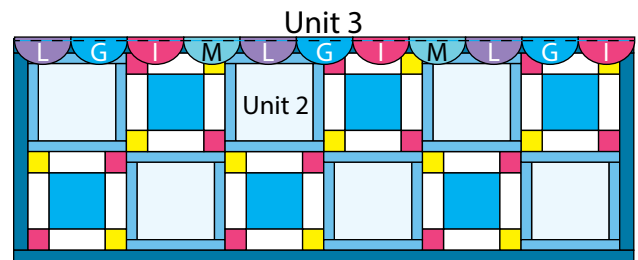

13. Place (11) assorted Scallops along the bottom edge of the Unit 3 rectangle, aligning the raw edges. Sew the scallops in place to make the Unit 4 rectangle (Fig. 11).

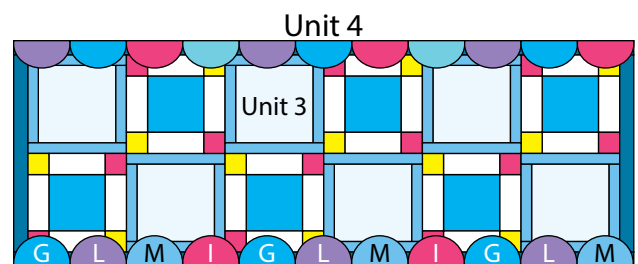

Table Set

14. Flip the top and bottom scallops out. Place (4) assorted scallops along the left edge of the Unit 4 rectangle, aligning the raw edges. Sew the scallops in place. Repeat along the right edge with the (4) remaining scallops (Fig. 11).

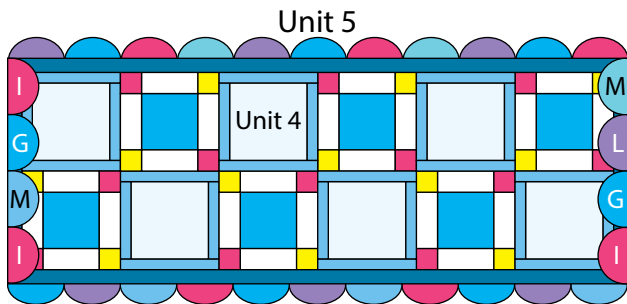

15. Layer the batting and backing together.

16. Turn the edges of the backing to the wrong side ¼" over the edge of the batting and press (Fig. 13).

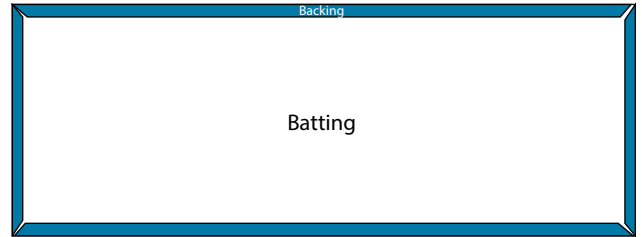

17. Place the Unit 5 rectangle and backing/batting piece wrong sides together, making sure the scallops are all pointing out. Topstitch the layers together to complete the runner (Fig. 14).

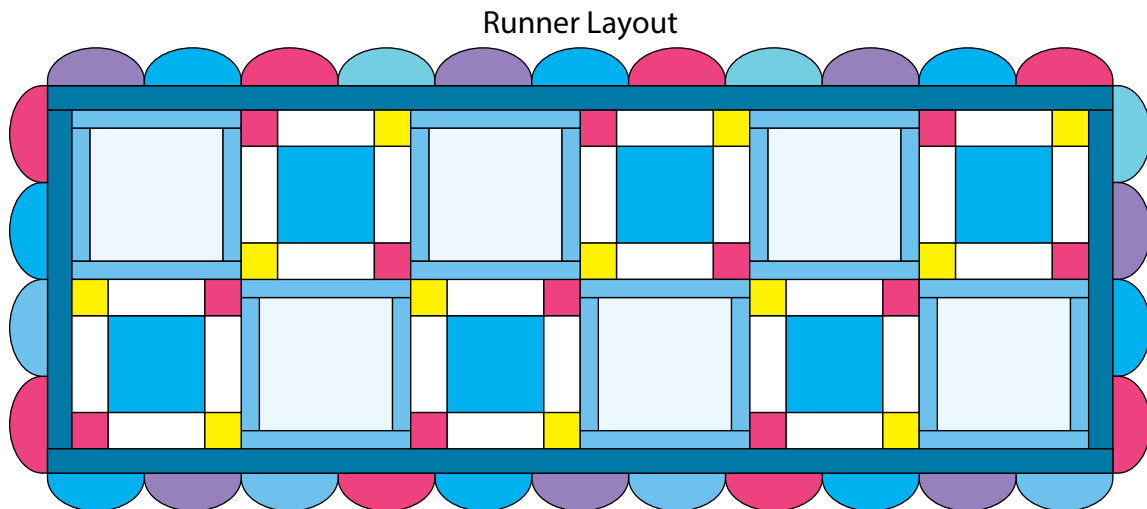
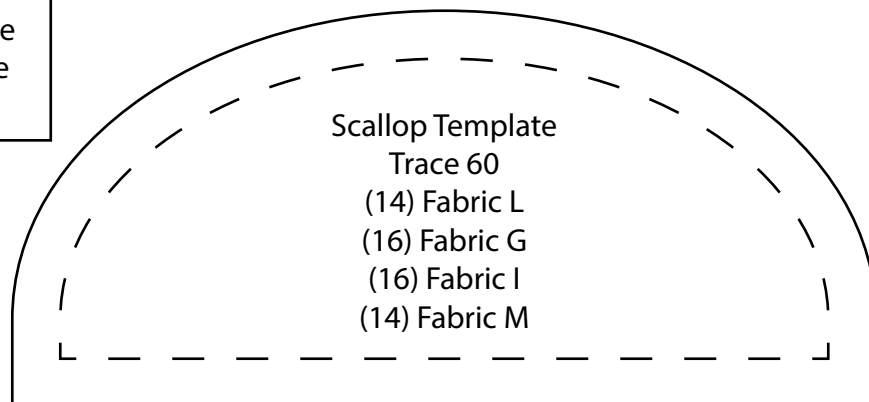
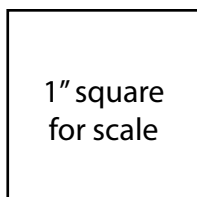

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Birthday Candles - White, cut: (A)

- (1) Cupcake Bottom.

From the Tonal Hearts - Purple (B), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Top.

From the Happy Birthday Words - White, cut: (C)

- (1) Cupcake Bottom.

From the Tonal Stars - Blue (D), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Top.

From the Cupcakes - White (E), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Bottom.

From the Tonal Stars - Red (F), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Top.

From the Party Balloons - Blue (G), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Bottom.

From the Tonal Hearts - Turquoise (H), cut:

- (1) Cupcake Top.

From the Presents - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" squares.

Place Mat Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

18. Place (1) Fabric B Cupcake Top on top of (1) Fabric A Cupcake Bottom. The Cupcake Top should overlap the Cupcake Bottom by 1" - 1 ½". Pin the layers together and sew the bottom edge of the Cupcake Top to the Cupcake Bottom using a blanket or satin stitch to make the Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 15).

19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to Figures 16-18 for fabric identification and placement to make the Place Mat #2 top, Place Mat #3 top and Place Mat #4 top.

20. Layer (1) Place Mat top with a 16" square of batting and quilt as desired. Trim the batting even with the place mat front. Repeat with the remaining place mat tops and batting.

21. Place (1) 16" Backing square right side up on a flat surface. Place (1) Place Mat on top of the backing, right sides together.

22. Trace the cup cake shape onto the backing piece. Cut the backing piece on the drawn line. Layer the (2) pieces again, right sides together. Sew around the layered pieces leaving an opening for turning.

23. Turn the place mat right side out and hand sew the opening closed.

24. Repeat Steps 21-23 with the remaining place mat tops and backing squares to complete.

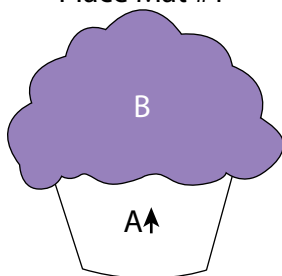

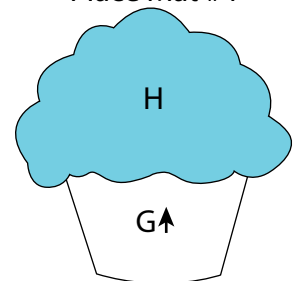

Reversed Template



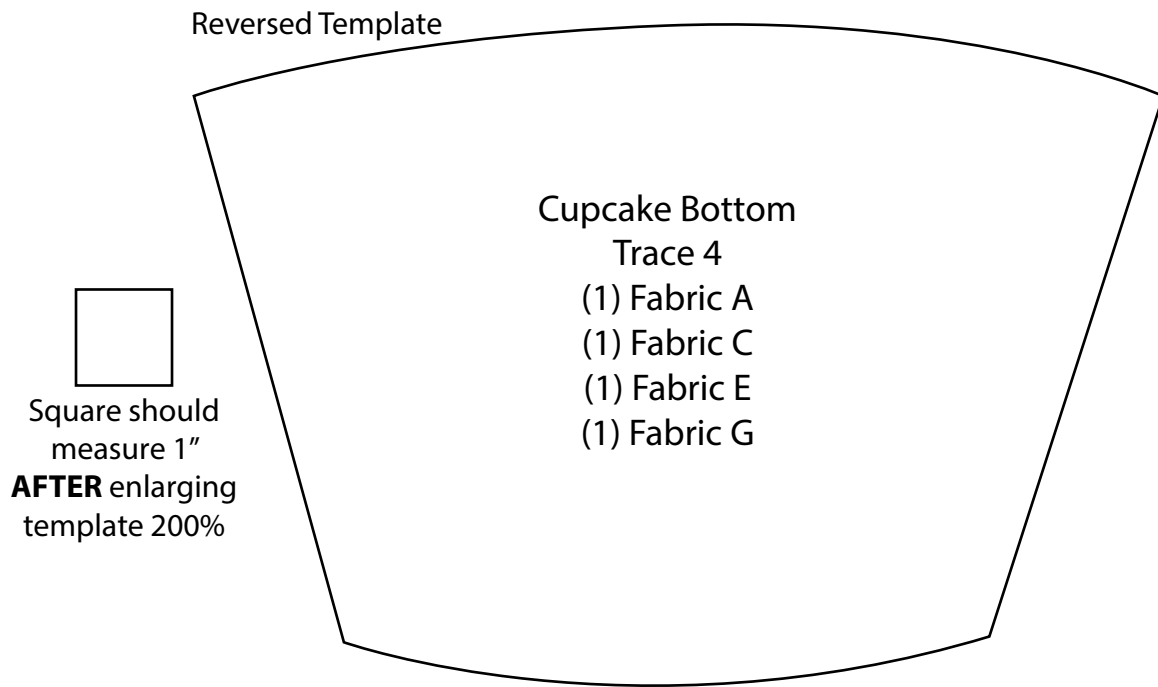
Square should
