


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

1/4 yard	Starlet - Yellow (G)	6383-Yellow
3/8 yard	Ladybugs - Green (H)	1554-66
1 1/8 yards	Sunflowers with Butterflies - Turquoise (I)

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel - Turquoise (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 8 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Starlet - Pink (B), cut:

- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

From the Starlet - White (C), cut:

- (12) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 ³/₄" x 5" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 44" strips.

From the Dots - Purple (D), cut:

• (7) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 ³/₄" squares.

From the Bees - Turquoise (E), cut:

• (7) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 ³/₄" squares.

From the Scroll - Pink (F), cut:

• (2) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ³/₄" squares.

From the Starlet - Yellow (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ³/₄" squares.

From the Ladybugs - Green (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46" strips.

From the Sunflowers with Butterflies - Turquoise (I), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 56" strips.

From the Dots - Red (J), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Butterflies - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 77" back.


Block Assembly


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure 9 ½" x 9 ½". Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Place (1) 2 ³/₄" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 2 ³/₄" x 5" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 3).








- 3. Place (1) 2 ¾" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ¾" x 5" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (48) Unit 2 strips total.






5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (48) Unit 3 strips.



6. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 3 strip, along their Fabric D sides, to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (48) Unit 4 strips total.



7. Sew (1) 2 ³/₄" Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.





8. Sew (1) 2 ¾" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
9. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

- 10. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 11. Sew the (4) Rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 2" x 54 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 44" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 56" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.



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
